INSERTS FOR LIFE

Paid for by the Long Island Coalition for Life (LICL), the Suffolk County weekly newspaper aptly named Suffolk Life inserted and distributed 250,000 copies of the 8 page, glossy, four-color, pro-life flyer depicted here in their Sept. 25th edition.

The flyer, produced by Human Life Alliance of Minnesota, has articles on fetal development, the abortion breast cancer link, the sale of fetal body parts, methods of abortion and their risks (written by former abortion mill director Carol Everett), post abortion syndrome, and personal stories of people who have been involved in abortion decisions. It also lists addresses, phone numbers and websites where readers can find help or more information. All this is done in a classy, non-graphic, non-confrontational manner intended to offend no one.

Nonetheless, Suffolk Life publisher Dave Willmott expected the flyer to generate some negative response and it did. During the first 24 hours after it arrived in homes, Suffolk Life received well over fifty calls from people claiming to be offended on their own behalf or, ridiculously, on behalf of their children! The LICL received a number of similar calls. Over the next few days, though, the response was overwhelmingly positive. One heartwarming call was from a woman who had had an abortion, was pleased to see the material, and was looking for a place where she could volunteer to help.

Thank you Dave Willmott for helping us tell the politically incorrect truth about abortion and thanks to our many donors who made this extensive (and expensive) public information project happen.

EMILY's List:

Perpetuating the Greatest Lie Ever Told

EMILY's List is the largest and most powerful political action committee (PAC) in the world. In the 2000 election alone, members of EMILY's Listnumbering more than 68,000-contributed more than \$9.3 million to female candidates who support abortion rights. The organization also raised \$10.8 million for its WOMEN VOTE! initiative, an election effort designed to bring Democratic pro-abortion women voters to the polls, especially in battleground states. In the eight elections since the PAC's inception, 11 proabortion Democrat female senators, congresswomen and 4 female governors have been elected. Thanks to the backing of EMILY's List, proabortion women are now hammering out public policy on a variety of issues ranging from restricting Second Amendment rights to expanding "reproductive rights."

EMILY is an acronym for "Early Money Is Like Yeast" (it makes the "dough" rise).

By pioneering the practice of "bundling," EMILY's List developed a way to side-step financial caps often placed on political action committees by state governments. Even the "McCain-Feingold" federal campaign finance "reform" bill recently signed into law by President Bush does not prohibit or even limit bundling. My call to EMILY's List was answered by an eager young woman determined to do all she could to help me. As we spoke, I could feel the energy of these young women and their passionate devotion to their "cause." I had to remind myself that those women are working to destroy innocent human life.

EMILY's List understands the seductive influence of power, not to mention money. The PAC exists to enable women to help other women attain power. This power often entices women in our culture to *choose* a career over having a family, but more astonishingly to *choose* to kill their own children and feel okay, even noble, about doing so. Not only that, it convinces them to work for the legalization of the

killing of other people's children as well. Power, so the propaganda goes, does not lie in the courageous decision to become a mother, but in the choice to abort a baby in order to preserve a lifestyle of corporate advancement and personal pleasure.

As its website details, EMILY only hires staff from among the brightest in our nation: women with managerial expertise, extensive campaign experience, fundraising success and savvy media skills. EMILY then uses this powerhouse staff to seek out viable proabortion candidates and prepare them for victory through its own state and legislative training program. The group brings in donations by assembling members to whom they send a detailed biography of each proabortion woman running for office. Members decide to whom they wish to contribute, make their checks payable directly to the individual campaigns and send them back to EMILY's List.

Most women do not realize that the early feminist movement itself unanimously opposed abortion, characterizing it as a tool of male oppression. According to the early feminists, to evade having children-or worse yet, to kill them-was to live as a woman who had given up all freedom. Mary Wollstonecraft, 1792 author of A Vindication of the Rights of Women, warns of the slavery that the socalled right to choose ultimately brings: "Women becoming consequently weaker...have not sufficient strength to discharge the first duty of a mother; and sacrificing to lasciviousness the parental affection... either destroy the embryo in the womb, or cast it off when it is born. Nature in everything demands respect, and those who violate her laws seldom violate them with impunity." Wollstonecraft understood, as the women who support EMILY's List do not, that the real power of being a woman is that which comes from using your strength to protect and nurture the defenseless-above all, the pre-born child nestled in the womb.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION



HOUSE VOTES TO ALLOW A REJECTION OF ABORTION

The U.S. House of Representatives, on 9/25/02, by a vote of 229-189 passed the Abortion Non Discrimination Act. This bill would let hospitals and insurances companies refuse to perform or pay for abortions without forfeiting Medicare and other federal funding. Pro-Life Congressmen Felix Grucci and Peter King supported this pro-life measure while Congressional Members Carolyn McCarthy, Steve Israel and Gary Ackerman opposed it. McCarthy, Israel and Ackerman are strongly supportive of abortion had also opposed the ban on Partial Birth Abortions.

President George W. Bush supports the Abortion Non Discrimination Act and has said "Hospitals and health care professionals should not be forced to perform or participate in abortions...". The present makeup of the Senate makes the passage of this Act in the Senate fairly unlikely as long as pro-abortion Senator Thomas A. Daschle remains the majority leader.

It is desirable to contact the offices of these Congressional Members and inform them of your support or opposition. Also remind them that you will keep in mind their position on the above issues at election time.

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION



The New York State Legislature has been in recess since early July. However, as you may already know the "Women's Health and Wellness Act", a bill

which has a "conscience clause" so narrow as to be almost meaningless, became law when Governor Pataki signed it on 9/17/02. Gov. Pataki's support of this bill was disappointing but considering his "prochoice" statements it was no surprise. Certainly, during this year's Legislative Session it became increasing clear that the National Abortion Rights Action League (NARAL) and other pro-abortion groups were dictating the agenda with little or no resistance from our Governor. What was surprising as well as disappointing was the fact that many legislators who consistently vote pro-life voted for this bill. Statewide only ten Senators and ten Assembly Members voted against this outrageous bill. (As mentioned in previous columns we are well aware of the well financed campaign of misinformation and intimidation which NARAL waged against legislators who opposed their The brave Nassau/Suffolk Members who agenda). voted pro-life on this bill are Senator Trunzo, and Assemblymen Barraga, Flanagan and Wertz. Please thank them.

On Election Day we will vote for Governor, Attorney General and Comptroller as well as all State Senators, and Assembly Members. There is very good news: Attorney General Eliot Spitzer who is running for re-election was forced to discontinue his attack (actually based on a handbook published by NARAL) against Crisis Pregnancy Centers. Unfortunately, these Crisis Pregnancy Centers had to expend considerable time and financial resources before Spitzer was forced to back down, but it was a great victory for unborn babies and their mothers. Now NARAL is trying to prevent the election. of John Faso as Comptroller. Citing Alan Hevesi's decades long pro-abortion voting record, Kelli Conlin, NARAL/NY Executive Director announced NARAL's endorsement of Hevesi. Noting John Faso's consistent advocacy of "legislation opposing, restricting and criminalizing" abortion, Conlin called pro-life Faso's candidacy "a grave danger".

HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT WE CHALLENGE YOU!



The news media is saturated with alerts about any cancer causing agents such as saccharin, cellular phones, asbestos, smoking, second-hand smoke, and recently, hormone replacement therapy with estrogen. What about abortion, birth control pills and devices, and abortifacient contraceptives?

We challenge: all groups that make educational presentations on "women's wellness" such as The American Cancer Society, 1 in 9/Cancer Action Coalition and Planned Parenthood to truthfully and completely inform their audiences, students, patients, and clients as to the increased health risks, especially cancer, related to the use of birth control pills, devices, abortifacients, and abortion itself. In the past, we have attended several 1 in 9 Cancer Coalition presentations. We questioned the presenters as to why they were not informing those present, who were attending expressly to be educated on how to avoid the dreaded "C", of these deadly increased risks. The presenters said that was a "social moral issue" and they were not going to get involved with that. We offered to join them at their presentations, at no extra cost to them, including materials to be distributed. No sale! We then asked if they would give out material on the studies done on the connection between abortion and breast cancer. They took the brochures and our phone numbers. No calls were ever received.

Previous to those encounters, John Short, a respected pro-life activist and close friend of Dr. Jerome Lejeune, along with Dolores Andreski, arranged to make a presentation at a 1 in 9 Chapter meeting. Upon arriving, they were told the talk was cancelled, and they were not permitted to talk with a reporter in the office. Why were they, and why are they still so afraid of the truth? Is it as Brian Clowes writes in *The Facts of Life?* "... Pro-abortionists strenuously deny that such a link is even theoretically possible, even though there is no way that their conclusion can possibly be proven at this time."

How do they have the nerve to proclaim on their website: "...we must not only support 'traditional' research projects funded year after year, but we must also support innovative, cutting-edge projects that may reveal new clues about preventing or curing this disease." Is this their excuse to support live fetal and live embryonic stem cell research, but to ignore the many studies on the cancer connections described above?

We have written numerous articles on this topic. The August 2002 Life News article refers to the July '02 world-wide report on the connection between estrogen hormone replacement therapy (HRT) and the 26% increased risk of ovarian cancer for those on the regimen. A special edition Communique on this topic from Judy Brown contains the following from John Wilks, B.Pharm., MPS, MACPP, an

internationally recognized expert: "... It is important to recognize that the dose of estrogen used for postmenopausal hormone replacement therapy (HRT) is substantially less than that used in oral contraception...the average dose of hormone in the birth control pill is, conservatively, four times stronger per dose than HRT." Are you listening Planned Parenthood? Their website contains the following question and response: "Does abortion cause breast cancer? No, but it does not offer the same protection against breast cancer as a full term pregnancy." As usual, they continue to use doublespeak! Life Issues Connector (10/02) reports that several affiliates of the Susan B. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation, sponsors of the annual Race for the Cure, have given grants to Planned Parenthood and a late-term abortion clinic! Komen Foundation founder Nancy Goodman Brinker sits on the Advisory Council for Planned Parenthood Dallas/ Northeast Texas. She received their 1996 Humanitarian Award.

The excuse that there have not been enough studies to consider these risks is lame. "Since 1957, twenty-eight out of thirty-seven worldwide studies have linked abortion to breast cancer. Of the fifteen studies conducted in the United States, thirteen show a significant link...for women who have had abortions, their risk of developing breast cancer increases at least 30%." (Jana Morford Widmeyer, RTL of Greater Cincinnati, Inc., Dr. Joel Brind) Dr. L. I. Remennick concluded, "an initial attitude of researchers toward abortion usually determines the way they interpret results." (International Journal Epidemiology) Australian attorney Charles Frances reached a settlement with an abortionist for a woman who was suing for not being informed about the research findings linking abortion with breast cancer. The woman agreed to an out-of-court settlement if her name would not be revealed. (NYS Nurses for Life) Several other cases are awaiting trial. "Women who have had one abortion more than double their risk of cervical, ovarian, and liver cancer, and women with more that one abortion quadruple their risks." (Brian Clowes)

Countries that permit abortion show a dramatic rise in breast cancer cases. Countries that do not permit abortions show no rise. *Life Dynamics* communicated with every oncologist and research center and asked if there was any flaw in their conclusion about the abortion/breast cancer connection. Not one doctor challenged their conclusion!

This is just a very brief overview of the information available on increased cancer risks. We challenge all "educators" to give serious consideration to providing women with all the information they need to make a truly informed choice. "There are 1,600,000 abortions each year. 56% are first abortions, 44% second or more. One women in ten will develop breast cancer, and 25% of them will die" (J.C.Willke, M.D.)


