BEWARE PLANNED PARENTHOOD'S DECEPTIVE PRACTICES

PLANNED PARENTHOOD'S SELECTIVE DATA APPROACH

At the 11/13/01 meeting of the Suffolk Network on Adolescent Pregnancy (SNAP), held at the Girl Scouts of Suffolk County Office Building located in Commack. Planned Parenthood's (P.P.) Education Director (Ed. Dir.) extolled the virtues of the adolescent sexuality programs utilized in Germany, Holland and France, and plans to present these at a major workshop to school educators for reducing teen pregnancies and sexually transmitted disease (STD) transmission.

P.P. believes these "model" programs should be emulated in the U.S. The presentation failed to mention the French experience. France has had an extensive confidential program of dispensing contraceptives in their schools for years, resulting in a substantial increase in teen pregnancies. French Health and Education officials are now dispensing emergency contraception (morning after) pills to teens as young as eleven, hoping to reduce the rising tide of teen pregnancies and lower its abortion rate, one of the highest in Europe. P.P.'s Ed. Dir. failed to mention that the French also "...have the highest venereal disease rate in Europe" (Human Life Review, Fall, 2001.)

Another "model" of adolescent sexuality education mentioned by P.P. Ed. Dir. was the Dutch model, of which, Lynette Burrows, a noted English educator and journalist, says "The Dutch Model of brilliance is one of deception and grand illusion. No one knows what the conception rate is among teens. Since the Dutch

specialize in 'menstrual extraction' as a means of preventing pregnancy and this procedure is not registered in official statistics." Several other factors are also never mentioned in the Dutch context, such as the fact that sexeducation there is not obligatory in schools, contraceptives are not handed out free by the school nurse, and no financial support is offered to any girl who becomes pregnant when unmarried. They are simply handed over to the care of their families." P.P.'s Ed. Dir. also failed to provide rates for STD's, Chlamydia or human papilloma virus (HPV).

In Germany, where sexuality education is also comprehensive, 63% of teens are using <u>hormonal</u> contraception which does not provide any safeguard against STD, and the emergency contraception provides the killing ground before implantation. Germany also does not allow abortion on demand, it only allows first trimester abortions.

At the SNAP meeting, P.P.'s Ed. Dir. noted that sexuality is a part of growing up and that the use of condoms was a sign of respect. If using condoms is a sign of respect and responsibility, why do we have the highest STD rates for HPV and Chlamydia, let alone AIDS?

In the final analysis, the comparisons are patently flawed. Our U.S. teen population is not homogeneous and many studies show that teen consistency in condom use ranges from 5% to 40%. Educators who swallow this deceptively lethal information are guilty of falling for P.P.'s "Grand Illusion" and are failing to protect their students from irreparable damage.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION



HUMAN CLONING DEBATED IN THE U.S. SENATE—UP FOR A VOTE SOON.

Action: Contact Senators with this message:

We urge you to support the ban on human cloning which passed in the House 265-162 on 7/31/01. So called "therapeutic cloning" results in "clone and kill" which kills human embryos for use in scientific research. Other sources of material for research not requiring destruction of live embryos are in plentiful supply and could be used.

The National Academy of Science Committee in a report released 1/18/02 (see Newsday 1/19/02), concluded "Human reproductive cloning... is dangerous and likely to fail" and should be subject to a legally enforceable ban.

In addition public polls have shown that over 85% of citizens oppose human cloning. You are strongly urged to support Senator Brownback's bill (formerly S.790, now S. 1899) to ban all human cloning.

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION FREEDOM OF RELIGION THREATENED

Once again we are asking you to take action to keep the agenda of the National Abortion and Reproductive Rights Action League (NARAL) from becoming law. If the "Women's Health and Wellness" bill becomes law it will narrow the scope of religious liberty and open the door for new mandates which will force hospitals and other agencies to provide morally objectionable drugs, devices and procedures. (Last year NARAL promised to spend \$40 million during the next four years to advance its agenda. In December NARAL specifically targeted New York State.) So far in the 2002 Legislative Session numerous bills with these mandates have been introduced in our state legislature. The most immediate threat is still the "Women's Health and Wellness" bill (A.2006.A/S.6265). It is still uncertain when or whether the Senate and Assembly will pass identical versions of this legislation. (Since both versions of these bills are unacceptable any compromise arrived at would almost certainly be unacceptable.)

If a compromise is reached and the legislation reaches the Governor he should be asked to veto the bill. (Call the Bill Status Hotline 800-342-9860 with the bill number for an update.)

Action--Sample message:

Dear.... I am not just concerned—I am outraged at the thought that NARAL, Planned Parenthood and other pro-abortion groups have for many years prevented bills restricting abortion from even being reported out of committee, while the "Women's Health and Wellness" bills, which contain anti-life provisions and violate religious freedom, were voted out of committee and passed in record speed. Both A.2006.A and S.6265 would require religious individuals, organizations and groups to violate their religious beliefs by forcing them to fund certain drugs and devices which act as abortifacients; they also represent a grave and unconstitutional encroachment by government into the realm of religion. Please help us free our state's agenda from the clutches of NARAL. Oppose these and other bills which violate our freedom of conscience. Are you willing to do this? Please reply.

THE MICHAEL FUND (INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION FOR GENETIC RESEARCH) WALKATHON 2002

The International Foundation for Genetic Research is popularly known as The Michael Fund. This foundation opened its doors in 1978, with world-renowned geneticist, Dr. Jerome Lejeune as Medical Director, and Randy Engel, President of U.S. Coalition for Life as Executive Director. The Michael Fund is the pro-life alternative to the National Foundation/March of Dimes that was in a decade-long battle with the pro-life movement

because of their funding of live fetal research that was inhumane, and their search and destroy policy (amniocentesis) as the cure for birth defects.

A number of March of Dimes (MOD) grantees have used aborted babies as a source of spare parts or fetal blood. A blood source was by "open-heart puncture of healthy ten week aborted fetuses. During the 1970's and 1980's, it was MOD's private foundation monies that permitted these researchers...to bypass the government ban prohibiting the use of federal funds for such non-therapeutic, lethal experimentation on live human fetuses."

In 1979, Long Island Coalition for Life looked for a way to fund this new, pro-life foundation, The Michael Fund. We suggested a walkathon, and from 1980 have held The Michael Fund Walkathon annually. We are n ow asking you to please consider joining us on May 11th for our 23rd Michael Fund Walkathon, at Wantagh Park, Merrick Road, Want agh, any time between opening ceremonies at noon to 3:00PM. The path is two miles long and may be repeated as many times as you choose and have informed your sponsors. You may walk, jog, skate, or come in your wheelchair. Help us fund life giving research, support systems, physician referrals for specific birth anomalies, adoption of handicapped children, breast -feeding and dietary management of children with Down syndrome, and physician resources on the management of Down syndrome patients. Studies have demonstrated that mental retardation, particularly that associated with chromosomal anomalies often are amenable to treatment. Dr. Paddy Jim Baggot's research has focused in on the time span in fetal development when retardation has not been observed and on early prenatal intervention treatment for these preborn children affected by chromosomal disorders. His three-year research grant project is Biochemical Analysis of Folate-Dependent Metabolites in Amniotic Fluid. His research results will be put into clinical practice shortly.

Dr. Marie Peeters Ney, Director of Medical Research, has worked with the International Center for Metaboli c Testing on nutritional and chemical supplementation for children with Down syndrome. She notes, the "preliminary study has documented a number of improvements in the health of children with Down syndrome. A significant improvement in immune function can at this stage already be affirmed. This study needs to be continued so that it be possible to evaluate neurological development." Unfortunately our White Plains clinic is no longer in operation. A search for a new location for clinic facilities has begun.

Much has been done. Much remains to be accomplished. Thank you for all you have done in the past; we beg and pray for your continued support.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

QUESTION: What is the Definition of "Abortifacient?"

ANSWER: The general definition of "abortifacient" is "a drug or agent that induces an abortion." An abortifacient destroys the preborn child who is already conceived. Depending upon the type of abortifacient, this killing can take place at virtually any stage of pregnancy, by preventing implantation of the blastocyst (the very early developing human being), by killing the unborn child shortly after implantation, or by killing the child later in pregnancy.
