COLLEGE ADVERTISING 101

"Breast Cancer - Abortion Link" - so started an LICL advertisement for college newspapers. To read campus newspapers or hear university mantras about enlightening future generations, one would not expect much obstruction to placing college newspaper ads. Not necessarily so.

The LICL delivered an ad on the link between abortion and breast cancer (A-BC) to four colleges: Nassau County Community College, LI University C.W. Post Campus, SUNY Stony Brook, and Hofstra University. The ad mentioned scientific studies, the biological mechanism, and sources for more information regarding the A-BC link. We requested one full page ad, to be run in October (Breast Cancer Awareness Month). The average cost of a full page ad is about \$330.

Here is a very brief look at the results:

Nassau Community College – accepted the ad when first contacted and printed the full page ad (Vignette 10/30/02).

<u>C.W. Post</u> – accepted the ad without comment, but reduced it to a quarter page, making it difficult to read and less noticeable (*Pioneer* 10/23/02). Coincidentally, our ad was dropped to the same size as a Planned Parenthood ad on the facing page.

<u>SUNY Stony Brook</u> – initially refused to run the ad, calling it too "controversial." We continued to communicate with the paper's staff and send A-BC link documentation. Eventually, the LICL full page ad was printed (*Statesman* 11/25/02).

<u>Hofstra University</u> – refuses to run the ad, finding it "insulting" and "inappropriate." The LICL provided A-BC information and contacted administrators up to Dean of Students Gina-Lyn Crance, urging a reasoned response and publication of our ad. She simply supported *The Chronicle's* decision, deferring responsibility to the students. *The Chronicle* prints Planned Parenthood ads.

The LICL will continue to utilize college newspapers for prolife education, as opportunities and funds are available. If you are interested in helping place prolife ads in your local college paper, please let us know (631-243-1435).

Planned Parenthood's Suffolk County Teen Health Conference

This year's Teen Health Conference includes a Professional Workshop on Teenagers, Health Care and the Law, to be given by Rebekah Diller, Director, N.Y. Civil Liberties Union's Reproductive Rights Project, who will address laws on minors' rights to reproductive health care, as well as confidentiality, child abuse and sexual assault care. It would be a most egregious omission if she fails to mention Planned Parenthood's (P.P.) failure to notify authorities of abortions performed on young teens who are victims of statutory rape. Allegations have been leveled at P.P. and National Abortion Federation (N.A.F.) clinics in New Jersey, Iowa, Colorado, Arizona, North Carolina, Alaska. Connecticut, Wisconsin, Utah, New York and Nebraska. Although the laws defining statutory rape vary widely, all 50 states list Statutory Rape as a felony.

An agent for <u>Life Dynamics</u> telephoned 800 P.P. and N.A.F. facilities around the country, posing as a 13 year old, impregnated by a 22 year old, seeking an abortion. "Would you guys have to tell anybody?" The usual response from P.P. or N.A.F., "Here? No, we don't tell anybody anything.", or "By law, we should, but we've never reported anybody".

Fox News' O'Reilly Factor, Jan 9, 2003, reported the case of P.P. of Phoenix performing an

abortion on a 13 year old who was a victim of statutory rape by a 23 year old male. She came in for a second abortion within 6 months. P.P. did report the second pregnancy. Maricopa County Superior court Judge, Cathy Holt found the abortion provider, P.P. of Phoenix to be negligent and the rapist, Shawn Stevens was jailed. P.P.'s negligence in this devastating assault on the 13 year old was in performing the first abortion and sending her back into the same environment which inflicted serious psychological, physical and emotional harm on a defenseless girl who does not have the maturity to consent to sexual activity.

Why are school Principals and Administrators continuing to expose students entrusted to their care to an organization which subverts the law and in so doing aiding and abetting the cover-up of a felony avoiding criminal prosecution of a statutory rapist? Is this their idea of a Health conference? Schools that have continued to attendance at P.P.'s Teen Conference over the past few years are Kings Park, Sayville, Huntington, Bayport-Blue Point, West Babylon, Southampton, East Hampton. Their continued support increases the chances of prosecution for aiding and abetting a felony.

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION



Once again we ask you to call or write to your state legislators to voice your objections of the use of tax payer monies to fund the destruction of human life. Most New Yorkers are unaware that no federal Medicaid funds are used to fund abortions in New York State. The Hyde Amendment prevents federal Medicaid funding of abortions except in cases of rape, incest, or endangerment to the mother's life. New York State is not eligible for federal reimbursement because our state funds abortion-on-demand. Taxpayers are thus forced to finance 100% of the Medicaid abortions: 50% of the cost is paid with their state taxes and 50% paid with their local taxes. Hopefully, because of the current financial crisis in our state and in many of our counties even some legislators who are not pro-life will oppose taxpayer funding for financial reasons.

ACTION -SAMPLE LETTER:

Dear Senator/Assembly Member:

When participating in budget negotiations and voting, consider that thousands of taxpayers in our state strongly object to the use of their taxes to fund the destruction of human life. Yet, according to latest NYS Dept. of Health Statistics (2000) at least 35.9% of the 125,146 abortions in our state that year were Medicaid funded, using state and local money. This is many times the number of "medically necessary" abortions which qualify for Medicaid reimbursement under NYS Social Service Law 365a. Even more disturbing is the fact that more than half of the 9872 abortions on teenagers under 18 are Medicaid funded-often without parental knowledge. Clearly, the state's policy which violates our own state law and makes us ineligible for federal funds is unjust and illegal. Medicaid is a program intended to prevent illness and promote healing. Vote to remove Medicaid funding of chemical and surgical abortion from the budget. Abortion is not health care.

EVIL COMPOUNDED



By the time you read this, some of the questions we have today may already have been answered. Recent reports state that a cloned baby has been born. Additionally, a second birth has been amounced. The media questioned, "History or Hoax"? We would label this reproductive cloning "Unethical Creative Competition by a Diabolic Creationalist Cult".

A former French auto racer and journalist, Claude Vorilhon, claims aliens picked him up in 1973 on a French volcano. The small, olive green, extraterrestrials with almond-shaped eyes informed Vorilhon that they created life on earth through DNA genetic engineering 25,000 years ago. Vorilhon reports that the ET's then introduced him to Jesus, Buddha and Muhammad, all of whom acted as prophets for the aliens. Their messages were not fully understood. Is this some kind of parody of the Transfiguration of Jesus? Can anyone really believe that we are part of some bizarre cosmic experiment gone wild?

When Vorilhon returned to Earth, he changed his name to Rael and founded the Raelian religious sect. In 1977, the sect founded Clonaid, the Bahamas-based cloning firm that supposedly produced the first human clone for a 31-year-old woman whose husband is infertile. No one has seen the seven pound girl, named Eve (???), nor have the promised DNA tests, proving she is a clone, been done. The baby was supposedly born via Caesarian section December 26, as we celebrated Christmas—another religious coincidence?

The second baby was supposedly born in Holland to Brigitte Boisselier, a chemist and formerly a member of the faculty at Hamilton College, who claims to be a Raelian bishop. Ms. Boisselier is chief executive of Clonaid, and has been making their media announcements. She refuses to accept biblical creation teaching and "willfully and conscientiously" abandons the evolution theory. Ms. Boisselier did not reveal from whom the eggs (ova) were donated for these processes, but stated, as in reproductive cloning, that the nucleus, which was removed and the DNA fused into the egg, was extracted from skin cells. Treatment similar to an electric shock then stimulated the development process. Clonaid implanted embryos in 10 different women. Supposedly five were successful. This is an unbelievable success rate considering the rates associated with IVF and animal cloning.

Scientists and doctors interviewed said that defects are seen in all cloning processes. They claim this could cause severe distress and pain for these produced human babies. They also brought out that the single DNA introduced will make for less healthy babies, and increases the possibility of causing inborn diseases. They also seemed to think it was odd that of 8 different animals cloned, no one has been able to successfully clone a Chimp, and yet they could suc-

cessfully clone a human.

The president of the U.S. Raelian Movement boasts 1,000 members. They are hopeful that this genetic research will lead to extending human life "so that we can live forever". Clonaid reported that there are 2,000 people willing to clone themselves at \$2,000 each. The Raelians have a U.F.O. theme park in Canada, along with several laboratories whose locations have been kept secret.

George Seidel, physiologist at Colorado State University questions, "Did they actually clone a person? That's not such a simple thing to verify. There are all sorts of opportunities for switching (tissue) samples and so forth...the danger of producing a child with serious abnormalities trumps all the other ethical issues about whether one should be doing this in any case. It's unethical from the get-go." According to Seidel, cloned babies will still have differences, just as identical twins, genetic duplicates, are different in some ways. "If the egg used to receive the mother's genes came from another family, then a small subset of genes inside tiny bodies called mitochondria will differ from the mother's genes. Also, the cloned baby will develop and grow up in a different environment than the mother's. And the mother's skin cell genes may have been damaged, or mutated, during her lifetime, and the baby would inherit those genetic changes." (Cooke, Newsday, 12/28/02, pg. A13)

Whether this report turns out to be fact or fiction, it proves the necessity for immediate legislation to ban human cloning, be it for the rapeutic or reproductive purposes. To state that cloning for stem cell purposes is different, therefore ethical, is a lie. Legislation permitting the destruction of an embryo after 14 days for stem cells is still killing a human being. We agree with Cal Thomas, "Have we abandoned the sacredness of human life...endowed by our Creator?" Only Sen. Sam Brownback's bill provides the ethically needed legislative ban on cloning. The bill backed by Feinstein, Kennedy, Hatch and Spector sets a 14-day development limit. Tell us, who will be able to supervise this? Please make an effort to stop researchers from playing God. Contact your Senators and Congressman and ask them to champion the cause to ban all human cloning. Four states already have a cloning ban in effect.

The FDA's biotechnology chief, Dr. Phil Noguchi, warned that in cloning experiments "there's a variety of unknown things that could happen. This was too dangerous to proceed at this time." (Cooke, *Newsday*, 12/28/02, pg. A3)

C. Ward Kisher, Ph.D., chairman of the American Bioethics Advisory Commission, and Richard Thorne, M.D. write, "The marvel of the continuum demonstrated in embryonic life should never be undermined by reducing the human essence to a function or some arbitrary pseudo-scientific stage. Human development does not end at birth. Just as in embryonic life, all of life is a continuum. To assign varying moral values at anytime during life is simply arbitrary and has nothing to do with science." ("Embryos, preembryos, and stem cells", Fertility and Sterility, 12/02, p.1355)

Umbilical-Cord Blood Saves Mother from Leukemia

Montreal, Canada (10/26/02) A 27-yearold woman severely ill with leukemia was cured of her condition through a transfusion of the umbilical-cord blood from her baby daughter. The high-risk procedure performed by doctors at Royal Victoria Hospital in Montreal was possibly the world's first offspring-to-parent transplant.

There has been growing interest in using umbilical-cord blood as an alternative to bone-marrow transplants. The blood is rich in hemopoietic stem cells which can rebuild a blood system damaged by heavy doses of chemotherapy. Umbilical-cord blood can be stored for later treatment of illness such as leukemia.

The mother, Patrizia Durante, credits her daughter with saving her life. She was 26 weeks pregnant when she learned she was suffering from acute myloid leukemia. Since she was not responding to mild chemotherapy, labor was induced and her baby was born 2 months premature. Later, when she was infused with the blood cells from her child's umbilical cord, the stem cells, which included the baby's immune system, attached the leukemia and began rebuilding her blood system. Seven months later she was in complete remission.

Scientists are currently studying whether stem cells from cord blood may also be able to repair damaged heart and brain tissue.

U.S. ABORTIONS DROP BY 11%

Washington, DC (10/8/02) The Alan Guttmacher Institute reported that the number of abortions in the U.S. has declined by 11%. The rate of abortions has dropped from 24 per 1,000 women in 1994 to 21 per 1,000 in 2000. In 1987, the rate was even higher --27 per 1,000 women.

Disturbing, however, is the statistic that 25% of all pregnancies in 2000 ended in abortion, and that 78% of these report a religious affiliation (43% Protestant, 27% Catholic and 8% other religions.)

The largest decline in abortion rates was among the teens: in the 15-17 year-old group, abortions fell from 24 per 1,000 in 1994 to 15 per 1,000 in 2000.

Parental involvement laws have had an impact on teen abortions in states with these laws, according to Laura Echevarria, NRLC's Director of Media Relations.





Question: Should the government interfere in the highly personal issue of abortion?

Answer: As Thomas Jefferson once wrote: "The care of human life and happiness, and not their destruction, is the first and only object of good government." In
