

BOYCOTT UPDATE

In the December 2003 LIFE NEWS we reported various companies that contribute to pro-abortion organizations. Shortly after we went to press, Life Decisions International updated The Boycott List, which it publishes as part of its Corporate Funding Project (for further information contact LDI at 540-631-0380 or www.fightpp.org).

According to its November 2003 list, the good news is that Sony and HMV have been dropped from The Boycott List. This is to the credit of those prolifers who do not shop at stores that support proabortion organizations and write to those companies letting them know why. Unfortunately, Blimpie (sandwich/Salad shops) and The Home Depot have been added to The Boycott List.

It seems incongruous that The Home Depot would contribute to Planned Parenthood. The Home Depot is known for its outreach to the disabled community by employing physically and mentally challenged individuals. Yet, Planned Parenthood's mantra of "every child a wanted child" too often excludes preborn babies found to be "defective."

FEDERAL LEGISLATION



Important Alert—The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to rule on over-the-counter "emergency contraception".

On December 16th, two advisory committees to the FDA recommended that the so called "morning-after pill" be sold over-the-counter in drug stores rather than by medical prescription. The FDA is expected to rule on this as early as February.

Dear Commissioner Mark B. McCellan: I urge you to oppose making "emergency contraception" available without a prescription. The swift and politically motivated approval of the abortion drug RU-486 without the safeguards required in other countries has ready been deadly to some women as well as to countless babies. Hopefully, the FDA will learn from the experience, and consider the welfare of women and young teenagers rather then the agenda of Planned Parenthood.

The health risks of non-prescription "emergency contraception" are serious. Regions where "emergency contraception" has been introduced without prescription have not experienced a reduction in abortion rates but have experienced an increase in sexually transmitted diseases. Young girls will have ready access to mega-doses of hormonal medication which could be used to cover-up instances of sexual abuse or dangerous promiscuous behavior without the involvement of a doctor or parent.

Also, of great concern to me, in some cases "emergency contraception" may destroy an already-existing embryo by preventing implantation. Women

deserve the truth about the drug, its methods of action, and its effects. For these reasons I respectfully ask you to reject the proposal to make "emergency contraceptive (Plan B-levonorgestrel) available without a prescription.



"For the honor and glory of God"

John Cardinal O'Connor and Jack Short

On December 21, 2003, the pro-life movement lost one of its most dedicated and tireless activists. Dolores Andreski passed away at home, having spent almost a year in the hospital. Dolores and John Short were the original authors of this column. Inspired by the work of Doctor Jerome Lejeune, their purpose was to educate the pro-life community on a broad spectrum of issues. The pro-life movement in general, and the Long Island pro-life community in particular were blessed with her knowledge, understanding, wisdom, compassion and seemingly endless energy. There never seemed to be enough hours in the day for Dolores. (I know she often worked deep into the night.)

Many of us in the pro-life movement find it hard to find a balance with our faith, family, friends and commitment to the pro-life cause and other social concerns. Dolores was able to combine them all. I would often catch her dropping off papers after early morning Mass. She was hurrying off to be sure to kiss her grandchildren good-morning before they went to school. Her car always had literature on hand to be distributed as well baby clothing to bring to a CPC. She always had a full day - Mass, babysitting, doctor's appointments, prayer meetings, pro-life/diocesan meetings. But her stories were always centered on her family - wonder and joy in her grandchildren and great-grandchildren, concern for her husband's and children's health. She was bursting with love for them all.

That love of family was reflected in her concern for others. Dolores worked on the Committee to Eliminate Indecent Literature in the early 1960's. She was a founder of Teens for Life, originated the Children's

Rosary at Maria Regina, taught CCD as well as being a volunteer substitute teacher, auxiliary teacher for Learning Skills, and PTA and school board member. She was active in the Rosary Society, Legion of Mary, Catholic Action Committee, St. Joseph's Chapter of the Third Order of Carmelites, Long Island Coalition for Life, Maria Regina Human Life Committee and the Diocesan Respect Life Ministry. She coordinated the provision of food and clothing for the homeless and worked with the Prison Ministry. In addition, Dolores originated the August 22nd Rosary Procession for Life and the annual Michael Fund Walkathon. She worked closely with Birthright and other CPC's, as well as being extremely active in prayerful witnessing and counseling at local abortuaries.

As the Long Island representative for the Michael Fund, she worked tirelessly for those born and pre-born who were diagnosed with a birth defect of any kind. She accepted phone calls at all hours of the day and night and worked to find the right answer to bring help and comfort to those women and men who were faced with a frightening and confusing diagnosis for their children or grandchildren. Dolores had an uncanny ability to foresee the direction that science and research was taking, and was able to anticipate the need to forewarn the pro-life community of upcoming dangers to the health and safety of the unborn, the physically and mentally challenged, the elderly and the terminally ill. She was brilliant – able to grasp complex medical and scientific issues and their impact on society.

Dolores was a true heroine in the pro-life movement. She was never afraid to speak the truth, even when it was uncomfortable for herself or those she was addressing – pro-abortion activists, politicians, doctors, nurses, lawyers, clergy, confused and frightened mothers, and even fellow "right-to-lifers". She was often several steps ahead of the rest of us because of her vision and insight. Knowing that God and His Truth were guiding her, Dolores continued to persevere.

Dolores' great love of God and her deep faith were evident in the activities she was involved in. They were especially reflected in her family life. She was a wonderful wife, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother, always there to comfort in time of need, as well as to celebrate with joy. She was untiring in her love and dedication to her faith, her family and all those in need. As she so often told her family, everything was done "for the honor and glory of God".

Spiritually "Adopt a Baby" Program

An excellent "intercessory prayer" activity for the entire parish community, Spiritual Adoption, is a very easy prolife project.

We know there are pre-born infants in danger of abortion. Therefore, this program invites the community to commit themselves to praying every day for the nine months, praying that the mother and father of an infant receive the strength by God's Spirit to continue to choose life.

Where to start?

Begin the program with a sign-up weekend. Participants sign a pledge card promising to pray every day for a baby they spiritually adopt and for his/her parents. The pledge card suggests the Spiritually Adopted baby be given a name.

Monthly Development Report:

During each of the nine months the parish bulletin updates the child's development. For example:

3rd Month Developing Baby:

Your baby is quite active now. If his/her mother's womb had a window, you could watch your Spiritually Adopted baby squint, swallow, and move his tongue. Your baby can make a tight fist if you touch his/her palm.

Baby obtains the oxygen his body needs through the umbilical cord. The baby you are praying for weighs one ounce.

Suggestions for concluding the program:

A closing Mass or Service, a Communion Breakfast, a "Baby Shower" from which the gifts, diapers, formula can be donated to a nearby crisis pregnancy center.

NOTE: Volunteers say that diapers, receiving blankets, Onesies, bibs, and formula are the most needed items.



Answer: The "Will to Live" is offered by the National Right to Life Committee, Inc. (NRTL) as a Pro-Life alternative to the Living Will.

The NRTL has prepared a document call a "Will to Live" which people can use to state their desire for food, water, and live-saving medical treatment if they become unable to speak for themselves. Separate forms have been prepared for each state to comply with state laws.
