# FEDERAL LEGISLATION MORNING AFTER PILL WON'T GO OVER THE COUNTER

Ultimately, the Federal Drug Administration (FDA) decided to take no chances with the health of the potential users of so called "emergency contraceptive" pill when they backed down from approving over-the-counter distribution of the morning after pills without a doctor's prescription.

The FDA saw the fallacy of its own panel's previous recommendation of approval of Plan B, manufactured by Barr Laboratories. The manufacturer presented no evidence that these strong hormones could be safely used, possibly repeatedly, by young teenage girls. The FDA itself recognizes that the pills are meant for one-time emergency protection and the effect of repeated use of the drugs is unknown. Known side effects include increased risk of heart attacks, strokes or blood clots. These drugs can also be abortifacient by interfering with implantation of an embryo thereby killing a new life

Many years ago the government approved a synthetic form of estrogen called DES that became very popular to prevent problems during pregnancy. The drug was later implicated in devastating reproductive abnormalities, cancer, injuries, illness and deaths. One can only hope that the FDA has learned from the DES debacle.

## NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

FAMILY PROTECTION ACT—A.6770/S.2893 was introduced by Assemblyman Barra and Senator Padavan. It has 12 Assembly 22 Senate sponsors including Nassau-Suffolk Senators Flanagan, Johnson and Trunzo and Assembly Members Barra, Alfano, Barrage, Conte, Fitzpatrick, McDonough, O'Connell and Raia.

Action: Please call or write your representatives asking that they actively support this bill. Thank those who are sponsors.

Sample Message:

Please support the Family Protection Act A.6770/ S.2893. This pro-life, pro-family bill offers an opportunity for all legislators, whether they consider themselves pro-life, to work together to protect the health and safety of young women who could be our daughters or granddaughters.

Do you believe women have a right to all the relevant facts that might affect their health and safety before consenting to the abortion procedure? Despite the many research studies which indicate evidence of serious and long-lasting physical and psychological damage done to women by abortion current state law does not require that the woman receive information about the harm abortion can do. The Family Protection Act would

require that a woman considering an abortion be given information regarding the development of her baby, the effects of abortion on a woman's physical and mental health and the alternatives to abortion.

Do you believe that girls under 18 should be given an abortion without parental knowledge or consent? Under current state law girls as young as twelve or thirteen can be given an abortion without parental knowledge. Having no parental consent law makes it easy for an older man to take advantage of a young girl coercing her to have an abortion to avoid parental responsibilities and other consequences to himself. (A study of Life Dynamics, Inc. found that among girls 15 and under who become pregnant, between 60 and 80% are impregnated by adult males and according to the same study 90% of abortion providers fail to report this crime of statutory rape.) The Family Protection Act would require parental consent for girls under 18 years of age or alternatively a court waiver.

Protect our women and our families by working for the

passage of the Family Protection Act. Please reply.

As of May 9th, the deadline for this column there has been no action on any of the state bills cited in May LifeNews. Please continue to lobby on these bills. Use the Bill Status Hotline to keep up-to-date. June is a critical time for our lobbying efforts. WE CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE!

# A BABY OR A FETUS WITH A DEFECT?



Many of us in the pro-life community have received phone calls or requests for information and/or help from parents and grandparents after the Alpha-Feto Protien (AFP), a sonogram or an amniocentesis shows the possibility of a birth defect in the developing baby. Grace Anne Nugent was one of these babies. After a "weird" AFP result, Christine Nugent was referred for a level 2 ultrasound. The sonographer pointed to the monitor and said, "Oh, look at the baby. How cute." Then she became very quiet and serious. She commented that the baby's hands were clenched in tight fists. Something appeared to be wrong with the heart, and there were brain cysts. The attending physician told the Nugents that these symptoms all indicated Trisomy 18, the presence of a third number 18 chromosome, which would prove fatal for the baby. Suddenly the medical personnel referred to the child as a fetus with a defect, she was no longer a "cute baby."

When the couple indicated that "termination" was not an option, Christine states that, "They (medical personnel) looked at us like we were from another planet." Christine and Paul requested that the hospital find a doctor that would help them bring their baby to term. "Instead, the physician referred the Nugents to a genetics counselor, who told the couple 'how horrible' Trisomy 18 is." When they asked for "resources for women who wanted to carry babies with birth defects to term, they were told the only resources available were for women who wanted to abort such babies." The hospital was pressuring them to have an abortion before 24 weeks. Even the priest they went to told them "...these babies are very sick—there will be a lot of suffering...he told us we should pray for a miscarriage and he told me how to bury my baby".

Even some friends and colleagues didn't understand their decision. They seemed to be saying the baby isn't going to live, so why have it? "Why not end the suffering as soon as you can?" In an article in the National Catholic Register, Christine stated, "We live in a society where everything is supposed to be perfect. It's a disposable society. If something is not perfect, you get rid of it and try again. It's like, Better luck next time."

Finally, Christine's obstetrician respected her decision to continue with the pregnancy. He recommended an amniocentesis so that they could plan for the birth. He stated in the National Catholic Register, "There's definitely a feeling out there that a life like this is not worth pursuing to the end of pregnancy. I don't know how we've come to this end, but we have. A large portion of the obstetrics community believes these lives are less worthy, in the sense that babies that appear to be normal are, in a sense, more worthy. You can speculate on the reasons as much as I can. Is it abortion on demand? Even the March of Dimes' Healthy

baby program — the March of Dimes does a tremendous amount of good work. But the promotion is based on identifying and eliminating unhealthy babies. Somewhere, we have developed a definition of healthy and, in pursuit of 'healthy', there are babies deemed unhealthy. Their moms are strongly steered toward termination." He criticizes the medical profession for not doing enough to help couples who decide to allow their children to live as long as possible. He would like "to see cases like theirs serve as models for prenatal hospice programs. There is a paucity of data on how to plan, cope and help patients get through these situations. There's more data on how to mentally help someone cope with a termination."

Christine did a lot of research on her own and used the Internet to find others who were faced with the same decisions. Her website credits the Sisters of Life and Morning Light Ministry with providing her with the support and information she needed to prepare for Grace's birth. The Nugents developed a birth plan and made sure that all the hospital staff was informed of their plans and decisions, covering all possible outcomes. They made the decision to provide comfort care only. They expected Grace to live 3 to 5 days. She actually went home on her one-month birthday. At home, the seizures and apnea increased. Hospice was "a tremendous support". Grace died at home on her two-month birthday. At Grace's funeral Mass, Father Berbig quoted Paul Nugent, "People tell us, 'That was a long hard road you had.' But we took the easy way. We chose to have the baby and love the baby." The other way might have led to a lifetime of regret. "Instead, the Nugents have many memories, photos, and a little girl in heaven. And they're surrounded by a few new believers in the sacredness of life." Christine Nugent feels that her family was not the only ones to be blessed by knowing and loving Grace Anne, "it seemed everyone who met her realized what a beautiful and mysterious gift every human life is."

On Grace Anne's website, Christine states, "Grace brought out the best in people around her. She was the most helpless creation – she brought out the goodness of people. Grace provided an opportunity for many people who we knew and who we didn't know to love unconditionally. Grace touched many, many people in her short life. She did more in 2 months than some people do in a lifetime. She was pure love, and she experienced pure love...The doctors that worked with us told me they will never look at a case like this the same again. Grace is a teacher and a pioneer...She showed me that death is peaceful...Grace was truly 'amazing."

It is vital that this message be brought to the entire medical community as well as to the general public. We must do all we can to help to establish Prenatal Hospice and Support worldwide.



# INTERNATIONAL PLANNED PARENTHOOD FEDERATION'S COMPULSORY ABORTION AGENDA

Continued from page 2, May issue of LIFE NEWS.

The aim of International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF) through its local affiliates in developing nations is to promote abortion by the same techniques it has used in the U.S. by marketing and use of the tactic that the abortion movement has used in almost every nation, which is to greatly exaggerate the numbers of women who die from illegal abortions. For example, case in point - Brazil - "... the Brazilian Affiliate of International Planned Parenthood Federation (BEMFAM), (an affiliate of IPPF) estimate of 400,000 annual deaths (from illegal abortions) yet the Brazilian Institute of Geography and Statistics figures have shown (sic) that only 55,066 Brazilian women between the ages of 14 and 50 died of all causes in 1980 (and) confirmed by World Health Organization statistics showing that 41,685 Brazilian women...died in 1986 and, of these, 241 died of complications from legal and illegal abortions.". (B. Cowles, The Facts of Life, 2001, pg. 18).

In prefaces to various Chinese Family Planning manuals, Planned Parenthood officials, state, "The methods or techniques used in the Peoples Republic of China will be of great interest to other nations. Why not adopt China's population goals and methods?"

As noted earlier, IPPF has been a major player in not only promoting abortion as a reproductive right, but it is also involved in population control in developing nations. Along with the United Nations Fund for Population Activities and other zero population growth advocates, they claim that cutting funds for family planning as a result of the Mexico City Policy will lead to a rise in maternal deaths. As U.N. statistics demonstrate, in African nations, when proper medical facilities are available, maternal mortality rates have dropped from 1,340 to 320 per 100,00 pregnancies. Basic health services and

sanitation are the way to reduce infant and maternal deaths.

Our tax dollars are better spent in training medical personnel to improve the lives of women and children by providing better health care and strengthening market economies. Limiting population and the use of abortion will not solve the problems of developing nations which include civil and ethnic political instability, poor infrastructure, and lack of hospitals and schools. Developing nations do not have to be coerced by Western elites, by bribes and promises from those who profit from the sale of abortions and contraceptives. IPPF and Planned Federation of America (PPFA) have utilized political institutions both here and abroad. In their incursion into Africa, Asia, Latin and Central America we see the emergence of a neo-colonialist policy imposed on developing nations which are composed mainly of people of color. The promotion of abortion as a means of population control detracts from the major issue which is the failure of the global community to assist development in poorer nations. important, IPPF and PPFA have often subverted the will of the majority through the courts or through the use of world institutions such as the U.N.

# NEA OFFERS NO CHOICE FOR LIFE

"Pro-life teachers angered by NEA-sponsored march: Thousands of pro-life teachers and school staff required to belong to the National Education Association across the country are offended by the union's co-sponsorship of a pro-choice march in Washington this Sunday. # Thousands Face the Truth

Through the quiet, but determined, action of a small band of dedicated pro-lifers, thousands of Nassau and Suffolk travelers saw the grim reality of abortion during the weekend of April 17th and 18th. Question: Do you know there is a way you may abandon your baby legally?

Answer: There is now a Safe Haven Law whereby a parent or an agent of the parent may take the newborn baby to a person at a Safe Haven, which may be either a hospital, police or fire station or emergency medical service.

When the child is brought to the Safe Haven he or she will be taken care of and you will not have to answer any questions. Some people will perhaps, voluntarily, give the newborns background. The police will not be called. Details differ by state. New York State requires 5 days or less for the newborn to be received by the Safe Haven.
