ABORTIONS DECLINING: Statements from a 6/8/2015 Associated Press article are encouraging. "Abortions have declined in states where new laws make it harder to have them - but they've also waned in states where abortion rights are protected." "Nationwide, the AP survey showed a decrease in abortions of about 12 percent since 2010." From *LifeNews.com* 6/8/2015: "Several of the states that have been most aggressive in passing anti-abortion laws — including Indiana, Missouri, Ohio, and Oklahoma — have seen their abortion numbers drop by more than 15 percent since 2010. But more liberal states such as New York, Washington and Oregon also had declines of that magnitude, even as they maintained unrestricted access to abortion" LifeNews.com 6/8/2015 reports the numbers for New York State as: 2010 - 111,212 abortions; 2013 - 94,326 abortions; down 15.2 percent.

Students for Life (SFLA) will help you start a Pro-Life Club at your school. As recent national polls have confirmed, this generation of young people is pro-life. The challenge comes in breaking through the apathy, and motivating and training students to take a stand for Life on their high school and college campuses. Since 2006, SFLA have helped to establish and build over 700 student pro-life organizations and have trained tens of thousands of students nationwide.

Ideas, adapted from the SFLA website, suggest using the summer months to prepare:

- \Rightarrow Meet with your core team of pro-lifers at your <u>school</u> and <u>bounce</u> around ideas for next year. Use our <u>Plan</u> Your Year Guide.
- \Rightarrow Look into what pregnancy resources your campus offers and reach out to partner with them to offer pro-life resources through the Pregnancy on Campus Initiative.
- Are there pregnancy resource centers in your community? Get to know them so you can easily refer pregnant \Rightarrow students. Volunteer at the PRC or a maternity home over the summer. Maybe organize a volunteer day to spruce up the outside or just call and ask them what they need done.
- Watch videos from the SFLA East Coast National Conference to get the training. Save the dates for the SFLA \Rightarrow National East (January 23, 2016) and West Coast (January 24, 2016) conferences.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

The House passed the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act [HR 36] On 5/13 by a vote of 242-184. It bans most abortions after 20-weeks gestation. A vote had been set for 1/22/15, but was withdrawn due to questions about the bill's rape and

incest provisions.

HR 36 now says that to obtain a post 20-week abortion the following conditions apply:

A woman must be given a consent form, stating the abortion must be done in the way "most likely to allow the child to survive," unless this would cause the woman's death, or permanent impairment of a major physical body function. (Not psychological/emotional).
If the pregnancy resulted from rape of an adult woman, and at least 48 hours before the abortion, she must either have rape counseling, *or* be treated medically for the rape, or rape-related injury. (The counseling can't be at an abortion providing facility, hospitals excepted).
If a minor is pregnant due to rape, the minor must have reported the rape/incest to law enforcement or a government child abuse agency.

The 'Born Alive' act applies. If the abortion victim could live outside the womb, a neonatal doctor must be present, treating the child like they're expected to live.
Post 20-week abortions and (unplanned) live births must be reported to the National Center for Health Statistics.
The woman or parent can sue doctors who break the law.

On 6/4 the NRLC reported: Sen. Lindsey Graham (R-SC) has announced that he will introduce the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act in the U.S. Senate the week of 6/8/15. This bill would extend general protection to unborn children nationwide beginning at 20-weeks fetal age, based on congressional recognition that by this point in development, if not earlier, the unborn child is capable of experiencing pain.

NOTE: HR 36 has rape exceptions and is not considered by some to be truly "pro-life". Other pro-life advocates believe HR 36 will prevent the killing of a majority of pain-capable babies who would otherwise be aborted after 20 weeks gestation and view this legislation as an incremental measure.

FYI: The pro-abortion Emily's List PAC has listed 20 pro-life House members for defeat in 2016. Lee Zeldin [R-1st CD] is one.

Life News - 3 - July/August 2015 NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

As of this writing, with only a few days left of the 2015 NYS Legislative Session, there have been no

significant pro-abortion measures passed. We have the now embattled Senate Leader Dean Skelos to thank for that.

A new and dangerous Assisted Suicide Bill, The Patient Self-Determination Act S.5814 (same as A.5261B-Paulin), has been introduced by Senator Bonacic [R]. On 6/4/15, S.5814 was referred to the Senate Health Committee. Title of the bill: An act to amend the public health law, in relation to patient selfdetermination at end of life. Purpose of the bill: is to provide that a physician who prescribes in compliance with the provisions of the article medication to a terminally ill patient to be self-administered for the purpose of hastening the patient's death will not be subject to civil or criminal liability or professional disciplinary action.

Reversing a lower court's ruling, the Second Circuit Court of Appeals has deemed, by a 2 to 1 margin, that **Choose Life license plates are "patently offensive."**

Voter registration is imperative if you want your voice to be heard. Registration can be in the following major parties in New York: Democratic, Republican, Conservative, Green Party, Working Families, Independence, Women's Equality, Stop Common Core. Most of these parties have a declared position on life issues, although individual candidates may or may not line up with his/her party's position. It is important to find out where a candidate stands, individually. If none of these parties are to your liking, you may also register as an Independent, which is not the same as the Independence party. Registered Independents may vote in general elections, but not in party primaries.

Reminder:

--At Street Fairs speak to elected officials and those seeking office to ask how they will vote on pro-life issues.

--Refuse photos with pro-abortion representatives as the photo may be used in promotional mailings prior to elections.

HEALTH & SCIENCE Vaccines Made From Aborted Babies

Debi Vinnedge reports in the May/June 2015 issue of American Life League's *Celebrate Life Magazine* that, for over 50 years, pharmaceutical companies have been producing vaccines using the remains of aborted babies. Some people have rationalized this by arguing that it was only two abortions, and they were done so long ago, or that no new abortions are needed to produce the vaccines today. Vinnedge states, "these claims are grossly erroneous and don't solve any problems for parents trying to protect their children from disease without compromising their religious or moral convictions."

According to Vinnedge, "data recorded as early as the 1930's reveals that hundreds of babies were sacrificed to find suitable cell lines for virus cultivation used in polio and rubella vaccine research. Eventually, two cell lines, both taken from the lung tissue of electively aborted babies, came to be used in vaccines for measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR); chickenpox; Hepatitis-A; and shingles; in addition to some polio and rabies vaccines."

Vinnedge explains that scientists have known for quite some time that these cell lines will "age and die off, thus needing replacement." It **is** possible for the vaccine manufacturers to use an alternative source. However, Vinnedge states that since "the industry perceives widespread acceptance of these vaccines, it has no intention of doing so. Instead, other aborted fetal cell lines are emerging and are currently being used in clinical trials to develop vaccines for diseases such as Ebola, Hepatitis-A, rabies, flu, Marburg, and Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib), and they will eventually replace the earlier cell lines."

Forty eight states allow religious exemptions from vaccination. As a result of the measles outbreak at Disneyland earlier this year, several states were considering legislation to eliminate these exceptions, "until, in at least four states, concerned parents informed state officials about vaccines made from aborted babies' tissue."

Vinnedge also reports that prior to 2009, "Merck, the sole manufacturer of MMR and chicken pox vaccines in the US, provided morally acceptable separate vaccines for measles and mumps, but has since stopped." Vinnedge's organization, Children of God for Life (COG), is "urging legislators, parents, and physicians to request that Merck again provide the morally produced separate vaccines. It will take massive protest - especially from physicians - to sway Merck."

Research is being conducted by Sound Choice Pharmaceutical Institute to find other avenues for obtaining morally produced vaccines. Children of God for Life is also involved in an effort to obtain US licensing of a Japanese MMR vaccine which is currently not approved by the US Food and Drug Administration. At this time, US residents must travel to Japan to received it. Vinnedge writes, "We won't rest until we have safe, effective, and moral alternatives for parents."

In October, 2014, Children of God for Life wrote letters to the FDA, NIH, NIAID and Department of HHS regarding the use of aborted fetal cell lines in the Ebola vaccines under development. In November, COG reported that they "received a pathetic and erroneous response from the FDA." COG wrote a followup letter pointing out the following:

*the Ebola vaccines in question by GSK/NIAID, NewLink Genetics and Johnson & Johnson/Crucell, are using HEK-293 and PER C6 aborted fetal cell lines

*[the FDA letter] stated that these cell lines have a proven track record of safety when in fact, HEK-293 and PER C6 are currently not used in any vaccines licensed in the US

*the moral cell lines being used by Tekmira and the University of Texas are Vero cells- which do have a proven track record of safety as they are used in polio and rabies vaccines in the US

*there are 47 FDA licensed vaccines in the US, 8 of which are produced using aborted fetal cell lines. Of those 8 only 3 do not have a moral option anywhere in the world: chickenpox, shingles and ProQuad (MMR + chickenpox). To say that 'an inability to use these cells [aborted fetal] would deprive the US of important vaccines' is simply, not true
