
Dear Pro-Life Friend,

After nearly three years in the making, the Reproductive Choice Campaign of the Center for Bio-Ethical Reform (CBR) finally came to Long Island during the first week of May. For five days the two trucks with graphic depictions of first trimester aborted babies traveled the length of Long Island and made two forays into Manhattan. They were seen on the LIE, Nicolls Road, Route 110, Hempstead Turnpike, the Clearview and Cross Bronx Expressways, and from one end of Manhattan to the other on Amsterdam Avenue, Broadway, and the Avenue of the Americas, among others. Roads on the campuses of SUNY Stony Brook and SUNY Farmingdale were also traveled. Tens of thousands of people in their vehicles and on the sidewalks of New York have now seen what "CHOICE" really means: a mangled fully-formed tiny baby. We thank the members of the CBR staff, Mark, Rich, Fletcher, Erica, and Bill who manned the trucks, Long Islanders

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION



The current New York State Legislative Session is scheduled to end on June 20. We urge you to keep expressing your concerns to your legislators and/or Governor Pataki. Consult previous issues of LIFE NEWS for information on specific bills. Since it is late in the Session bill status often changes quickly. For this reason keep in touch with the Bill Status Line (800-342-9860). If an anti-life bill passes both Senate and Assembly, Gov. Pataki should be contacted as soon as possible to pressure him to veto the bill. Of course, if pro-life legislation passes both houses urge him to sign.

SENATE BILL S.7359

Sample letter:

Dear Senator I was very pleased to learn that on May 7 the Senate passed a bill (S.7359) which requires insurance coverage for drugs and therapies designed to help couples conceive naturally. This bill deserves enthusiastic support because it supports a couple's desire for a baby but unlike the Assembly bill and the previous Senate bill it does not require coverage for procedures which often result in the direct destruction of developing human life. I am especially proud that all Nassau and Suffolk Senators voted for the bill. It is my hope that an identical bill will be introduced and passed in the Assembly as soon as possible.

Please consider similar remedies in resolving the impasse over the "Women's Health and Wellness Act". Introduce pass legislation which like S.7359 will not require a conscience clause because it will not include provisions which mandates insurance coverage for contraceptive drugs and procedures which cause Such provisions do not belong in any abortions. "health" legislation. For the same reasons oppose any bill which mandates distribution or insurance coverage for contraceptives which act as abortifacients. If you are not knowledgeable as to the abortifacient effect of so called "emergency contraception" refer to the March 2002 edition of the "Annuals of Pharmacotherapy" or read the full study on the Internet at www.theannuals.

HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT THE ABORTION CONNECTIONS

Pre-term birth is a risk factor for cerebral palsy. An article by Brent Rooney in Celebrate Life quotes Prof. Barbara Luke, "a highly regarded author in the field of obstetrics, 'If you have had one or more induced abortions, your risk of prematurity with this pregnancy increases about 30%. If they were done during the second trimester, after 14 wks, your subsequent risk of prematurity is greater than if they had been done during the first trimester, before 14 wks.' ... a second mechanism by which abortion boosts prematurity risk is infection, in particular, infection of the uterus. At least 16 studies...including one published by the prestigious New England Journal of Medicine support Luke's claim...An additional study...found that the greater the number of previous induced abortions, the greater the risk of a subsequent low birth weight newborn." A later, very large study of over 61,000 Danish women showed: "Doubled risk of a very preterm birth (before 34 weeks gestation) for women with previous induced abortions...A 1,155% boost in prematurity risk for women with two previous 'evacuation' type abortions." (Obstetrics & Gynecology)

Eileen Doyle writes in the New York State Nurses for Life Newsletter about the abortion/child abuse connection. She reports on Dr. Philip Ney's book, Deeply Damaged, An Explanation for the Profound Problems Arising from Aborting Babies and Abusing Children. Dr. Ney has researched this subject for 20 yrs. The newsletter states, "For many years the unquestioned assumption was that unwantedness was a cause of child abuse. Abortion of unwanted children would then cut down on the incidence of child abuse. Dr. Ney found in the early years of his practice that women with pregnancy losses tended to be depressed after the birth of their next child. They had difficulty bonding which made abuse and neglect more likely. His research found that more abortion resulted in more child abuse. He also found that "child abuse more frequently leads to abortion... People who are dehumanized by mistreatment in their childhood are more likely to dehumanize and destroy their young." Ney found in his research that in Canada in areas where there were low rates of abortion there were low rates of child abuse, and in areas where abortion rates increased so did child abuse. He cites the work of Dr. Lenoski who found it far more likely that it was the wanted children who were abused."

"Once respect for preborn lives has been sufficiently eroded, the movement to legalize euthanasia can begin..." (Brian Clowes) In society today, the accepted solution to babies being born with handicapping conditions seems to be killing the baby rather than curing the condition. Pouring money into the detection of the disease when there is no cure available is an obvious move to abortion as the option. Dr. Leo Alexander writes in the New England Journal of Medicine, "There is a prevalence of thinking in destructive rather than ameliorative terms in dealing with social problems. The ease with which destruction of life is advocated for those considered either socially useless or socially disturbing, instead of educational and ameliorative measures, may be the first danger sign of loss of creative liberty in thinking which is the hallmark of a democratic society." On 4/1/02, the Netherlands became the first country to legalize euthanasia. This isn't anything new, since euthanasia has been tolerated there for 20 yrs. Of course they call it mercy killing! Belgium, France, Australia and England are moving in this direction. In the U.S., the propellant for legalizing euthanasia may be the very same 14th "Liberty" Amendment, or 'Privacy Right', that legalized contraception (Griswold v Connecticut 1965) and which became the basis for the Roe v Wade and Doe v Bolton abortion decisions in 1973. The first case of infanticide that we remember was a Down Syndrome baby born in Johns Hopkins and left to linger and die of dehydration for 22 days because the parent, a nurse, would not allow corrective surgery. This same procedure is used on patients who need tubal feeding. Denial of nutrition and hydration is not compassionate care. Death by thirst and starvation is painful and hideous. Most patients denied nutrition and hydration, who were not on the verge of death, took 12-19 days, often with seizures (although sedated) to die.

This is merciful, or 'death with dignity'?

"Suicide is rare among pregnant women, but much more common after induced abortion. It is never reported under maternal mortality from abortion, of course, even though it is causative... It is Easier to Scrape the Baby Out of the Mother's Womb that to Scrape the Memory of the Baby Out of Her Mind...The cardinal feature of post abortion syndrome is denial and suppression...Sooner or later (after 5, 10, or more years), many women can no longer handle it...Guilt is a near constant, often with shame, lowered self-esteem and then depression. Insomnia, sorrow and hopelessness, anniversary reactions, dreams, nightmares, and reliving are all part of it. She considers suicide..." (Dr. & Mrs. Willke) C. Tishler writes in Pediatrics that two teenaged mothers who had abortions attempted suicide on the anniversary of the day their babies would have been born. Questions & Answers, by Dr. & Mrs. Willke contains a report by M. Uchtman, Ohio Director of Suiciders Anonymous that states: "Of all the emotions they experience during the abortion crisis, none brings more pain and distress than the one they now know and identify five to ten times more than any other feelings... 'Oh, my God, I am evil. I have to be evil to have done this thing.'..." Uchtman further reports that of the 5,620 people who had attempted suicide in a 35-month period, 4,000 were women and 1,800 had abortions and 1,400 of these women were between 15-24 years of age. Just as the abortion climate set the stage for euthanasia, the euthanasia movement, including assisted suicide, encourages suicide. When respect for even one life is diminished, respect for all life decreases! "The number of teen suicides in the U.S. has exploded to more than 2,000 per year... If our society accepts euthanasia and assisted suicide, how will we tell a despondent teenager he has no right to kill himself if the cheerleader he adores spurns him?...or who loses self-respect through premarital sex? ...or who flunks out of college?" (Brian Clowes) If an adult is permitted to kill himself or request a physician to end his life because of the fear of future pain or loss of dignity, then why shouldn't a teenager be permitted this OUT instead of facing the results of their actions? Could the school killings be related to this philosophy? Convenience has become more important than responsibility!

The New York State Nurses for Life Newsletter reports on "what is purported to be the first settlement of a case against an abortion doctor by a woman who sued him for failing to inform her of a link between induced abortion and breast cancer prior to her abortion. A similar case is still pending. In 1996, two cases were settled involving failure to inform the women about the adverse psychiatric consequences of induced abortion. A woman in North Dakota is suing the Red River Clinic for false advertising for denying any link between breast cancer and abortion. Trial is pending. (World Net Daily, "Law of the Land", 12/30/01) Twenty eight of thirty seven studies published since 1957 have shown a 30% increased risk of breast cancer in women who have had induced abortion and studies on American women showed an increased risk of breast cancer who have had an induced abortion in 13 of 15 studies. (Joel Brind, Ph.D., National Right to Life News, March 2002)."

"Women who have had one abortion more than double their risk of cervical, ovarian, and liver cancer, and women with more than one abortion quadruple their risks." (Brian Clowes, The Facts of Life, Second Edition) Abortion increases the risk of endometriosis, an inflammation of the mucous membrane lining of the uterus, especially among teenagers. This can become cancerous! Pelvic Inflammatory Disease (PID) is "A common and serious complication of induced abortion and has been reported in up to 30% of all cases." (Human Life Educational Foundation) "PID is life-threatening and can lead to subsequent infertility and an increased risk of ectopic pregnancy..." (Brian Clowes) Tubal pregnancy risk is increased by 30% after one abortion and 160% after two or more.

These are only a few of the abortion connections, many of which are deadly. At least 100 women die from 'legal' abortions here in the U.S. every year. Most are not reported as abortion-related. No wonder the pro-abortion forces do not want women to be informed before they have abortions.



When I began my teaching career in the '50's my principal, superintendent and chairman were all veterans of military service. They were by and large a group of individuals who were principled and who had a clear understanding of ethical behavior. They were part of a generation which had witnessed first hand the horrendous effects of Nazism and Japanese Militarism and were willing to go into harms way to preserve not only our freedom, but to defend the intrinsic worth and dignity of all human life. They would not have acquiesced to the notion that it is appropriate for teens to be sexually involved or that abortion is a fundamental "right".

Today we have many school administrators who have difficulty distinguishing an immoral action from a moral one, nor are they willing or able to protect their students from society's hedonism as exemplified by Planned Parenthood's (P. P.'s) false agenda which places their students in harms way. P.P.'s Teen Health Conference is not a life affirming event, but one which has a deadly message. One wonders how many parents actually saw a P.P. brochure describing the "Health Conference" workshops. They appear to be willing accomplices to a great moral evil or unwitting dupes of P.P. propaganda.


