FEDERAL LEGISLATION

PRO-ABORTION ON LOSING END



The political party with the pro-abortion platform rightly suffered widely in the 11/04 elections. A national poll in November of 2004 by Wirthlin Worldwide found 75% in support of and only 18% opposed to this legislation.

The Unborn Child Pain Awareness Act would require that those performing abortions at or beyond the twenty-week point, provide the mother with certain information regarding the capacity of the unborn child to experience pain during the abortion and offer the mother the option of having pain-reducing drugs administered directly to the unborn child to reduce his or her pain.

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION



EMBRYONIC STEM CELL RESEARCH

In the opening weeks of the 2005 Session there was such intense lobbying by bio-tech firms that many expected Governor Pataki to amend his budget to include funds for embryonic stem cell research. The Governor's office received hundreds of calls opposing this and, as the amendment deadline passed, no such funds were included in his budget. Since the bio-tech firms are continuing to lobby for taxpayer funding of embryonic stem cell research it is imperative that we continue to lobby against such legislation.

UNINTENDED PREGNANCY ACT

On 1/31/05 the Assembly by a vote of 112 to 33 passed the Unintended Pregnancy Act (A.116). Please thank the following Nassau/Suffolk Assembly Members for voting against A.116: Acampora, Barra, Barraga, Fitzpatrick, O'Connell, Raia and Saladino. We must work to stop this bill in the Senate.

Action—Sample Message: Please oppose legislation such as recently passed A.116 which would allow emergency contraception (EC) to be sold without a doctor's prescription. EC can work as a true contraceptive by delaying ovulation and preventing conception but can also kill a newly formed human embryo by preventing implantation. Distribution of EC without a doctor's prescription exposes women, of any age, to mega-doses of potentially dangerous medication without a medical exam or physician oversight. Easy access to EC by young girls could be used to cover up instances of sexual abuse or dangerous promiscuous behavior. Regions where EC is sold without a doctor's prescription have seen a large increase in the incidence of sexually transmitted diseases (STD) without a corresponding decrease in unintended pregnancy.

If A.116 becomes law a large increase in Medicaid costs is likely because of the cost of treating greater numbers of STD cases.

Opposing bills such as A.116 will not only show me that you consider protection of our women and children important it is also the fiscally responsible choice.

HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT THE HISTORY OF THE OVERPOPULATION MYTH AND EUGENICS



(Editor's note: this is important background information for all pro-lifers to know, explaining the theoretical underpinnings of anti-life forces, the sources of their power and how they exert control. It will be serialized in the next several issues of *Life News*.)

PART I: THE ORIGIN OF EUGENICS

"The Inherent Racism of Population Control" is the title of Paul Jalsevac's fourth-year thesis at Christendom College. He was encouraged to publish the paper so that others could be made aware of the alarming movement that has its roots in the 18th century with England's first professor of political economy, Thomas Robert Malthus. In "An Essay On the Principle of Population", Malthus wrote, "It may be safely asserted, therefore, that population, when unchecked, increases in a geometrical progression of such a nature as to double itself every 25 years." According to Malthus, food production could only increase at an arithmetic ratio and therefore could never keep pace with population growth. Nature therefore needs to have "checks" to balance the two opposing forces. Malthus proposed "preventative" and "positive" checks. Preventative checks are those which slow population growth through human efforts. If these fail, it will be necessary to utilize positive checks which include "unwholesome occupations, sever labour and exposure to the seasons, extreme poverty, bad nursing of children, great towns, excesses of all kinds, the whole train of common diseases and epidemics, wars, plague and famine." If man cannot reduce population growth through the preventative check of "moral restraint through later marriages", then positive checks in the form of "vice and misery in the forms of war, pestilence and famine" must be utilized.

But Malthus did not feel that the burden of the positive checks should be shouldered by all. "The positive check... is confined chiefly, though not perhaps solely, to the lowest orders of society." Jalsevac explains Malthus' theory as follows: "Alleviating the situation of the poor so as to decrease the death rate and encourage procreation merely exacerbates the situation. It creates more poor people who will place an added stress on the already meager resources available, thereby necessitating an increased intensity in the positive checks flung at the poor by nature. By attempting to alleviate the suffering of the poor, in other words, 'nature' retaliates by increasing the 'positive checks' of war, famine and misery. Traditional philanthropy, consequently, is self-defeating. The strain...on a country's resources threatens to drag them [upper and middle classes] into the pool of suffering." Jalsevac labels this new form of racism—"whole segments of the population discriminated against based on their socioeconomic status"—scientific

racism. "According to this view the poor owned nothing—not even the right to live." The agricultural and technological advances made during Malthus' lifetime contradicted his theories, but Malthus never changed his opinion. Jalsevac states that historian Allan Chase suggested that Malthus became a "spokesman for the wealthy industrialists and landowners...to protect this vast reservoir of cheap labour...charitable attempts had the tendency to remove the necessary stimulus to industry."

Charles Darwin acknowledged that he was inspired by Malthus' theories. Biologist and philosopher Herbert Spencer applied evolutionary theory to his study of society that he called "synthetic philosophy". Jalsevac explains that "Spencer created Social Darwinism...the struggle of the marketplace and the greed and aggression of individuals were all simply the methods of survival of the fittest by which 'the unfit' were removed from society." Spencer also felt that "a careful program of selective breeding could produce a race of the superfit from the stock of the fittest." Darwin's cousin, Sir Francis Galton, "created the pseudo-science of eugenics, the science of improving stock not only by judicious mating, but whatever tends to give the more suitable races or strains of blood a better chance of prevailing over the less suitable than they otherwise would have had." Jalsevac states "Much of Galton's motivation came from his consuming fear that the lower and lesser classes, if supported and allowed to breed in good conditions, might overrun the world with their unfitness and hamper the natural improvement of the human race...Galton fought against all social reforms including hygienic reforms, laws supporting the poor, and education reforms...declaring certain races had inferior moral, intellectual and physical qualities...Galton advocated a removal of all societal aids to these groups, but also advocated a system of active prevention against their propagation...stern compulsion ought to be exerted to prevent the free propagation of the stock of those who are seriously afflicted by lunacy, feeble-mindedness, habitual criminality, and pauperism. He became the leading advocate of sterilization."

Spencer and Galton's theories appealed to the rich and elite including James J. Hill, John D. Rockefeller, Sr. and Andrew Carnegie. Historian Chase wrote, "Where Spencer offered 'revolutionary' rationales for low wages and subhuman working and living conditions, Galton offered the 'hereditary' reasons in the Natural Laws of biology for not wasting sympathy, money, education, and, above all else, health care on biologically low-class types who were destined by the Will of God and/or Nature to be nothing but drains on society and a rapidly proliferating population of hereditary paupers, thieves and parasites."

In the next part we will see the eugenics movement becoming established in Cold Spring Harbor and the rise of one of its most influential and dangerous adherents, Margaret Sanger, founder of Planned Parenthood.

Several times each month, and happening more frequently, a mother will change her mind and ask for help. These are serious and fragile situations during which pro-lifers can assist both mother and child with timely counseling and support. January, in Manhasset, the mother simply said "It's good you were here." At Smithtown, mid-January, a mother driving her teenage daughter for an abortion stopped to say "We need to make a decision. Where can we go, this morning, to sit down with a counselor."

There is a real need is for counseling centers to be open on Saturday mornings. As of 2/14 we have verified that Life Center's Massaqequa Office (516) 798-9100 at 35 East Willow Street, opens every Saturday 9AM -12 Noon. However, Roslyn Bank has been purchased by New York Community Bank, which has discontinued support to Planned Parenthood. While we don't know specifically what caused this change, we do know that pro-abortion groups lose support when their donors are educated with the truth, contrasting the prolife and "prochoice" agendas. Please continue to write letters, join boycotts, and participate in events that reveal the unhealthy truth about Planned Parenthood and its allies.

Life Decisions International (LDI), publisher of The Boycott List that identifies companies contributing to Planned Parenthood, announced that Newman's Own is no longer on the list. Among other companies we have mentioned here in the past, The Home Depot and Church & Dwight (Arm & Hammer brand) have been removed from the list, but Blimpie, Unilever (includes Dove, Q-Tips, Skippy, Breyers, Wisk), and Whole Foods are still on The Boycott List. 




