PLANNED PARENTHOOD TEEN CONFERENCE VIOLATES STATE HEALTH ED REGULATIONS

By allowing their High School Student's participation in Planned Parenthood's Teen Health Conference, off campus, during a school day, School Boards/Principals and Educators are in direct violation of NYState Commissioner's Regulations Subchapter G, Section 135.3 (c) (2) (i), which states that "... appropriate instruction concerning... (AIDS) Shall stress abstinence as the most appropriate and effective premarital protection against AIDS, ... (and) such instruction shall be given during an existing class period using existing instructional personnel."

This year, nineteen Suffok County H.S.'s have allowed 55 'teens to be trained by Planned Parenthood, after school hours at their Smithtown Abortion mill as an Advisory Board to recruit fellow students to attend PP's Teen Health Conference on Friday, April 23 at the Wyndham Wind Watch Hotel, Hauppauge (Tele 516-232-9800). FEDERAL LEGISLATION



EXPERIMENTATION USING HUMAN EMBRYOS:

The ban on federal funding of destructive embryo experiments has been in effect since passed by Congress in 1995. There is a strong effort by this administration as well as by the National Institute of Health (NIH) and several reform groups to oppose the ban and write their own legislation.

The National Abortion and Reproductive Rights Action League (NARAL) a large pro-abortion organization announced on 1/22/99 that rescinding the federal ban on destructive embryo research is one of its top priorities for this year.

Writing in the NRTL News, 4/14/98 and 2/19/99, Richard Doerflinger of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops states, "Cloning must not be used to produce a new generation of human embryos with the status of laboratory mice created solely to be destroyed". Harvesting these cells from a human embryo kills the embryo.

PRO-LIFE ALTERNATIVES TO EMBRYO RESEARCH:

As some researchers and politicians press for stem cell research requiring the destruction of human embryos new scientific evidence suggests that such abusive action is unnecessary. In January, researchers made three announcements concerning progress toward regenerating and replacing diseased or damaged human tissue that does not require harvesting cells from unborn children:

- (1) Researchers have developed an enzyme, telomerase, which can keep tissues growing almost indefinitely.
- (2) Researchers have developed a gene therapy that can help patients grow new tissue.
- (3) Ongoing research raises the possibility that stem cells from a patient's own tissue might be used in the future to create whatever type of tissue may be needed by that patient.

LETTERWRITING: (Sample Letter)

Dear Representative/Senator _____: You are urged to continue the ban enacted in 1995 which prohibits the use of federal funds (1) to create human embryos for research purposes, and (2) for research in which any human embryos are destroyed, discarded or knowingly subjected to risk of injury or death.

Please, if you have not already done so, add your name to the list of Senators and Representatives who have already voiced opposition to lifting the ban.

In January of 1999, researchers announced progress toward regenerating and replacing diseased or damaged human tissue that does not require harvesting calls from unborn children. These alternative methods include use of the enzyme telomerase and are outlined in the 2/19/99 issue of the *National Right to Life News*.

THE INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION FOR GENETIC RESEARCH VS. THE MARCH OF DIMES BIRTH DEFECTS FOUNDATION



The Michael Fund is the popular name for the International Foundation for Genetic Research. It came into being to be a voice for the unborn, especially those affected by inborn diseases. The Michael Fund is a 100% pro-life foundation, funding only life-giving research, a clinical medical protocol, support services, medical referrals and networking adoption services for babies born with handicapping conditions.

A few months ago we wrote about the involvement of most well-known foundations who fund and support by lobbying fetal experimentation and research. We also attempted to enlighten you on the harvesting and use of "stem cells". Now, the National Institutes of Health are pressing for the exclusion of stem cell research from the Congressional ban on funding embryo/fetal research. They use the argument that stem cells can be harvested "pre-embryo" or before implantation. Unless the fertilization and development of the zygote is done in vitro (outside the womb), how could anyone be sure the harvesting is pre-implantation? If the harvesting is always done in vitro, wouldn't that be developing an embryo expressly for the purpose of research—which is prohibited under the Congressional ban? Donna Shalala, Secretary of Health and Human Services, announced that federal scientists will continue plans for embryonic stem cell research despite arguments by members of Congress that the studies would violate the federal ban.

Based upon past experience and present knowledge, you can be assured of two things concerning plans to bypass the ban: 1) The Michael Fund will fight this devaluation of life aggressively; and 2) most popular and well-known foundations will support it.

Support of the foundations' pursuit of stem cell and embryo/fetal research often comes from those affected by birth defects or handicapping conditions. They think, especially due to media hype, that this research is the best present hope for their cure. To quote Mary Meehan ("A Good Charity is Hard to Find"), this exploitation of the defenseless pits one disadvantaged group, the disabled, against the most disadvantaged and defenseless group of all, the unborn. Moreover, it detracts attention and money from other medical research that is ethical and that may prove more helpful to the disabled. We can easily observe this by comparing The Michael Fund and the March of Dimes Birth Defects Foundation (MOD).

The March of Dimes began in 1938 as the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis (polio). One of the oldest medical charities, the MOD is a major cause of the decline of medical ethics. In 1958, "still reeling from a bad corporate conscience and massive cover-up concerning the 'effective, safe, and potent' Salk Inactivated Poliomyelitis Vaccine, a vaccine which turned out to be inadequately studied, seriously flawed and prematurely introduced, the MOD stated it would become a new conscience for America by extending its purview from poliomyelitis to birth defects." We heard very little about the victims of this hurried polio vaccine distribution or the part the MOD played in it. (See "An Untold Vaccine Story," H. Ratner, M.D., *Child and Family*, Vol. 20, 1988; *A March of Dimes Primer*, Randy Engel.) By the 1970's, the MOD funded the use of fetal tissues and organs of aborted babies for research. One of the studies funded at that time involved 60 pairs of embryonic kidneys obtained from abortions after 5 to 12 weeks gestation. They funded research that involved the removal of reproductive organ systems obtained by D&C abortions of pre-born baby girls up to 10 weeks gestation and prostaglandin abortions at later gestation. This followed with additional funding of experiments using the reproductive tract of male fetuses that were grafted on to mice. Similar testing was then repeated with female fetal reproductive tracts. Later funding involved the use of third trimester prostaglandin-induced abortions, which we know provide live births. The funding by private foundations such as the MOD has allowed non-therapeutic fetal research to flourish and bypass the federal bans on funding live fetal non-therapeutic experimentation.

Solving the problem of birth defects by destroying those affected is utterly opposed by The Michael Fund, as is the sterilization of those carrying inheritable diseases to avoid future carriers. In contrast, the MOD has been the major institutional force behind the development of prenatal testing to detect such handicaps as Down Syndrome, spina bifida, cystic fibrosis, muscular dystrophy and many others. They set up genetic testing centers across the nation.

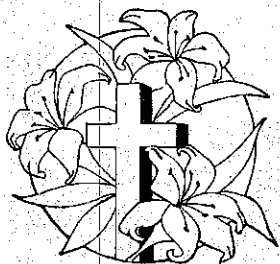

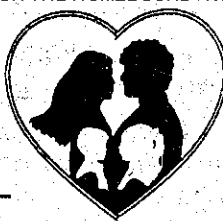

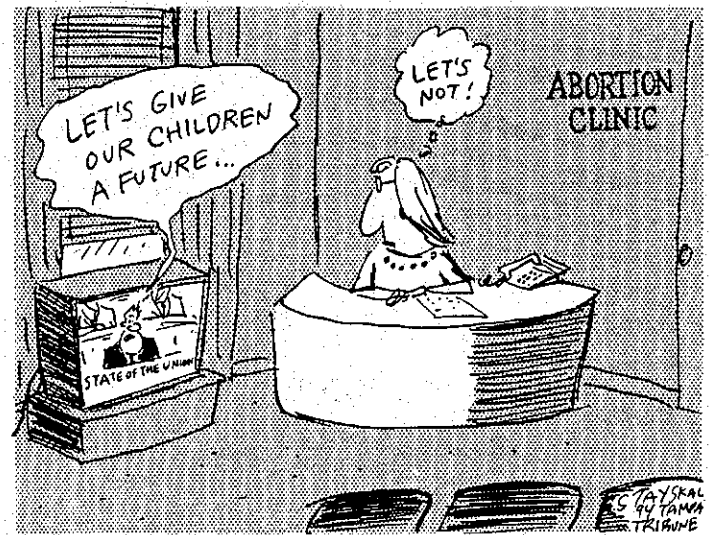
USAID Funding for Family Planning vs. Progress

The total present worth of USAID population control expenditures since 1964 has been \$10,679,523,000 in current (February 1997) dollars. If this money had been reallocated towards infrastructure construction in developing countries, it would have at least:

- Built 50,000 miles of roads & bridges connecting 20 thousand remote villages (access to goods & services).
- Built 30,000 well-equipped basic health care clinics in remote villages (delivering health care to millions & greatly reducing maternal and infant mortality).
- Built grain storage facilities for 20,000 remote villages (to reduce famine).
- Built & staffed modern schools to properly educate millions of rural children.
- Brought electricity & clean drinking water to 2,000 of the most remote villages (greatly reducing the source of most disease & increasing productivity).

We cannot 'take back' the more than 10 Billion dollars that have been squandered on population control and reallocate it to authentic economic development. However, we can reallocate this year's USAID funding to purposes that will strengthen entire nations, instead of merely turning big poor families into small poor families.

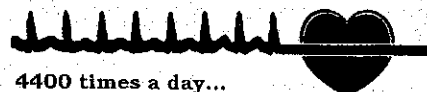

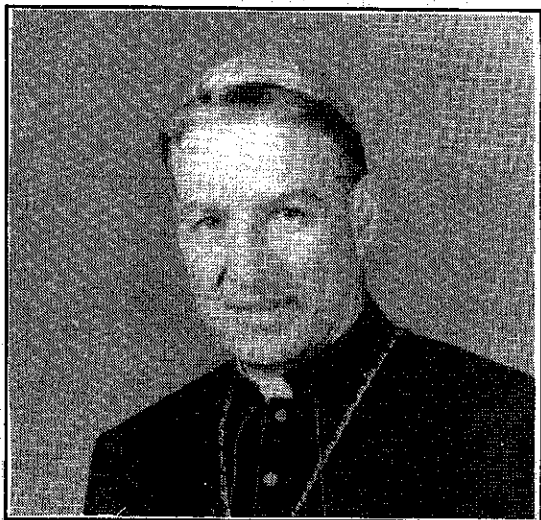
