

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

On April 7, a Federal District Court ruled in *Louisiana v. FDA* that the state, and Rosalie Markezich (pressured and threatened by her boyfriend to take

abortion pills he mail-ordered from out of state) have standing, and are likely to prevail. Judge D. Joseph wrote the harm was due to the Biden Administration's COVID policy, which allowed the pills to be mailed. While letting mifepristone remain available, the Judge said, "FDA has an obligation to act with all deliberate speed to...address the deficiencies it has acknowledged" and finish the safety review in 6 months.

Family Research Council (FRC) stated mifepristone is the sole product of Danco Labs, one of the largest manufacturers of mifepristone. FRC cited a 2023 LA Times piece, noting that Danco has under 20 employees, lists a PO Box, but no address, town, CEO, board members or investors, citing "security and harassment concerns". When mifepristone was approved in 2000, the FDA redacted government employee names and Danco locations.

On May 1, a 5th US Circuit Court of Appeals panel ruled that Louisiana would likely win *Louisiana v. FDA*, and thus mifepristone again required in-person dispensing. The next day, Danco Labs and generic drug maker GenBioPro filed emergency "administrative" suits against the 5th Circuit ruling. GenBioPro's CEO, Evan Masingill, called it a "baseless attack on an essential medication". Media and activists claim it's as safe as Tylenol, Viagra or penicillin. But *lifeneews.com* reports two studies show 1 in 10 women who take the abortion pill will visit an ER in the aftermath. On May 4, SCOTUS issued an 'administrative stay' that overrode the ruling by the 5th Circuit. Thus, mail order access to mifepristone is restored, for now.

Senate bill **S.4066**, *Safeguarding Women from Chemical Abortion Act*, to ban the use of mifepristone, now has a House companion bill, **HR.7902**. At the April 11 meeting of United for Life NY in NYC, Abby Johnson (former PP clinic manager), said pro-lifers weren't ready for what came after *Dobbs*, but the pro-abortion side was ready. They moved right into pill abortions. Abby warned that banning mifepristone will NOT stop chemical abortions. There are already protocols for misoprostol-only abortions. Misoprostol is legitimately used in obstetrical care, such as treating miscarriages. She noted that Abortion Pill Reversal wouldn't be possible with misoprostol only abortions. [Some online articles claim APR might still be possible, but only in a few, rare circumstances.]

In 2022, New Jersey's then-Attorney General Platkin subpoenaed First Choice PRCs for 28 kinds of documents, including donor lists, charging the PRC with false advertising. On April 29, SCOTUS ruled 9-0 that First Choice had standing, and its First Amendment rights are burdened by NJ's demands. The next day, current NJ Attorney General Davenport, claimed SCOTUS had only ruled on standing, not merit, and asked an Essex Co. judge to lift the 'stay' and allow New Jersey's subpoena for the documents to be enforced. (No ruling as of May 7.)

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

Part K of Gov. Hochul's proposed budget bill (S9005A/A10005A) includes provisions to establish 25-foot "buffer

zones" around 'reproductive healthcare' facilities and houses of worship to prohibit protests that "alarm and annoy" within that radius and to prevent 'harassment' of patients, staff, and worshippers. The zone would apply to hospitals, clinics, and other 'reproductive health' centers, as well as houses of worship.

The NY Civil Liberties Union and other organizations argue that the policy is unconstitutionally broad, stifling peaceful, lawful free speech on public sidewalks. Planned Parenthood and other abortion activists are concerned that the broad nature of the bill may lead to legal challenges weakening existing, narrowly tailored 'clinic access protections.'

NYS Right to Life stated, "a free society combats bad speech with good speech. It does not use governmental power to limit speech deemed too controversial or offensive...Supreme Court precedent shows buffer zones to be constitutionally controversial...The specific wording... 'with intent to alarm or annoy' - ... Who determines what the motives of the protesters are? This provision endangers the free speech rights of pro-lifers..."

On April 9, Anthony Gestone was admitted to the Nassau University Medical Center (NUMC) with critical injuries following a car accident. NUMC physicians said his brain was "not viable" and wanted to perform an apnea test – a critical part of the final clinical steps in determining brain death. Anthony's mother filed an emergency petition on April 17 stating that her son was still alive and that such tests would violate her religious convictions. The petition claimed that for 9 days, the hospital failed to provide him with any nutritional support, undermining any clinical assessment of Anthony's neurological state. The family observed "repetitive movement in response to touch and provided video evidence. The hospital stated there had been "no appreciable evidence" of brainstem activity since April 10. NUMC's "Brain Death and Termination of Mechanical Support" policy states that if a family raises a religious or moral objection, the hospital may continue ventilator support "as a reasonable accommodation" for up to 72 hours after death is declared. The family requested at least 14 days, stating the window was insufficient for their religious needs. The court temporarily blocked the hospital from performing the tests. The stipulation allowed the family to have their own neurologist examine him. The hospital agreed not to conduct a brain perfusion (SPECT) test until after the evaluation. Parties returned to court the following week. On April 28, the court gave the family 24 hours to transport him to another facility before the test was performed at 5 PM Wednesday, April 29. Transport was considered dangerous and no alternate facility was found. He was taken off life support April 29.

Take to the Seas by Francesco Posillico (student at St. Pius V HS)
First Place Winner - 2026 Pro-life Oratory Contest

Imagine you have spent your entire life living on solid land. You wake up every morning and feel the ground beneath your feet. You are safe. You are stable. But now I want you to visualize this:

You wake up and you're in the middle of the ocean, no safety, no support. There you are, ferociously treading water, alone, exhausted, and scared. I want to illustrate this metaphor with a true and personal story which has affected my life and the life of others around me.

A young girl, let's call her Lisa, was a devout Catholic for as long as she could remember. She had structured her life on the strong and fortified foundation of land. Then one day she was thrown into the middle of the ocean. You see, Lisa found herself pregnant, due to unfortunate circumstances.

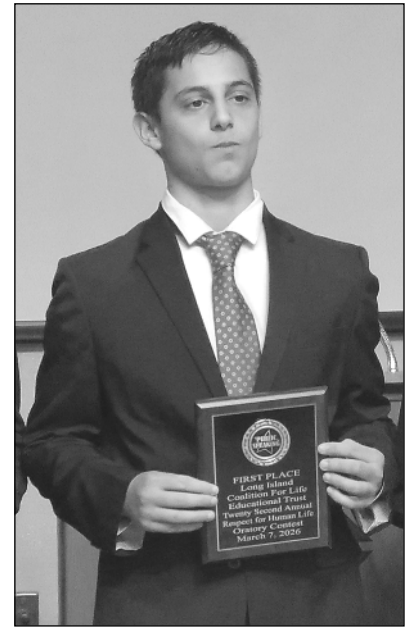
Now, what does society tell a woman in this situation? Society tells you that when you are drowning, it's not worth the fight. They tell you that you are owed freedom, that you are entitled with a "choice." They whisper: "There is no life at stake." There is nothing worth fighting for. Just relax. Just let your head go under the water." They promise that if you surrender to the pressure, all will be calm. But what society doesn't tell you is that when you put your head under, it doesn't result in freedom, It results in death.

So there Lisa was, fighting to keep her head above the water. She battled the anxiety, but she slowly succumbed to the exhaustion and the pressures of society. And as she walked towards the parking lot of a Planned Parenthood, the water was just about to raise to the tip of her nose, until, she saw my uncle's hand reach out. My uncle is like a rescue-man. He is on a rescue boat traveling through the water, straying directly towards the storm. Going head first to find those who are drowning, those who are going through incredibly difficult times. He spends hours outside in the cold, trying to console parents, all while people disrespect him and his mission.

Now, although Lisa didn't speak any English and my uncle didn't speak any Spanish, no words were needed, she felt pure hope and safety from the touch of his gentle hand. My uncle hoisted Lisa on board. He brought her to the Life Center Of Long Island, where he introduced her to Juana, a Spanish speaking expert, who welcomed Lisa with compassion and respect. Lisa then agreed to an ultrasound hearing, where she witnessed the miracle of life concerning her 11-week old baby. In that critical and emotional moment, Lisa's natural, implanted motherly instinct came to life. Right then and there, Lisa didn't just see a clump of cells. She saw her son. She broke the surface of the water. She took a breath of reality. She understood that she could choose the beauty and grace of her future, and that the only way to defeat the darkness and intensity of that "unfortunate circumstance" was to answer it with the defiance of God's greatest gift, life. And on the verge of drowning she chose to swim. She chose life.

Now, a couple years later, Lisa started attending our family events. During this last Christmas, I sat down next to Lisa's child, who we will call Miguel. I looked down at him, at his bright eyes, his energy, his ability to love, and I realized I was looking at a miracle. I was looking at beauty that had risen from the ashes. I realized that if my uncle hadn't been there at Planned Parenthood, saving children, had he not reached out his hand on that rainy day, this boy would not exist. The world would be darker. The water would have won. And sadly, in most abortion instances, the water does win.

There are people around you right now who are struggling to keep their heads above water. Society is telling them to give up. To throw it all away. We must not stand for this. And if you've learned anything from this speech, I ask you, take to the seas! Be the hand that reaches out. Be the person, who has the courage to pull them to shore. Be like my uncle. Offer the alternative of what society offers, hope and life. Swim directly into the storm, directly where conflict is, directly towards the highest waves. Because when you do, you too can save someone from drowning. Even if you think you are scared, we must do this. As one of my favorite writers once said, "Even if you are not ready for the day, it cannot always be night."

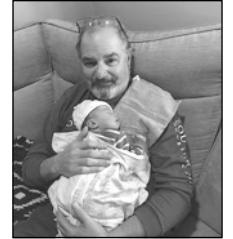

Lobby in Albany

Shown here are some of the participants with the Long Island Coalition for Life's lobby trip to Albany on April 21, 2026. Teams of 2 to 4 walked through the Legislative Office Building and the Capitol building visiting the offices of more than 160 legislators (senators & assemblymembers). Although many legislators were at meetings, the LICL representatives also spoke with many aides and interns. The staff are important as they act as a resource (and 'filter') to the legislators. We provided information on the bill the LICL opposed (S2533A), which has the stated purpose "To improve the accessibility of abortion medication." Why bother lobbying? The NYS Dept. of Health statistics for induced abortions in NYS in 2023 (about 70,500) show that upwards of 25% of pregnancies in NYS were terminated by induced abortion. Is it fair, then, to ask legislators who might vote for abortion expansion bills, how many abortions do they think NYS ought to reach such that we need laws to increase access to abortion-inducing procedures or drugs?
