
MORE ON "PILL BILLS"

LEGISLATIVE WATCH

NEW YORK STATE



The CLINIC ACCESS/ANTI-STALKING BILL (S.6004) passed in the NYS Senate on 6/17/99. Sadly, all Nassau/Suffolk Senators voted for the bill. We must urge the Assembly to vote against S.6004.

Dear____Please oppose the Clinic Access/Anti-Stalking
Bill (S.6004). This bill is overly broad, discriminatory,
and unnecessary as a Federal law already exists. Please
reply.

Letterwriting: (to your NYS Senate Member)

Dear I am deeply disappointed with your vote on the Clinic Access/Anti-Stalking Bill S.6004. Intentionally blocking access to an abortion clinic or threatening clients and staff are already crimes under the federal FACE Act. Clearly this was a political exercise and the first time the Senate caved in to the pressures of extreme abortion advocates. How can the Senate explain its one-day consideration and passage of this bill when months after their introduction the Health Committee still has not acted on the Parental Notification and Women's Right to Know bills? Please reply.

INFERTILITY BILL (S.3131) would result in destruction of human embryos in the laboratory and killing of "excess" fetuses in the womb.

Letterwriting: (to your NYS Senate Member)

Dear___Please vote against the Infertility Bill S.3131-A. This legislation will result in the destruction of many human embryos. A second serious effect would be a burdensome rise in health insurance premium costs.

LI Newday, in its editorial of 6/28/1999 which opposes this legislation, stated "Estimates of the impact on annual insurance premiums are all over the map: From as little as \$3 per policy to the \$20 suggested by proponents of the mandate to as much as \$96". At present over three million New Yorkers are without adequate health insurance. The majority are working people with minor dependents. No insurance plan, individual or employee should be compelled to offer or pay for a plan contrary to his or her own beliefs. Some of the assisted reproductive technologies covered by the bill, including in vitro fertilization and embryo transfer, routinely include the creation and destruction of living human embryos. Please reply.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

ONE VOTE MAKES THE DIFFERENCE—On 5/20/99, by a vote of 51-49, the U.S. Senate refused to allow performance of abortions on U.S. military medical facilities. Senators Moynihan and Schumer voted to allow the abortions.

RU 486-THE ABORTION PILL—On 6/8/99, by a vote of 217-214, the House of Representatives voted to prohibit the Food and Drug Administration from granting approval "for the chemical inducement of abortion," such as the RU 486 abortion pill.

TEXAS AND FLORIDA PASS PARENTAL NO-TIFICATION BILLS—In June of 1999, both George W. Bush, Governor of Texas, and Jeb Bush, Governor of Florida, signed into law a requirement that parents must be notified when an unmarried girl under 18 years seeks an abortion. At the bill signing, George W. Bush expressed his desire for an America where "unborn children are welcome in life and protected by law".

HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT ORGAN TRANSPLANTS



Whatever could be wrong with pursuing a method to successfully transplant a healthy organ for a diseased one? Ethics are often put aside, especially when the patient is a loved one. But what does transplanting actually entail?

Recently, ABC TV News had a segment titled "Growing Organs In The Lab". They reported that 63,000 people were awaiting organs for transplant surgery. Research doctors were interviewed who were growing organs from a patient's own organ cells. This is certainly an ethical endeavor. Unfortunately, organs are not as yet obtained through this method. Many unethical practices are employed for research and transplantation. These include selling newborns to obtain their organs, slicing open a partially-born baby to harvest their organs, and keeping anencephalic babies (born with total lack of the cortex, the upper brain, and lack of skull closure) alive so that their organs can be fresh for removal. California's Loma Linda Hospital Research Center kept newborn anencephalic babies alive for this purpose. When a call came in for an organ, they would cut out the living infant's organs, killing the child and enabling the hospital to sell a fresh organ.

In 1990, Dr. Mark Evans, at the annual National Medical Association meeting in Las Vegas, proposed that a new legal definition of death should be "brain absent" so that a newborn anencephalic baby would be considered legally "dead at birth" so that their organs might be harvested for transplantation. A California State Senator introduced a bill that read, "An individual born with the condition of anencephaly is dead." The CA, OH, and NJ state legislatures tried to go one better by attempting to pass bills allowing the "harvesting of all organs from live handicapped babies"!

Annually, in the US, at least 100,000 preborn babies are used in research. Flow Labs of Rockville, MD is one of the fetal organ dealers in the US. Twelve countries and more than 250 suppliers are involved with Flo Lab's tissue trading. Over 12,000 babies were killed to supply the "fresh" kidneys that were shipped from South Korea's Seoul University to the US.

"In July 1988, authorities arrested 6 Paraguayan men for plotting to sell 7 male newborn infants in the US for the purpose of organ 'harvesting'... They testified that they had been doing this for years, and that the practice was 'common'. These men merely sold the babies to middlemen, who transported them to the US in the arms of women hired to act as their mothers (the babies flew free of charge), and then delivered them to un-

named firms in the US. According to the men, there was no shortage of demand in the US for healthy babies whose ultimate fate was to be killed and then cut up for parts." (*The Facts of Life*, Brian Clowes, PhD)

In past articles we reported on how Partial Birth Abortion (Dilation & Evacuation Abortion—D & E) is used to obtain organs. A video interview by Mark Crutcher and Dzintra Tuttle of Life Dynamics with Eric Harrah, who worked with several different abortion providers, including the "largest abortionist in this country", verifies the connection between partial-birth abortion and organ harvesting. Mr. Harrah was asked why proabortionists fight so viciously to keep partial-birth abortions when other methods are available. Mr. Harrah stated that with other procedures you have nothing to sell. To maximize profits, you have to have a whole, live baby. Abortionists get \$300-\$800 for an abortion, and then get another \$200-\$300 for an intact body. This is a multi-billion dollar industry—a conglomerate in selling fetal tissue. "That is why the procedure is so protected-not for the woman's right to choose."

Eric also explained how clinicians become so desensitized that they play ball with the fetuses, use them as puppets, stand them around the room and disengage legs like a turkey wishbone. How could anyone become so unfeelingly profane?

The Life Dynamics video also contained an interview with a person who works for a company that purchases fetal organs and has a team of "dissectors". The company has a contract with abortionist clients to go into the clinics on certain days to obtain the tissue. They scavenge only perfect baby specimens. The gestational age is from 7 to 30+ weeks. The dissector said that most times the baby's heart is still beating. Mostly eyes, livers, brains, blood from the heart and other sources and thymus are harvested. The abortionist is given a "wish list", and will often alter the abortion procedure to protect the organs needed that day. Sometimes a perfect, intact fetus is requested. This dissector, now a "Spy for Life", said that seeing aborted 24 week gestational-aged twins alive and gasping for air changed his/her attitude.

How can anyone justify these inhumane practices? How dare these people call themselves doctors! (Mary A. Nicholas, M.D., author of the booklet For Mother and Child is writing a book on partial-birth abortion which will contain documentation on the D&E procedure and organ harvesting.)



"God has blessed me with a long life...During that lifetime I have formed a clear perception of the absolute sanctity of life and the unshakable conviction that, of all God's gifts, it is the most precious... and is becoming the most tenuous."

Presently LIFE ATHLETES is a coalition of more than 200 athletes committed to leading lives of virtue, abstinence and respect for life and inviting others to do the same. Members include professional, Olympic and college teams within the United States and from around the world. Chris Godfrey, is president of LIFE ATHLETES and has spoken on Long Island at several pro-life events.




