## CLINTON JUSTICE DEPT. PRODDED FBI IN ATTEMPT TO CRIMINALIZE PRO-LIFERS

Judicial Watch, a watch dog organization, claims that for nearly 2 years, Janet Reno's justice dept. pushed the FBI to gather information on and monitor the activities of peaceful pro-life organizations and individuals.

The claim was made based on whistle-blower information and material it found in FBI documents obtained under the Freedom of Information Act.

Judicial Watch president Tom Fitton says his group filed its FOIA request after receiving a tip from an angry source at the Washington FBI office.

The FBI tipster complained that agents were pressured, against their will, by the Justice Dept. to look into pro-life groups with no known history of anti-abortion violence, or connection to clinic attackers.

When the N.Y.Post asked if the allegations were true, an independent FBI source replied: "What do you think? This is a highly political, highly corrupt administration." The investigation, named VAAPCON (Violence Against Abortion Providers Conspiracy) was ordered by the Justice Dept. after the 1994 passage of the Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrance Act (FACE).

The Justice Dept. wanted to snare pro-life

extremists attacking abortion clinics and providers, hoping to prove a national criminal conspiracy.

After months of monitoring pro-lifer's mail, phone calls and activities and finding nothing, the FBI wanted to drop it. But the Justice Dept. officials insisted they keep going. VAAPCON lasted another year, ending after 16 months with no conspiracy detected.

It was learned that many FBI agents felt that abortion-rights supporters in the Attorney General's office crossed an ethical line out of eagerness to damage the pro-life movement.

"The (FBI) people who were running the abortion investigations were very solid and thoroughly disgusted by efforts to use the agency this way," the Post source said.

"They wanted to go after pro-life groups as domestic terrorist organizations. The Bureau resisted," said the source. "That's the way they look at the world: Anybody who opposes us is a potential domestic terrorist." (emphasis added) Much of the VAAPCON information is still being kept secret. "Remember, we've only got a paltry amount of these documents," says Fitton. "Well over 100,000 of them continue to be withheld." Source: Rod Dreher, N.Y. Post 7/2/2000

#### LEGISLATIVE WATCH

NEBRASKA'S BAN ON PARTIAL BIRTH ABORTIONS (PBA) MISSES BY ONE VOTE. On 6/28, the U.S. Supreme Court, by a 5 to 4 decision struck down Nebraska's ban on PBA. The Court's ruling is far from the final word as the decision applied only to that state's law.

Justice Stephen Breyer's opinion for the majority declared that the Nebraska law wording was too vague and imposed an undue burden on a woman's right to abort her own child.

#### HOW THE JUSTICES VOTED:

Voted to continue PBA: Breyer, Ginsburg, O'Connor, Stevens and Souter.
Voted to ban the PBA procedure: Rehnquist, Thomas, Kennedy and Scalia.

Prior to the Court's ruling, 30 other state legislatures had passed bans on PBA some of which were enjoined (prohibited by law), while other states' bans passed the scrutiny of lower courts. Since 1995 the U.S. Congress has passed the ban on PBA three times. Each time the bill has reached Pres. Clinton he has vetoed it.

The Court rationalizes its acceptance of PBA from its already drawn conclusion that nothing will ever infringe on its imperious (dictatorial) Roe vs. Wade, Doe vs. Bolton decisions which legalized abortion throughout the entire nine months of pregnancy.

<u>USA Today</u>, 6/29/00, quoted Wanda Franz, Pres. of NRTL "The outrageous ruling ensures that partial-birth abortion and the extremism of the Supreme Court majority will be major issues in the presidential election."

#### NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION RECAP

Before the N.Y.S. Legislature adjourned, the Assembly Health Committee, chaired by Assemblyman Richard Gottfried (D.N.Y.), considered and killed six pro-life initiatives. Among them was "The Woman's Right-to-Know Act", the "Fetal Assault and Homicide Bill"; and a proposal to require parental notification for minors seeking an abortions. Each of these bills had wide public support and might have become law if they had been voted out of committee and afforded a chance for debate on the Assembly floor.

WHAT CAN WE DO? Between now and the opening of the next legislative session in January, we will have many opportunities to educate and influence others at campaign events.

- 1. Make others aware that N.Y.S. law clearly specifies that only those abortions which are medically necessary qualify for funding. Yet in N.Y.S. approximately 40% of abortions were Medicaid funded. (This compares with 14% of tax payer funded abortions in the U.S.)
- 2. Despite statements by Attorney General Reno (in the Elian case) that parental rights are the cornerstone of United States law, our teenagers as young as twelve and thirteen may be declared destitute and issued Medicaid Cards and brought to abortion clinics without parental notification. The Supreme Court has declared parental consent laws to be constitutional.
- 3. Pro-abortionists worship "choice" ignoring the fact that in abortion the innocent baby has no choice, but neither does the woman have a choice when she is denied information regarding the development of her baby, the effects of abortion on her physical and emotional health and the alternatives to abortion. It is a sham to preach choice when this information is withheld from the woman.

## HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT THE GENOME AGE



On June 26, 2000, a White House press briefing was called to announce the completion of a "rough draft"—a 97%-completed map of the entire human genome, all the DNA strands in the 46 chromosomes found in human cells. President Clinton said, "Today we are learning the language in which God created life. We are gaining ever more awe for the complexity, the beauty, the wonder of God's most divine and sacred gift." This from the man who supports fetal experimentation and partial birth abortions??? The Human Genome Project, begun in 1990, is a multibillion dollar effort funded primarily by the US government to sequence some 3.15 billion "letters" or chemical bases of the DNA code. President Clinton said "...It will revolutionize the diagnosis, prevention and treatment of most, if not all, human diseases."

Dr. Edmund Pellegrino, professor of medicine and medical ethics at Georgetown University stated that the genome mapping exemplifies "the kinds of problems we'll be facing continuously in the future...How do we use our knowledge wisely and within ethical constraints?" James Walter, professor of bioethics at Loyola Marymount University, Los Angeles, brought up the slippery slope argument—"The scientists will always convince us to get on the slope, saying 'We're going to use this for humane ends, we're going to cure disease.' But the same technology we use to cure disease is the technology we will use to engineer ourselves. How do we stop at curing, and not move on to engineering?" These warnings cannot be ignored. Geneticist Hayden says, "I've had several conversations with people who said that with prenatal tests we can wipe out the gene in a generation or two merely by not allowing any fetus at risk to be born." Geneticists Holding and Mark state "Preimplantation diagnosis could allow identification of normal and mutant embryos and the replacement in the mother of only those embryos shown to be free of the defect." The Genome Project findings make for an even more in-depth and informed diagnosis of birth defects plus "undesirable" hereditary traits than our present prenatal testing.

Dr. Linus Pauling, who has received the Nobel Prize twice, has suggested that those who carry "dysfunctional genes" have the information on their disabilities tattooed on the foreheads! Dr. Cecil B. Jacobson, chief of Reproductive Genetics, George Washington University Hospital said, "I can't imagine any reasonably responsible person arguing against the abortion of mongols...If we could tell what fetuses are going to be affected with cancer in their 40's or 50's, I would be for aborting them now."

Recent gene therapy treatments have been not only disappointing, but dangerous and even fatal at times. The Federal Drug Administration uncovered evidence of 691 adverse events, of which 652 were not reported to authorities. A brief TV report stated that 20 children with brain cancer may have been accidentally exposed to the AIDS and hepatitis C viruses through gene therapy.

Dr. Leon Kass stated, "Moral progress has not kept pace with scientific progress." Randy Engel of the Michael Fund warned of the dangers involved when there are commercial interests. She would not be surprised if in the future it would be advised that all embryos be inspected prior to implantation. A class of "subhumans" could be used for projects such as space exploration.

Bishop James T. McHugh identifies the problems we must

face: "...respect for the human person, privacy concerns, a real effort to benefit everybody and not just certain segments of the population, ...respect for the human embryo...There's a tendency to look at some embryos as research specimens rather than to recognize that each embryo is a human being with a potential for full development."

Most people agree that gene mapping could be used to identify and cure/correct defects. The causes of 80% of birth defects are unknown. Also, a forewarning of the predisposition to a disease could lead to earlier detection and therapeutic efforts to ward off effects. For example, ground-breaking surgery on unborn babies with spina bifida is being done at Vanderbilt University Medical Center.

However, we know how advances can be used unethically. Amniocentesis was developed as a strictly therapeutic innovation to handle detected problems that had cures such as rH factor, anemia, etc. We all know how this test has become a "search and destroy" weapon on the unborn. Half of all children with Down Syndrome are now killed in the womb. Dr. Carlo Valenti, of Brooklyn's Downstate Medical Center, a frequent speaker at March of Dimes-sponsored genetic symposiums, stated "...Although I would welcome an alternative to the abortion of a defective fetus, I reluctantly conclude that abortion must remain the solution to inheritable disease."

One of the abuses that could occur with gene identification is in the field of medical coverage and insurance and employment. Employers could use this information as a means of screening for jobs. Some insurance plans already refuse to pay for deliveries or care of infants with genetic defects if the parents do not accept amniocentesis and abortion to "select out the 'defectives' who have serious birth defects. Protective legislation must be introduced. A balance must be achieved between protecting against discrimination resulting from the revelation of information from genetic testing and employer's rights to dismiss employees for unacceptable performance/behavior. In The Facts of Life, Brian Clowes warns that as "prenatal genetic diagnosis becomes easier, the temptation will arise to use it for less severe genetic aberrations...young couples...would be able to select the height of their children within certain limits... other traits affecting intelligence, athletic or musical ability, even personality would become matters of parental choice." Thus we will have gone from curing disease to engineering a human being, as warned by Dr. Walter earlier in this article.

One leading genetic researcher boasted "(Scientists) have the right to exercise their professional activities to the limit...as lay attitudes struggle to catch up with what scientists can do." Our Sunday Visitor (July 9, 2000) states, "Like the Internet... genetic manipulation is already outpacing our abilities to control its excesses and evaluate its impact. To those who say that technology and science must go where they will, we point to the bloody creations of the 20th century. Control over the decisions resulting from these discoveries cannot be given exclusively to scientists or businessmen, any more than they can be given to generals or politicians...(we must) defend the integrity and sanctity of every human person. The moral quagmires that await will one day make abortion seem like the most paltry of quandaries. And, as in the case of abortion, we may find ourselves one day in a eugenics hell of our own making."



TOXOPLASMOSIS: What pregnant women should know

Toxoplasmosis is an infectious disease found in some farm animals and household pets. If infected, cats are a carrier of the disease and could possibly transmit it to humans & the unborn child. Although cats can transmit the disease, they are not the major source of infection to humans. People are more likely to pick up toxoplasmosis by handling raw meat or not cleaning up thoroughly after handling the meat. Prevention of toxoplasmosis is easy by following these simple steps: M Someone other than a pregnant woman should clean the cat litter every day. M. Wear rubber, disposable gloves when cleaning the litter box and wash thoroughly afterwards. M. Feed cats dry, canned, or cooked food & keep them from hunting. M Wash or cook homegrown vegetables that may have come in contact with cat feces in the garden. M. Cook meat thoroughly. Wash hands and anything else that comes in contact with the raw meat such as cutting boards, knives & the sink. M. Cover children's sandboxes when not in use & dispose of any contaminated sand. 

Abortion stops a beating heart





On Sunday, June 18, 2000 Newsday ran its weekly feature titled:

Long Islander of the Century: Our Everyday Hero

From the photo above, many will recognize the subjects Jack and Winifred Eschmann to be the heroes. Because the article was subtitled "Helping Long Island's Homeless", their pro-life accomplishments were not mentioned. Newsday stated, the Eschmanns are active members of the Bellmore community as well as volunteers of the St. Vincent de Paul Society at St. Barnabus Catholic Church. Jack's fund raising enabled them to open Anthony House in Roosevelt, a residence for men in crisis. Next they founded Dismas House in 1988, a halfway house for men released from prison. The Eschmanns raised money for different projects in the Domincan Republic. Jack has also traveled there, at his own expense, leading other volunteers to do the actual work of rebuilding, reforestation, and water purification projects.

Jack is vice-president and board member of the Life Center, has participated in Operation Rescue which resulted in his arrest more than once, and is a committee member of the RVC Diocese Procession for Life. Like many pro-lifers, his and Winnie's deeds prove the lie of the often quoted, "All pro-lifers care about is the unborn baby".
