PLANNED PARENTHOOD'S DECEPTIVE PROPAGANDA

Planned Parenthood (PP) has sent an invitation to Suffolk County High Schools to participate in their "Teen Health Conference", which will be held at the Wyndham Wind Watch Hotel, Hauppauge, on April 27, 2001. They are asking school officials to recommend students to be trained by PP as a Teen Advisory Board to recruit their peers to attend the conference.

The chief message of the conference is "Safer Sex". As people of conscience we must question the morality and safety of PP's "safer sex" message which has contributed to the rise in Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STD's). Now is the time to ask your School District to join the growing number of Suffolk Districts who do not participate in this annual conference.

PP's newest endeavor is the availability of RU-486 in the U.S. (Detailed information on its so-called safety—excessive bleeding, vomiting, etc.—will be presented at the next LICL meeting (above) and in *Life News* 12/00.)

You should know that many of the RU-486 trials were conducted at PP clinics. PP's major interest in the promotion of RU-486 is as another source of revenue to

fill their coffers. Use of RU-486 for abortion is a lengthy and expensive procedure. This engenders additional revenues to further PP's anti-life agenda in the Third World Nations and in the U.S.

It is ironic that PP, which has been touting the safety of surgical abortion, is now saying that surgical abortions are not good enough, and hail the availability of RU-486. Also ironic is that PP has consistently opposed a 24 hour waiting period prior to an abortion as an unacceptable burden, but now espouses a chemical abortion that is drawn out over three to four days, plus subsequent follow-up visits.

Lastly, one might question PP's amoral framework in supporting the manufacturer of RU-486, Roussel-Uclaf, a subsidiary of Hoescht AG., the successor to I.G.Farben, the producers of Zyklon B, used in the Nazi death camps as the "Final Solution". Now, in the year 2000 we face an unprecedented chemical assault on developing human life and PP calls it a victory. We have another way to kill preborns after practicing "safer sex".

BORN-ALIVE INFANT PROTECTION ACT Does a woman seeking an abortion have the right to a dead baby?

According to a New Jersey Federal Court she does. The Court in overturning the N.J. ban on partial birth abortions also ruled that it doesn't matter whether the infant is in utero or outside. Since the woman's intention was to abort her child, she had the right to dispose of (kill) that infant since it was unwanted. To date a number of babies have met this fate. Some of these babies have been found in soiled hospital linen, left on scales and tables unattended, without any nourishment, their hearts beating and limbs moving until death.

Congressman Charles Canady, R, Fl., saw the plight of these babies and introduced the Born-Alive Infant Protection Act, H.R. 4292. On 9/26/00 H.R. 4292 passed in the House by a near unprecedented vote of 380–13.

This Act would acknowledge that when a baby is born, it has intrinsic dignity and a claim to protection of law irrespective of whether it is unwanted. Those opposed to the Born-Alive Infant Protection Act include NARAL (National Abortion Rights Action League), Planned Parenthood, and Princeton University's Professor Peter Singer who advocates entitling parents up to one month to dispose of an unwanted infant.

Thank you for your letters and calls involving the passage of H.R. 4292 in the House.

THE FEDERAL DRUG ADMINISTRATION (FDA) APPROVES RU-486.

On 9/28/00 the FDA Commissioner, Jane Henney under pressure from the abortion industry, Planned Parenthood, NARAL, as well as President Clinton and V.P. Gore approved the harmful chemical abortion pill, RU-486 for use in the U.S. (See Planned Parenthood item on Page 2).

"Republican presidential candidate George W. Bush is opposed to abortion in most cases and scored the FDA's decision. Democratic candidate Al Gore favors abortion rights and supported the ruling" *Newsday*, 9/29/2000

Whether Congress or the next President will oppose the FDA's decision depends on both the election and your willingness in urging your U.S. Senators and Representatives to oppose Commissioner Henney's action.

HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT STEM CELLS



Stem cells and their possible cure-all properties have been the subject of many media reports and articles. Unfortunately, many of these have been very misleading. Who would not want a cure or therapy for diseased or damaged organs and body tissue? But, is that as far as it will go? Is life actually threatened by this therapy?

Stem cell research is a very complex issue. There are many moral and ethical decisions involved because an early embryo must be destroyed to obtain the totipotent or pluripotent stem cells before the developing embryo differentiates them into all its body cell types. Totipotent and pluripotent cells can form many body tissues. Multipotent cells can form blood and all its components. Unipotent stem cells only form tissue.

Stem cells can also be obtained from aborted fetuses, umbilical cord blood from newborns, various adult organs and tissues and even cadavers. Researchers are hoping to culture these cells into the specialized cells they need to regenerate or replace diseased or deteriorated tissue, organs, bones, cartilage, and hair. Researchers have very little knowledge of how to culture stem cells to comply with the way they wish them to differentiate. Much time and many steps must be taken.

Pope John Paul II said, "These techniques, insofar as they involve the manipulation and destruction of human embryos, are not morally acceptable, even when their proposed goal is good in itself." If adult stem cells are used from the patient himself and cloning is not used, it would meet with acceptable moral standards.

Embryonic stem cells also have immunological complications. The body can reject tissue grown from donated cells as well as organs.

Blood stem cells reside in our bone marrow and provide red and white blood cells throughout adult life. New findings with adult human stem cells show they may be coached to grow into organs, etc. In fact, many doctors say they may be more desirable! If the stem cells are cultured from the patient's own stem cells, the problem of immune rejection may also be circumvented.

Bishop James T. McHugh writes, "National Institutes of Health-funded researchers have published new evidence that adult stem cells from bone marrow can be directed to provide and 'abundant and accessible' supply of stem cells for transplant. This approach, according to the scientists, overcomes the ethical and immunological concerns associated with the use of fetal tissue."

Dr. Evan Y. Snyder of Children's Hospital and Harvard Medical School in Boston has conducted studies on mice that show that the neural stem cells will convert themselves into other kinds of brain cells when injected in the adult mouse brain. Michael Levesque, Director of Neurofunctional Surgery at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles commented on new ways to "regenerate"

and transplant a patient's own brain cells to treat Parkinson's and other diseases: "What we have is a protocol in which we don't have to harvest 12 or 15 fetuses, we don't have to give immunosuppressant therapy, and we don't have to worry about viral disease transmission."

Dr. David Prentice said, "Formerly it was believed that a person had all their brain cells that they would ever have at birth. Now we know that brain cells can replenish and migrate and be retrained." At a conference in August he explained that stem cells removed from faulty organs grew fine and healthy when away from the diseased organ and regenerated when replaced. He also discussed a case where normal corneal transplants didn't work, but the adult stem cells administered from the patient improved his condition.

Dr. Rajendra Bhatnagar, Professor at the University of California, San Francisco, reports that he has changed human skin and gum cells into bone and cartilage. Skin is not only the largest of our organs, but the most accessible. Skin could provide an unlimited number of cells without very invasive surgery. Dr. Bhatnagar says he can generate enough tissue from a snippet of skin or gum tissue—no more than a few cubic millimeters in volume—to fill a hole in bone or cartilage many hundreds of times that size. Because this comes directly from the donor, there is no risk of rejection. Clinical trials using this method have proved successful.

Research in this field is in its earliest stages. There are many unanswered questions about eventual outcomes of this technology in years ahead. Unfortunately, adverse effects may be the rule rather than the exception as greed, deceitful practices and disregard for patient safety are evidenced.

In order to obtain embryo stem cells, an embryo must die. It has been suggested that the reason organizations are supporting embryo cell research is that it is a popular way to gain acceptance of embryo research. It keeps open a way to experiment on embryos, and according to the Planned Parenthood web site: "Knowing she can donate her aborted fetus to potentially life saving medical research may help a woman turn an unintended pregnancy about which she may feel a sense of loss into a social good. The choice to donate fetal tissue often gives solace to women who may need to end their pregnancies." Let's hope this instrument of "solace" doesn't encourage a woman to abort who may otherwise have considered an alternative! Will all the people responsible for the staggering number of frozen embryos now be considered heroes if they donate them for research?

Moral reasoning seems to disappear with social acceptance!





Pro Life Pro Choice Answers Arguments

Argument: "I'm personally against abortion, but I'm still Pro Choice. It's a legal alternative and we don't have the right to keep it from anyone."

Answer: To be Pro Choice about abortion is to be Pro Abortion

Some people have the illusion that being personally opposed to abortion while believing others should be free to choose it is some kind of compromise between the pro abortion and pro life positions. It isn't. Pro choice people vote the same as pro abortion people. Both oppose legal protection for the innocent unborn. Both are willing for children to die by abortion and must take responsibility for the killing of those babies even if they do not participate directly. To the baby who dies it makes no difference whether those who refused to protect her were pro-abortion or merely pro choice.

What is Legal is Not Always Right

One of the weakest arguments for the legitimacy of abortion is that it is legal. Civil law does not determine morality. Rather, the law should reflect a morality that exists independently of the law. Can anyone seriously believe that abortion was immoral on January 21, 1973, and moral on January 23, 1973? If abortion killed children before the law changed, it continues to kill children after the law changed. Law or no Law, either
