Dear Pro-Life Friend,

Thank you, thank you, thank you I'm starting this with thanks because the Long Island pro-life community is to be congratulated for the overwhelming support given to our appeals for help to fight partial-birth abortion.

Thanks to your financial support we have been able to buy radio air time for nearly two hundred ads, have been able to mail over 61,000 informational letters, have been able to send several bus-loads of Long Islanders to Albany to lobby, and have been able to create, copy, collect and deliver petitions containing tens of thousands of names to our legislators.

Thanks to the work of hundreds of volunteers we were able create scripts and find radio stations willing to broadcast them, were able compose, print and mail our letters, were able to fill our buses, and were able to get those petitions circulated, signed, and delivered.

Though the vote in Albany didn't come out the way we would have wished, we won a great moral victory. The closeness of the vote, 73-71, by which the motion-to-discharge failed, indicates that the Assembly members were feeling great pressure from their constituents to vote to ban partial-birth abortion. That many legislators who voted against the motion-to-discharge found it necessary to make deceptive justifications for their vote, and that Speaker Silver has offered his own bogus bill regarding partial-birth-abortion, attest to the effectiveness of your efforts.

This battle is not over—as the anthem of the civil rights movement stated: "We shall overcome." Our efforts are forcing so many people to finally understand the damage wrought by all abortion, not just to the innocent pre-born but also to their misguided mothers. With God's help we will persevere and we will surely succeed.

And that gets me to our current need to press on with **all** our pro-life work. Because of our focus on partial-birth abortion over the last several months we have neglected to provide for our other programs. Funds raised to combat partial-birth abortion will be used strictly for<u>that</u> purpose. Unfortunately that leaves us underfunded in other important areas.





NEW YORK STATE

The Partial Birth Abortion (PBA) ban fight is not over as Assemblyman Patrick Manning continues efforts to have his bill to ban PBA, bill A.8875, voted on before the Assembly ends their 1998 session (on approx. July 1). Unless a vote is taken on the Manning bill this session, the April 8 vote on Manning's "Motion-to-Discharge" will be our guide as to who voted for or against continued use of the partial-birth abortion procedure in NYS.

PLEASE SAVE LEGISLATIVE PAGES

We often receive calls from readers whose daughters, granddaughters, nieces or friends have been told by their OB-GYN that they "have" to undergo some form of prenatal testing to rule out fetal deformities. First of all, no mother is REQUIRED to have any fetal testing against her will. Take it from this writer - you can refuse a prenatal test. I have had several charts with "AFP TEST REFUSED BY PATIENT" and "AMNIO REFUSED BY PATIENT" written in red on the top!

We must explore the reasons for prenatal testing. Is the test being performed for therapeutic (to cure or preserve health) or preventive (to prevent an adverse condition) purposes? Is the technology available to cure or preserve the health of the child once the prenatal test has confirmed the condition? Or are these tests done just to search and destroy? If an "unfavorable outcome" is the test result - that is, a child with a

physical or mental handicap - will abortion be the only solution offered?

There are two kinds of prenatal testing - invasive and non-invasive. Non-invasive procedures are those that do not "invade" the uterus or amniotic sac. These include ultrasound (sonograms) and maternal blood tests such as Alpha-Fetoprotein (AFP) and the newer Ultra-Screen. Invasive procedures include amniocentesis and chorionic villus sampling (CVS).

Amniocentesis is done between the 14th and 18th week of pregnancy. During amniocentesis, a doctor, using ultrasound, inserts a needle through the abdominal wall of the mother into the uterus and withdraws about an ounce of amniotic fluid. Labs grow fetal cells in the fluid for several weeks, and examine the cell for chromosomal abnormalities (karyotyping). The major risks of amniocentesis include maternal hemorrhage and infection, fetal puncture wounds, pneumothorax (injection of gas into the mother's pleural cavity), laceration of the baby's spleen, damage to the placenta and/or umbilical cord, death of the baby by exsanguination (loss of blood), and risk of miscarriage (from .5 to 2.0%). Amniocentesis was a strictly therapeutic innovation for use in late pregnancy and in labor before the March of Dimes mounted its "preventing birth defects" campaign. In a September, 1978 letter to all members of the House of Representatives, March of Dimes President Charles L. Massey stated, "The financial cost of treating and institutionalizing our severely affected survivors is staggering, we cannot begin to measure the cost..." His letter cites Sickle Cell Anemia, Cooley's Anemia, Tay-Sachs Disease, Down Syndrome, Muscular Dystrophy...as diseases which could be reduced through genetic screening and prenatal diagnosis. The only current way to "reduce" these diseases is to abort those identified in the womb with these diseases!

Chorionic Villus Sampling is done earlier in the pregnancy at about eight weeks gestation. A doctor uses a plastic catheter to clip villi (hairlike structures) from the placenta. Chromosomal test results are available within a week. The risk of miscarriage is greater with CVS - from 1 to 5%. The Lancet, England's medical journal, reported on February 20, 1993 that there was an increase in transverse limb reduction defects in children who had undergone CVS in utero.

Dr. Jerome Lejeune, geneticist, reported on the findings of Drs. Foidart and Schaaps in 1991 of a chamber of liquid that reduced the concentration of oxygen coming from the mother so that the amount of oxygen in the baby's blood is significantly less. After three months gestation, the baby apparently does not need this protection, and the liquid chamber disappears, and oxygen is diffused directly across a single membrane into the baby's blood. Dr. Lejeune theorized that limb defects occur after CVS testing because some of the mother's blood - containing much higher oxygen levels - comes in contact with the baby's blood, causing blood clots in the tiny vessels of the baby's body which could stop development of the fingers, toes, arms, and parts of the brain.

Non-invasive tests such as maternal blood tests (AFP and Ultra-Screen) and ultrasound are considered "screening tests", not diagnostic tests, according to Terrence W. Hallahan, laboratory director of NTD, a Long Island birth defects testing company. Positive results of these tests "indicate the need for other, more conclusive tests, such as CVS and amniocentesis."

So, if you are approached by a woman who is confused about whether she should undergo prenatal testing, tell her to ask herself several questions: Will the test harm the baby in any way? Will the test harm her in any way? Can anything be done to help the child in utero such as fetal surgery for very rare conditions? Will the test help to anticipate a difficult delivery or the need for emergency surgery immediately after birth? All the risks to the child must be taken into account. Or is the test being performed for the sole purpose of counseling the woman to abort her "less than perfect" child?

CEMETERY OF THE INNOCENTS

The Cemetery of the Innocents is a reverent peaceful memorial to the unborn. It consists of small white crosses representing babies sacrificed to abortion. There are 150 crosses, one for each baby killed by surgical abortion each week in Nassau and each week in Suffolk County. 
