

PLANNED PARENTHOOD'S CUSTOMER LOSS

Halting PP's Sex Ed Programs Seen As Ending Its Influence

Even as Planned Parenthood is racking up record profits, it is experiencing a severe decline in support from the American people and in customers through its front doors. The latest PP's Annual Report presents a picture of an organization on the verge of major problems. For the last five years, PP has been losing ground on a number of fronts. To understand this decline, it is important that we take a few minutes to review how PP operates. As we have pointed out many times, PP has a three-step program for getting into any community or country. Its first step is to promote sex education programs. These programs are often hyped as ways of reducing teen pregnancies or sexually transmitted diseases. But the result of these programs is always to increase the demand for PP's products - particularly birth control products. Following the implementation of PP's sex education programs, there

is a growing demand for birth control and PP then becomes the area's largest provider of birth control for women. This business is so important to PP that it has historically measured its affiliates by the number of female birth control customers (FBCC) that affiliates has. The third step is to provide surgical abortion. The demand for the abortions comes from the failure of PP's various birth control methods. STOPP has long maintained that the way to put an end to PP's influence is to cut off PP's sex education programs. Our contention is that taking that action will automatically reduce its birth control customers and that will lead to a lowering of its abortion business. Evidence from this year's PP Annual Report supports STOPP's approach. The report showed that PP is continuing a nine-year trend of reduced attendance at its sex education programs. ~ The Ryan Report June/July 2000

NEW YORK STATE

THE SAFE HAVEN BILL was signed into law on 7/18. Hopefully this bill will reduce the number of dead or abandoned infants by protecting parents from facing charges of abandonment or endangerment if they leave an unharmed infant up to five days old in a safe haven such as a hospital, a police department or even at a neighbor's house. The parent must alert an "appropriate person" so that authorities can immediately assume responsibility for the baby's care. Suffolk County had passed a resolution earlier this year requesting state wide safe haven legislation.

ARE YOU REGISTERED TO VOTE?

Register in person at your County Board of Elections (Suffolk-located in Yaphank, phone 631-852-4500 or Nassau-located in Mineola, phone 516-571-2411) or by mail. Forms are available at your Post Office or DMV. You must be registered to vote from your current mailing address and forms must be postmarked no later than 25 days before the election in which you want to vote. This form may be used to order absentee ballots.

PRIMARY DAY IS TUES. SEPT.12, 2000. What is a primary?

Background: Early each year the political parties chose a candidate to represent their party for each office to be voted on in November.

Next: Any party member not satisfied with the party's designated candidate may decide to run for that office and present to the Board of Elections the required number of signatures of other party members designating him/her to run. The exception is in the Independence Party where party affiliation of a person signing the petition is not a factor.

A Primary Vote must be held in every race where two or more candidates seek the same line on the November 7 ballot. Consequently, a Primary allows the underdog his/her opportunity to be heard and to run in November, and is a very important pro-life tool. Check the following list for Primaries in your party in which you are eligible to vote. Ask the candidates' stand on the life issues and please get out the vote in that race.

HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT

STRAIGHT FROM PRO-ABORTION COMMENTARIES: PART 1



We are aware of 13 different medical and legal terms for both intentional and spontaneous abortion. "Therapeutic abortion" is the present terminology medical literature uses in reference to legal abortion. But, Webster says therapeutic is the treatment of disease or disorders. Most of us do not view abortion as a treatment. It is the destruction of life-killing. Pro-abortionists have expended great effort over the years to have pregnancy considered a disease. Dr. Alan Guttmacher, a national advocate of abortion rights and former Medical Director of Planned Parenthood Federation of America (PPFA), said, "The birth control pill ... is an important prophylaxis, perhaps the most important, against one of the gravest sociomedical illnesses extant. That of course is unwanted pregnancy." Dr. Mary S. Calderone, another former Medical Director of PPFA and President of SIECUS, said, "We have yet to beat our public heated drums for birth control in the way we beat them for polio vaccine; we are still unable to put babies in the class of dangerous epidemics, even though that is the exact truth." Abortionist Warren Hern has said, "Pregnancy is an epidemic, moderately extended, chronic condition ... and may be defined as an illness ... treated by evacuation of the uterine contents." He also describes pregnancy as a "host-parasitic relationship." Now they have the U.S. Center for Disease Control in agreement with them that pregnancy is a disease. When pro-abortionists are having a "wanted baby," do they feel they are diseased?

The California Medical Journal carried the following message by pro-abortion strategists: "Since the old ethic has not yet been fully displaced, it has been necessary to separate the idea of abortion from the idea of killing, which continues to be socially abhorrent. The result has been a curious avoidance of the scientific fact, which everyone really knows, that human life begins at contraception and is continuous, whether intra- or extra- uterine, until death ... "About 20 years later, with society more brainwashed, Faye Wattletom, past president of PPFA said, "I think we have deluded ourselves into believing that people don't know that abortion is killing. So any pretense that abortion is not killing is a signal of our ambivalence, a signal that we cannot say yes, it kills a fetus, but it is the women's body, and therefore ultimately her choice." So then, does that say that women who have abortions are killers? When Ms. Wattleton was president of PPFA, she was quoted in a Los Angeles Times article, "We are not going to be an organization promoting celibacy or chastity. Our concern is not to convey 'shoulds' and 'should nots' but to help young people make responsible decisions about their sexual relationships." And, if they become pregnant, they can decide if they want to be "killers" or not and all without fully informed consent and parental involvement. In a Mission and Policy Statement by PPFA, "Planned Parenthood opposes any limitation or restriction on the access of adolescents to confidential reproductive health services, including contraception and abortion." And so we are breeding a generation that has been informed they have a right to kill another human being they are responsible for conceiving. So, why stop there?

The Pro-Abortion Alan Guttmacher Institute did a study on 1,900 women in 38 states who were going to have abortions as to why they were aborting. The so-called hard cases of mother's health, rape, incest and fetal deformity were the reason for only 7% of the abortions.

Three women died soon after Dr. Robert D. Crist performed abortions on them. Patty Brous, president of Planned Parenthood of Mid-Missouri and Eastern Kansas made this statement about Dr. Crist, "one of the most skilled and compliant and committed physicians performing abortions." Dr. Michael Burnhill, PPFA vice president of medical affairs said, "Only a handful of physicians in the country have his expertise, particularly in second-trimester abortions." That must make the families of those three women feel better! Like the mother of Belinda Byrd who died three days after abortionist Stephen Pine perforated her uterus. She was his 74th abortion of the day! Abortion is a money-making business and the woman's well-being is as expendable to an abortionist as the baby is. Abortionist Lise Fortier said. "Each and every pregnancy threatens a woman's life. From a strict medical viewpoint, every pregnancy should be aborted." Abortion doesn't threaten a woman's health and life?

Warren Hern, abortionist and author of the much used book *Abortion Practice* says, "in medical practice, there are few surgical procedures given as little attention and so underrated in its potential hazards as abortion. It is a commonly held view that complications are inevitable." As many as 100 women currently die from legal abortions in the U.S. every year. A recent study shows it is much more dangerous to have an abortion then for normal child-birth.


In the beginning of this article we told you there were 13 different medical and legal terms for abortions. There are also many different types of surgical abortions which vary generally due to the gestational age of the baby because of the size and texture of their tissue that must be cut through. In past articles we described all the procedures and the complications the mother will face. Next month, in Part 2 of this article, we will describe, in the abortionists' own words, how they are performed along with the abortionists' observations of the effects of their methods on the babies they are killing.

CARDINAL CRITICIZES VAGUE USE OF 'CHOICE' FOR ABORTION

Los Angeles (CNS) - The archbishop of Los Angeles, Cardinal Roger Mahony, has criticized politicians' use of the phrase "a woman's right to choose" when what they mean is "a woman's right to choose to terminate her pregnancy, that is, to get an abortion."

"If political leaders are proud of the fact that they support the termination of a pregnancy, the taking of the life of an unborn baby, then why can't they simply say so?" he asked. "What's with all the wishy-washy 'choice' language?"

He suggested that political leaders and abortion advocates don't tell the truth "because they are trying to hide the reality of the inherent evil in abortion."

The cardinal made his comments in a column titled "Complete the Sentence, Please" in the Los Angeles archdiocesan newspaper. The column also ran as an op-ed piece in the Los Angeles Times.

Cardinal Mahony wrote, "'Choice' in American history and culture has become a precious heritage."

But as political races have been heating up across the United States, he said, he has become "increasingly confused and frustrated" by candidates proclaiming support for a woman's right to choose without saying what that choice is.

"Why do the media and the press allow political candidates to get away with this vague, meaningless 'choice' language – when they should be demanding that candidates finish the sentence?"

The cardinal said he suspects many political leaders use this "shadow language" because they "either don't support abortion and are afraid to say so, or because they want to pretend that a moral evil is somehow a moral good." And, he added, "the only way to make evil into good is to disguise (it), hide it. Bingo! Don't finish the sentence."

The cardinal said he is "vigorously pro-choice" because he believes in an individual's right to make choices in life and society. "But I sure want to specify what that choice is all about, and as a Church leader, to make certain that one is supporting a moral good in that choice," he added.

He said personally supports "a woman's right to choose a number of moral goods," including a husband, neighborhood, faith, community, school for herself and her children, and health care providers.

Said Cardinal Mahony, "I'm not afraid to name the choice, to finish the sentence."

The cardinal said abortion supporters cannot deny "there is a living being in the womb of the expectant mother," a being he called "precious and alive, not a choice."

He said he continues to question why political leaders and abortion advocates don't just speak the truth. "If they are so convinced that their position is good and valid, why can't they simply say aloud, 'I support the right of a woman to destroy her unborn baby?"

He suggested they may not feel comfortable with a position that has become "so politically correct," but are afraid to speak "what they might feel in their souls" for fear of losing votes.

"As we begin this new century and millennium, I would hope that all of us could be more honest and open with our beliefs, and our language that confirms and proclaims those inner beliefs."

Speaking those beliefs out loud could prompt more deeply through-out positions, he said, forcing everyone "to identify and weigh the moral good and the moral evil in our choices."

John Cardinal O'Connor: "Our faith traditions have a common denominator, and the principles of morality upon which our nation has developed are Judeo Christian in origin. It is together then that we must strive to create a culture of life and not of death."

Rabbi Moses Birnbaum: "If consciousness is raised regarding abortion on demand, I say that discussion is long over-due in the Jewish community."

Rabbi Barry Freundel: "We don't allow abortion under anyone's understanding of our sources, in cases where the child in inconvenient, is going to ruin a vacation, if the parents are unhappy with the gender of the child, or for economic reasons. All of this is clearly prohibited. It is simply not allowed by Jewish Law."

Rabbi Clifford Librach: "...I believe, concerning the fetus, that we should articulate a celebration of its *autonomy*, if we understand autonomy to be human uniqueness. Second, with respect to the fetus, we should recognize the *potential* of each life for creativity."

"In essence, abortion is judged to be the unwarranted taking of a life within a life and it is the same prohibition for gentiles as it is for Jews."






Russian Population in Decline: Another Crisis of Modernity




