

BEWARE THE DANGEROUS PLANNED PARENTHOOD ORGANIZATION!!

IS YOUR GIRL SCOUT COUNCIL INVOLVED WITH PLANNED PARENTHOOD?

American Life League's STOPP International has embarked on an effort to uncover the extent of the involvement between Planned Parenthood and individual Girl Scout councils nationwide.

Recently, Joe Pisciotto, co-director of Pro-Life Waco in Waco, Texas learned that the Texas Bluebonnet Council was co-sponsoring a Planned Parenthood teen and pre-teen sex education conference call "Nobody's Fool".

The half-day conference is held each year for girls in fifth through ninth grade. About 400 to 900 girls attend the event and are given the book, "It's Perfectly Normal", which includes chapters on homosexuality and masturbation, illustrations of couples having sex, people examining their naked bodies and a boy putting on a condom. It also has a chapter on abortion and tells how scientists are "working hard" to make the abortion pill available to the general public.

In the Girl Scouts USA, "Blue Book of Basic Documents", it states "the Girl Scout Organization does not take a position on abortion or birth control..."



FEDERAL LEGISLATION EXPECT A BIG PUSH TO OVERTURN PRESIDENT BUSH'S BAN ON STEM CELL RESEARCH

POPE JOHN PAUL II ON PVS

On March 20, 2004, Pope John Paul II issued the first clear and explicit papal statement on the obligation to provide food and water for persons in a "persistent vegetative state". In his speech he emphasized that:

1.) No living being ever descends to the status of a vegetable or an animal.

2.) Because human life has inherent dignity regardless of its visible "quality", it calls for normal care owed to all helpless patients and in principle, food and fluids (even if medically assisted) are part of normal care. Such feeding is a natural means of preserving life, not a medical act.

3.) Deliberate removal of such means to produce a premature death can be euthanasia, i.e. unjust killing.

4.) The obligation to provide assisted feeding lasts only as long as such feeding meets its goals of providing nourishment and alleviating suffering.

N. Y. STATE LEGISLATION

As of the deadline for July Life News the N.Y.S. Legislature is scheduled to meet for only six more days before adjourning on 6/22. It now seems very likely that all pro-life bills will die in committee. On 6/8 the Assembly Health Committee voted to hold in Committee all six of the pro-life bills they had considered that day. Nassau/Suffolk Members of the Assembly Health Committee are James Conte, Maureen O'Connell and Patricia Eddington. Conte and O'Connell voted against holding these bills in Committee. Please thank them for this pro-life vote. (Eddington voted to keep these bills in Committee.)

So far no pro-life bill has been considered by the Senate Health Committee. Thus it seems likely that all bills restricting abortion will die in committee again this year.

The good news so far in the 2003-2004 Session is that, as of 6/9, the bill which would allow Emergency Contraception, the so called "morning after pill", to be sold without a doctor's prescription has not passed the State Senate. The Assembly version of this legislation (A.888) passed the Assembly in February. The Senate will probably refuse to act on the Senate version of the bill (S.3339) because it was waiting for the FDA to approve it for sale without a prescription and that approval was not given.

A group calling itself "New Yorkers for the Advancement of Medical Research" has been lobbying the Senate recently for Sheldon Silver's dangerous "clone and kill" bill (A.6249A).

There is fear that this legislation could become law before the legislature recesses on June 22. Hopefully this will not happen and you will still have time to ask your State Senator to oppose embryonic stem research and human cloning and to ask he/she actively support Senate bill S.206, the Human Cloning Prohibition Act, the only true anti-cloning bill. Even if you already contacted your Senator, as suggested in May Life News do so again because if A.6249A does not pass in June it could be brought up in Special Session later in the year.

Please thank Senator Trunzo for sponsoring S.206.

HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT PARTIAL BIRTH ABORTION— THEIR OWN WORDS



The following is actual testimony from these cases. Please be aware that the material is gruesome and extremely upsetting.

We have all experienced disbelief when describing partial birth abortion to friends or family. "No one could do such a thing!" is the usual response. But the testimony of the abortionists themselves in the three court cases in New York, Nebraska and California is proof positive that this gruesome procedure is indeed performed. Immediately after President Bush signed the Partial Birth Abortion Ban on November 4, 2003, the abortion industry had federal courts in the above-named cities issue restraining orders to prevent the law from taking effect. Planned Parenthood Federation of America, the American Civil Liberties Union, the National Abortion Federation and the Center for Reproductive Rights were the organizations that filed lawsuits.

In the New York case before Judge Richard Casey, abortionist Carolyn Westhoff was questioned regarding information given to the woman prior to the abortion.

Casey: I want to know whether that woman knows that you are going to take a pair of scissors and insert them into the base of the skull of her baby, or her fetus. Do you tell her?

Westhoff: I do not usually tell patients specific details of the operative approach...

Casey: Do you tell her that you are going to then, ultimately, suck the brain out of the skull?

Westhoff: In all of our D&Es the head is collapsed or crushed and the brains are definitely out of the skull...

Casey: Do you tell them that?

Westhoff: Those are details that would be distressing to my patients and would not —information about that is not directly relevant to their safety.

Casey: ...whether it's relative to their safety or not don't you think since they're giving authorization to you to do this act that they should know precisely what you're going to do?

Westhoff: That's actually not the practice I have of discussing surgical cases with patients.

Casey: I didn't ask you that. I said don't you think they ought to know?

Westhoff: No, sir, I don't.

Attorney: How often will it be necessary to collapse the fetal skull during D&E whether the D&E proceeds by a dismemberment or more relatively intact, Doctor?

Westhoff: For the vast majority of D&Es it would be necessary to either crush or collapse the fetal skull.

Casey: Do you tell the woman that? Do you use the word crush? Westhoff: Your honor, I do not.

Abortionist Gerson Weiss was questioned on day eight of the trial.

Attorney: [When] you remove the fetus in a dismemberment procedure, are the pieces of the fetus covered by soft tissue?

Weiss: Frequently much of the bone is covered. It is quite likely that the ends of the bone in the area that is broken are uncovered and sharp.

Attorney: Can you eliminate the risks of retained fetal tissue in a D&E involving dismemberment by counting the fetal parts at the end of the procedure?

Weiss: No, you can't. You can count roughly. You can count

there is a limb here, I can see feet and hands, I can see skull fragments, I can see trunk. But when you see little pieces, if there are small pieces left behind that are torn off, you can't fully reconstruct and you cannot fully count the small pieces. Another way of looking at that is if you have a long bone that is broken into six parts, you are only going to say I see long bone parts. You will not be able to reconstruct to a point of that accuracy.

Attorney: Is your ability to bring the fetus out intact affected by the fetal tissue at that gestational age that you perform D&Es?

Weiss: The earlier the pregnancy the more fragile the fetus. So, grasping a fetus early on is more likely to tear it and less likely to allow you to bring it out whole. If the fetus were older its condition would be tougher enough that it could take, you could move it into an appropriate position easier.

Abortionist Stephen T. Chasen testified on day seven.

Casey: Does it hurt the baby?

Chasen: I don't know.

Casey: But you go ahead and do it anyway, is that right?

Chasen: I am taking care of my patients, and in that process, yes,

I go ahead and do it.

Casey: Does that mean you take care of your patient and the baby be damned, is that the approach you have?

Chasen: These women who are having [abortions] at gestational ages they are legally entitled to it –

Casey: I didn't ask you that, Doctor. I asked you if you had any caring or concern for the fetus whose head you were crushing.

Chasen: No.

Life Issues Connector, May 2004 reports "Abortionist Amos Gruenbaum of NY testified that partial birth abortion is necessary to insure an intact baby. He said women grieve less if they are able to see and hold the child they aborted. His abortion mill even takes pictures of the dead babies for the mothers as part of the grieving process." Gruenbaum said, "It is the same as any baby dying. People want to hold the fetus." The Connector reports abortionists testified that "they will arrange for burial of the baby if the mother desires. Small coffins are also on hand, as well as little hats to hide the incision in the back of the head where the brains were sucked out." Judge Casey asked Carolyn Westhoff "But did you tell them you would be sucking the brain out of the same baby that they desired to hold for the grieving process?" Westhoff replied, "I don't think that helps the grieving process."

Abortionist Leroy Carhart testified in Nebraska, "If I bring an arm down and bring it outside of the uterus and possibly even outside of the vagina, I'm not going to put that arm back inside of the woman's body to take bacteria back inside, so I'll remove that arm..." The goal is to bring the baby out feet first. The Connector reports that Carhart's "graphic testimony established they use time to ease the task of dismembering older babies. '... we are talking about a fetus that has been dead for 48 hours in essentially a warming oven or crock pot. It has been kept at a hundred degrees...that's enough temperature to cook meat...in my practice, we are dealing with a fetus that's both dead and soft, so it's much more pliable." When asked if he recommends using ultrasound, he responded yes, "I sleep better at night when I know what I've done."







QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Question: "Is Partial Birth Abortion Illegal to Perform."

Answer: No, in addition to the temporary injunction on the law President Bush signed in 2003, Judge Phyllis Hamilton declared it unconstitutional saying it infringes "on a woman's right to choose." She agreed with abortion rights activists that a woman's right to choose is paramount, and that it is therefore "irrelevant" whether a fetus suffers pain. Justice Department attorneys argued that it is inhumane and never medically necessary. Rep. Steve Chabot (R-Ohio) the chief sponsor of the House bill, said the banned abortion method "has no place in a civilized society."
