FEDERAL LEGISLATION

After a Presidential election, each State Governor certifies the results, and “as soon as practicable,” sends a *Certificate of Ascertainment* to the US Archivist (disputes must be resolved by Dec. 13). The Electoral College meets Dec. 19, and Congress will count the votes on Jan 6, 2017. Currently, Mr. Trump has 306 Electoral votes; Sec. Clinton 232. Recounts are under-way, or sought, in Michigan, Pennsylvania & Wisconsin.

As of Dec 6, the New Congress breaks down as follows: House 241R - 194D ; Senate 52R - 46D - 2 Independent

Several appointments by Pres.-elect Trump have been hailed as pro-life: Sen. Jeff Sessions (Attorney General), Betsy DeVos (Education Secretary), Gov. Nikki Haley, (UN Ambassador). Dr. Ben Carson (HUD Secretary), steadfastly says he is pro-life, despite his comment on the fight to save Terri Schiavo. Rep. Tom Price (HHS Secretary), is called pro-life and anti-HHS abortifacient/sterilization/contraceptive Mandate.

VP-elect Pence told the *Wall Street Journal* (12/1) that ObamaCare repeal and replacement, and the SCOTUS vacancy are among the top priorities in Mr. Trump’s agenda. (The LICL urges Congress to reject all ‘healthcare’ laws that include any abortion coverage and/or abortifacient/sterilization/contraception coverage at taxpayer expense, and direct or implicit limiting of care to vulnerable populations such as sick newborns and the terminally ill.)

Steven Mosher, writing in *Population Research Institute Review* [Nov/Dec 2016], reported the following pro-life indications from President-elect Trump:

- *Asked the House and Senate to send him legislation defunding Planned Parenthood.
- *Backed legislation to ban abortion after 20 weeks (Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act), and pledged to sign it.
- *Pledged to "repeal and replace" Obamacare (see above)
- *Backs writing the ‘Mexico City policy’ into permanent law (i.e.: NGOs that receive federal money can’t perform, promote or lobby for legalization of abortion in other countries.)
- *Wants to permanently defund UN Population Fund - a ‘cheerleader’ for China’s forced sterilization and abortion programs

A staff member of Rep. Chris Smith (Co-Chair, Cong. Pro-life Caucus), told this writer they expect the PP defund bill, the Pain-Capable ban, and most other pro-life bills that ‘died’ on Dec. 31 to be re-introduced in the new Congress. The House had acted on many of those bills, the Senate on few.

On Nov. 22, Pres. Obama admitted that Merrick Garland, his SCOTUS nominee, would not be confirmed. In mid- May, Pres-elect Trump listed 21 possible pro-life SCOTUS nominees. In early December, Trump told *FoxNews* his first pick was down to “three or four” names.

On Dec. 1, the House Select Investigative Panel on Infant Lives issued nine criminal and regulatory referrals citing abortion providers and/or fetal tissue companies. It’s now up to respective local DA’s, State AG’s and Federal officials to act on the referrals. The Panel also issued 41 Subpoenas. (Note: late-term abortionists LeRoy Carhart & Warren Hern, among others, have yet to fully comply). The Panel was formed in Oct. 2015, in response to David Dalieden’s undercover videos, and funded through 2016. Panel Chair, Rep. Blackburn [R-TN], said they were charged with: protecting the integrity of scientific research and voluntary organ donation, while pursuing “bad actors” re fetal tissue trafficking, 2nd & 3rd trimester abortions, born-alive infants, and tax dollar involvement. The owners of *DV Biologics*, one of the companies that received a criminal referral, have been the subject of articles re political contributions and immigration status favors. [See: *NY Times* 3/11/14 and Operation Rescue 10/27/16]

“The Texas Health and Human Services Commission introduced a new rule in July which requires that abortion facilities, hospitals and other medical centers either cremate or bury the remains of aborted and miscarried babies. State officials said the rule does not apply to miscarriages or abortions that take place at home. The commission finalized the rule in late November. It is scheduled to go into effect Dec. 19. Abortion activists have been protesting the rule, claiming it will create additional expenses and other burdens for abortion facilities. They also claim the rule is a pro-life attempt to end abortions. Previously, abortion facilities could dispose of aborted babies’ bodies in landfills or give them to research groups. More states are moving to require dignified burials of aborted babies’ bodies after the undercover videos by the Center for Medical Progress were released. Texas Gov. Greg Abbott said aborted babies’ bodies should not be “treated like medical waste and disposed of in landfills...It is imperative to establish higher standards that reflect our respect for the sanctity of life.” [*LifeNews.com*, 12/5/16]

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

“Protecting Life, Not Punishing Women”



Tim Bradley, research associate at the Charlotte Lozier Institute wrote on his blog on October 6, 2016, “Some abortion advocates claim that pro-lifers want to punish women seeking abortion. They argue that women were punished for having abortions before *Roe v. Wade* was decided by the Supreme Court in 1973, and that if *Roe* is repealed women will once again be subject to punishment. Those leveling these charges may sincerely believe that the logical implications of the pro-life position – that each and every human being, at any stage of development and condition of dependency, possesses a right to life simply by virtue of being human and ought to be protected by law from having that life taken from it – entail that women seeking abortions should be punished for their cooperation in an act that ends an innocent human life. Are they right? Accurate knowledge of the history of abortion law in this country before 1973, the legislative efforts of the pro-life movement to reduce and ultimately end abortion since *Roe*, and the rationale at the heart of the pro-life movement reveal that the answer is – emphatically – no.”

Bradley notes that Clarke Forsythe, acting president of Americans United for Life, stated that “there were zero prosecutions of pregnant women under any abortion law in the United States between 1922 and 1973. The only two documented cases in American law in which a woman was charged in participating in her own abortion occurred in 1911, in Pennsylvania, and 1922, in Texas. In neither of those cases was the woman convicted.” Bradley further notes that Justice Blackmun acknowledged in the majority opinion in *Roe* that prevailing laws did not prosecute women for self-abortion or cooperating in an abortion performed upon her by another. Most state statutes at the time did not allow for the prosecution of the woman, and in states that did have statutes prohibiting self-abortions or consenting to an abortion, no women were prosecuted.

According to Bradley, the reason for this is that state abortion laws before *Roe* were aimed at prosecuting the abortionists, not the women. Abortionists were considered the ‘principals’ of the act; women were, for the most part, considered the ‘victim’ rather than the ‘accomplice’. There was a practical reason for this: if a woman is considered the accomplice, she cannot testify against the principal in court. This would have limited the state’s ability to enforce laws against abortionists. Forsythe wrote in an op-ed in the *Los Angeles Times* (3/31/16), “The states understood that the point of abortion law is effective enforcement against abortionists; that the woman is the second victim of the abortionist; and that prosecuting women is counterproductive to the

goal of effective enforcement of the law.”

Will women face penalties if *Roe* is repealed? Bradley states that “there is no reason to answer in the affirmative”. According to Paul Linton (*Issues in Law and Medicine*, Spring 2012), if *Roe* is overturned, it will not prohibit abortion nationwide. State laws will not be restored to what they were in 1973. Most state laws have been repealed or overridden by state court decisions since 1973. There are just a handful of states that have passed laws prohibiting abortion since 1973 that would be affected by a repeal of *Roe*. Therefore, most states would need to design new laws to prohibit abortion. Bradley reflects that given the history of abortion law in the United States, there is no reason to think that new laws would punish women.

Bradley acknowledges that “most pro-lifers and all major pro-life organizations oppose punishing women for procuring abortions...abortion restrictions that have been enacted at both the state and federal levels indicate that pro-life lawmakers have no interest in punishing women...The Partial Birth Abortion Ban Act of 2003 explicitly states, ‘A woman upon whom a partial-birth abortion is performed may not be prosecuted under this section.’”

Bradley concludes, “This position against punishing women, which the pro-life movement embraces, is coherent with its fundamental premises. Abortion law before *Roe* showed a high level of sympathy for pregnant women facing difficult circumstances. It also recognized that these women’s testimonies were crucial in order for the state to be able to carry out its aim of protecting the unborn child by punishing those who perform abortions.

“Robert P. George and Ramesh Ponnuru explain (*National Review*, 5/9/16) that the pro-life movement wants our laws today to accomplish the same thing that pre-*Roe* laws did for decades. Those laws ‘recognized that unborn children are living human beings with the same right not to be killed that the rest of us possess; they gave effect to this recognition by prohibiting abortion; and they imposed no legal penalty on the mothers.’

“Saving babies, not punishing women, has been the purpose of the pro-life movement in this country from the start and continues unabated today.”
