## FEDERAL LEGISLATION

The 119<sup>th</sup> Congress starts its second (final) year in January. Bills introduced in 2025 will keep the same bill numbers through 2026. Below is a partial list of

the bills that address a Life Issue, or at least attempt to, in a monetary way. The number of cosponsors is shown {X} indicating the bill's chance of seeing floor action. Bills with **HR.** prefix = House of Reps., **S.** = Senate.

- **HR.7/S.186** {88/49} *No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion and Abortion Insurance Full Disclosure Act, 2025.* To bar federal funding of abortion, both directly or via federally funded insurance (including ACA) and at V.A. hospitals.
- **HR.722** {84} - *Life at Conception Act*; Title says it all.
- **HR.271 & S.203** {58}&{11} - non-identical *Defund Planned Parenthood Acts*. HR.271 would expire in 1 year, and has exceptions for rape, incest, and life of mother.
- **HR.589/S.223** {41/3} - *FACE Act Repeal Act*. Note: in Spring 2025, Asst. Attorney General Harmee Dhillon said the Trump administration will "aggressively" prosecute violence/vandalism of PRCs & churches under the FACE act. Rep. Chip Roy, who introduced HR589, replied if FACE stays on the books, it is "a sword" waiting for a future pro-abortionist administration to use.
- **HR.632/S.207** {27/12} *Protecting Lives on College Campuses Act*, to ban federal funds to any higher education institution that hosts or affiliates with a student-based abortion provider (pill or surgical), serving students or employees.
- **HR.3235/S.1630** {20/23} *More Opportunities for Moms to Succeed (MOMS) Act*. Includes: pregnant women could get child support from fathers; *Pregnancy.gov* (info on PRCs, adoption, aid orgs); grants for women who carry to term and keep their child; grants to boost pre/post-natal telehealth visits.
- **HR.4964** {15} *Child Interstate Abortion Notification Act* - to ban taking a minor across state lines for a pill or surgical abortion, bypassing parental consent laws.
- **HR.5160** {5} *Stem Cell Therapeutic and Research Reauthorization Act of 2025* - to extend funding through 2031 for the collection, storage and medical use of (ethical) stem cells derived from placentas and umbilical cords.

(None of the above bills has an L.I. House cosponsor)

- Sen. Blackburn has introduced the **ADOPT Act**, (Adoption Deserves Oversight, Protection, & Transparency) to tighten licensing regulations for adoption intermediaries and attorneys, and protect adoptive families, children and birth mothers. There are no House or Senate bill numbers yet.
- A Dec. 5 Family Research Council email listed some 2025 accomplishments: The *Rescissions Act*, **HR. 4**, cut billions from organizations that could use funds to tout abortion. Big Beautiful Bill **HR. 1**, made permanent the inflation- adjusted child tax credit. **S.Amendment 971** which may have allowed tax-funded abortion and embryo experiments failed 49 to 51. The

*Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act* **HR.21** passed in the House, but Senate companion **S.6** did not get the 60 votes needed to pass.



## NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

As of this newsletter going to print, the Medical Aid in Dying (MAID) bill was *not* sent to Gov. Hochul, but even on the rare chance it is never 'Officially Delivered' to her desk, it will be considered Delivered before the next legislative session begins in early January and hence will automatically pass. Provisions of the MAID bill include:

The individual must be an adult (18+) but does **not** **require** NY residency; diagnosed with a terminal illness expected to cause death within 6 months; capable of making an informed, voluntary decision. The request must be made by the patient, not a proxy, surrogate, or advance directive. The patient must make one oral request to their attending physician and one written request signed in front of two qualified adult witnesses. Witnesses cannot be relatives, heirs, facility employees caring for the patient, or agents under power of attorney. The attending physician must confirm diagnosis, prognosis, decision-making capacity, and voluntariness; ensure the patient is fully informed of risks, alternatives, and palliative/hospice options; refer to a consulting physician for confirmation; refer to a mental health professional if capacity is uncertain; offer the patient a final opportunity to rescind the request; document all steps in the medical record. The consulting physician must independently verify terminal illness, capacity, voluntariness, and informed decision-making.

A mental health evaluation is required if either physician suspects impaired judgment. If the patient lacks decision-making capacity, they are not eligible. Medication must be self-ingested, no injections or administration by another person. Providers acting in good faith are shielded from criminal, civil, or professional liability. Health care workers or facilities are not required to participate. Facilities with religious or moral objections may prohibit participation on their premises but must inform patients and facilitate transfer if requested. Actions under this law are not considered suicide, assisted suicide, euthanasia, or homicide; life insurance cannot be denied based on participation. Contracts or wills cannot be influenced by whether someone requests aid-in-dying medication. Physicians must document requests, assessments, and prescriptions; The state health department must collect data and issue reports. There are requirements for safe disposal of unused medication. The cause of death on the death certificate will be the patient's underlying terminal illness or condition.

Jimmy Vielkind reported at the *Gothamist* (12/3/25) that Hochul wants amendments to the bill including requiring NYS residency, patients to videotape their request, a 7-day waiting period, and a mental health evaluation for all patients. Instead of becoming law immediately upon her signature, she wants to delay the effective date for a year – conveniently after Election Day 2026. Obviously, she doesn't understand how dangerous this bill is.

## HEALTH & SCIENCE: IVF Robots

The *Washington Post* published an article on 10/3/25 by Elizabeth Dwoskin and Zoeann Murphy entitled “*Robots are learning to make human babies.*” The article stated that at least 20 babies have been conceived and born using an automated IVF process. AI robots search for and gather the strongest/healthiest sperm, mix the chemicals needed to keep the egg ‘viable’, then fertilize the egg, creating a new human being. Conceivable Life Sciences is the startup responsible for creating the Aura system that automates the manual IVF steps from freezing the eggs to creating embryos. The 205 manual steps involved in the IVF process were automated using “high-precision robotic arms,” along with other advanced technology. The *Post* article stated the “array of robots” might be mistaken “for a smartphone assembly line, with sleek technology making the messiness of biology feel controlled and contained.”

Co-Founder of Conceivable Life Sciences, fertility doctor Alejandro Chavez-Badiola, said the process will replace the “superstar embryologists at IVF clinics across the country with an automated process that is successful 100% of the time.” But the *Post* article stated that “none of the studies done by Conceivable and another company exploring the automation of IVF, Overture, have proved that AI-enabled machines are markedly outperforming conventional IVF.” The article intimated that these companies see automated IVF as the answer to global infertility.

Jacqueline O’Hara commented on the *Post* article at the Human Life Review on 11/14/25, stating “There is something eerily dystopian about this new venture into the robotic creation of human life. Rather than employing technology to discern the root causes of infertility, fertility doctors and embryologists such as Chavez-Badiola seem to be focused on profit-driven, flashy new technologies that dehumanize the human life they seek to create. These methods of enabling the creation of human life should make any conscientious human squeamish. [Overture Life] has focused on building “palm-size” robotic boxes called DaVitri machines that are able to prepare eggs for freezing with the click of a button. These DaVitri machines are already being shipped to obstetricians around the world for use.” O’Hara asks “at what cost” is this enabling people to have children? She noted the religious concerns of “separating the unitive and procreative aspects of sex, thereby reducing the formation of new human life to a mere commodity. There are also the pro-life concerns about the discarding of embryos that are deemed faulty or the freezing of them indefinitely. Even putting these objections aside, most people should be squeamish about soulless, automated robots becoming involved in the creation and formation of sacred human life.” O’Hara quoted one mother whose child was created using this robotic process: “Wow, she’s so normal! I don’t even remember that my daughter is made with a machine.”

### Science Gone Mad

Steven Mosher, president of the Population Research Institute, reported in the *PRI Insider* (11/7/25) that a “biotech entrepreneur has raised \$30 million to launch a new company, Preventive, dedicated to researching heritable genome editing – the genetic alteration of embryos so that engineered traits can be passed down to future generations. Gene editing embryos remains illegal in the US. Yet, tech investors continue pushing to redesign the human person at the genetic level. This research treats human embryos as products to be edited, optimized, and discarded.”

Antonio Regalado reported on Preventive in the MIT Technology Review (10/31/25). Regalado stated that “creating genetically edited humans remains controversial...doubts surround its usefulness as a form of medicine. Still, as gene-editing technology races forward, the temptation to shape the future of the species may prove irresistible, particularly to entrepreneurs keen to put their stamp on the human condition.” Gene-editing scientist Lucas Harrington is the founder of Preventive. He feels that if the process is proven safe it “could become one of the most important health technologies of our time and would only cost about \$5,000.” There are two other startups focused on gene-edited babies: Bootstrap (interested in enhancing intelligence), and Manhattan Genomics.

Regalado said Fyodor Urnov, “an expert in gene editing...believes such ventures should not move forward. Urnov has been a pointed critic of the concept of heritable genome editing, calling it dangerous, misguided, and a distraction from the real benefits of gene editing to treat adults and children.” The only investor Harrington identified was SciFounders, a venture firm that he runs with Matt Krisiloff, the CEO of the biotech company Conception, “which aims to create human eggs from stem cells.”

Will Harborne, a potential investor, said he is “thrilled” to see Preventive launch and that if the technology proves safe, “widespread adoption is inevitable” and would be a “societal obligation.” Urnov warned Manhattan Genomics that they will “cause zero good and formidable harm.” Harrington said “Most scientists I speak with either accept embryo editing as inevitable or are enthusiastic about the potential but hesitate to voice these opinions publicly. Part of being more public about this is to encourage others in the field to discuss this instead of ignoring it.”

## IS THE FILM "UNPLANNED" ON YOUR LIBRARY SHELF?

Last year, a pro-life advocate was able to have the "Unplanned" DVD and book added to the shelves of her local library. The movie "Unplanned" is based on the book of the same name, written by Abby Johnson, former Planned Parenthood director and current pro-life advocate. We applaud the efforts of this young woman and, perhaps, you can bring "Unplanned" to your library!

The pro-life woman had made an unsuccessful previous attempt to donate the "Unplanned" DVD to the North Merrick library. Then last year, the library had a display on censorship (mainly with a homosexual theme). The pro-lifer took this as opportunity to discuss with the library director the wider use of censorship, i.e. against pro-life materials. The pro-lifer submitted the appropriate paperwork to meet library guidelines and donated the DVD & book to the library. The materials passed library review and were put on the library shelves. It is useful to check out pro-life materials to show interest in the items because libraries may unstock materials that are not used over time.

It doesn't matter if your library has a display on censorship or not. Each library has guidelines for requesting materials to be included for the public to read/view. Having "Unplanned" in your library may find its way into a student's hand for a school report. This is yet another way to educate those who aren't otherwise informed of pro-life perspectives. If you try to get "Unplanned" or other pro-life DVDs/books in your local library, please let the LICL know what progress you made.
