#### PLANNED PARENTHOOD

- As incredible as it may seem, most Americans do not know that Planned Parenthood does abortions. A recent caller to Stop Planned Parenthood (STOPP) Headquarters said that her group placed a billboard in town that simply says: "Planned Parenthood performed 153,367 abortions in 1996." She said that message caused quite a stir and informed a lot of people on PP's activities.

- Planned Parenthood takes in \$184 million a year from fees at its clinics. \$50 million of this from abortions, \$120 million is from the sale of birth control devices, most of which cause chemical abortions, and only \$14 million is from other services. So PP's surgical and chemical abortions business makes up more than 90% of their clinic income.

- Planned Parenthood announced in 1993 a plan to have 2,000 facilities by the year 2000, but the number of their facilities has fallen from 938 to 900. Its number of birth control customers is the lowest since 1992 and its total abortion business has declined.

#### PARTIAL-BIRTH ABORTION DATA RELEASED-NUMBERS DISPUTED


On December 11, 1998, for the first time ever, the Alan Guttmacher Institute (AGI, The research arm of Planned Parenthood) estimated the frequency of partial-birth abortion method in the U.S. Adjusting for the non-response rate of abortion facilities, AGI projects that 14 facilities provided a total of about 650 partial-birth abortions in 1996, with the majority provided at 20 to 24 weeks of pregnancy. Stanley Henshaw, Deputy Director of Research for AGI, told the New York Times, "The numbers aren't exact, but I'm pretty sure it's in the 500 to 1000 range." Douglas Johnson, Legislative Director for the National Right to Life Committee, told the Times that the numbers were low, and likely did not include responses from the clinics and abortionists who use the procedure most.

#### LEGISLATIVE WATCH



#### FEDERAL LEGISLATION

Due to the 106<sup>th</sup> session of Congress beginning January 1999, there have not been any pro-life proposals introduced as yet.

It is very likely that Congress and/or the U.S. Supreme Court will take up the ban on partial birth abortions in the 106<sup>th</sup> session due to mounting popular pressure on Congressional and State Legislatures.

Consider what occurred in the last session of Congress with respect to partial birth abortions (PBA). On July 23, 1998, the House of Representatives overwhelmingly passed the ban on PBA by a vote of 296-132. The House showed conclusively its support of the ban by supplying 10 votes over the necessary 2/3 vote to override President Clinton's veto. However, the U.S. Senate in their majority vote in support of the ban was 3 votes short of the necessary 2/3 vote to override the President's veto. This 3 vote spread appears to be reduced to 2 votes with the net gain of one additional pro-life senator in the November '98 elections.

While Congress was attending to its ban on PBA, 25 states successfully passed bans on PBA in their own legislatures modeled after the Congressional wording. Of these 25 states, seven states are actually enforcing the ban. These states are: S.D., Miss, S.C., Ind., Va., Tenn., and Okla. However, 18 of the remaining states have temporary restraining orders prohibiting them from enforcing the ban. In fact, in Arkansas, Montana, New Jersey, Ohio, Florida and Kentucky, federal district judges have declared the ban unconstitutional. These cases are on appeal in the Federal Court of Appeals.

Encouraged by the Wirthlin Worldwide Election Day exit polls that show 73% of the American voters support the ban on PBA, as well as the support of Congress and State Legislatures, we welcome the challenge to bring our case to ban PBA before the U.S. Supreme Court.

#### NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION



"CLINIC ACCESS" BILLS ALREADY INTRODUCED. Before the 1999 State Legislative Session opened on January 6, 1999, bills intended to increase criminal penalties for those found to be blocking access to abortion clinics had already been introduced: "The Health Care Facilities Anti Violence Act" (S.32) and "The Access to Public Places Act" (S.33).

In November Governor Pataki announced that he would be proposing legislation "to make it a state crime to block a person's access to a health care facility." He also announced that he would be forming a new Task Force "to ensure that women and their doctors have free, and safe access to health care facilities."

It is important that all pro-life persons and organizations voice their concerns about such measures to the Governor, state legislative leaders and their state representatives.

Considering that Governor Pataki supports "Clinic Access" legislation and the pro-abortion record of the majority of Assembly members, the best hope of defeating this duplicative and discriminatory legislation is probably to lobby for its defeat in the State Senate.

#### **HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT**

#### EMBRYO FARMING AND HARVESTING

During the week of 11/6/98, it was reported that two teams of scientists isolated and cultured the first healthy human embryonic stem cells outside the body that are capable of developing into different types of human tissue. The scientists from the University of Wisconsin used stem cells from "leftover" or "spare" 6-day-old frozen embryos (blastocysts) from infertility treatments and donated by the progenitors (biological parents). The Johns Hopkins research team used cells from the tissue of aborted embryos. Evan Snyder of Harvard Medical School also announced that he had isolated the brain's version of stem cells, which can differentiate into all three types of brain cells in an adult. These cells were dissected from the brains of aborted fetuses. The usual procedure used to obtain brain cells or tissue is the cannula technique in which, as described before Congress by Rep. Chris Smith, a living fetus, in-utero, has its brains aspirated through a cannula before a Dilation and Evacuation (D&E) abortion is performed.

The primordial human stem cells used in these experiments are called "parent" cells that later become the nerve, muscle, heart and other tissues of the developing embryo. The researchers are attempting to understand how these stem cells differentiate into specific cells so that they can develop them for use in therapeutic transplantation such as dopamine-containing nerve cells for Parkinson's patients, pancreatic islet cells which make insulin for Diabetes patients, heart muscle cells that could be injected directly into the heart to build up failing tissue, and bone marrow and kidney cells.

We see here, then, not only the earliest stage of life being destroyed (aborted), but renewed worries about human cloning, genetic engineering to manipulate or enhance offspring, and unscrupulous attempts to create human-animal hybrids for lab work or "creativity". South Korean scientists recently reported that they cloned a human embryo and destroyed it at the 4-cell stage during their stem-cell research.

A Congressional ban has been in place since 1995 which prohibits government funding of experiments using human embryos if they are subject to risk of injury or death, unless the experiments are therapeutic in the best interest of that particular embryo. However, there is an exception which allows a human being to offer himself for research, even if it won't benefit himself, but will benefit mankind. How can an embryo make that decision? Someone else can do that for the embryo as a beneficiary for mankind. There always seems to be a loophole!

In the US, we have a National Commission for the Protection of Human Subjects of Biomedical and Behavioral Research, but their recommendations cover only post implantation embryos and fetuses. How convenient that the recommendations and regulations don't cover the time period involving Morning After/ Emergency Contraception Pills or ex-utero pre-implantation embryos such as those developed through in vitro fertilization (IVF). The fertilized ovum that has been flushed from a woman before implantation is also not protected. This results in little oversight by the government or scrutiny by the public. It also means that funding comes from private enterprise, usually biotech companies which can operate outside the bounds of ethical science. Many, we are sure, are not going to consider the moral implications involved with the destruction of one life in saving another. To quote the president of the Biotechnology Industry Organization, "If something is technically possible... then it is likely to happen sometime, somewhere."

We mentioned at the beginning of this article that this research involved the stem cells from "leftover" or "spare" embryos from fertility treatments. A "web" report noted that spare embryos are generally inferior to those that fertility doctors implant. Imperfect embryos might not "work" in an experiment. "As a result, a number of biotech firms are using anonymous gamete donors," according to Gary Hodgen of Eastern Virginia Medical School. (Gametes are mature eggs and sperm.) Companies fertilize the gametes with each other and we have "embryos to order, and the beginning of Orwellian embryo farming". Other scientists acknowledge that this procedure exists. Kevin Fitzgerald, geneticist and Jesuit priest, states "I just don't think the public knows how much of this is going on." As Dr. Jerome Lejeune, world-renowned geneticist and life advocate once told us, "Just because something can be done doesn't mean it should be done!"


