Eye on Life Issues

Austria, German, Italy, Malta, Poland and Slovakia have filed an official objection to the European Union's plans to subsidize experimentation on human embryos and petitioned that the EU invest in adult stem cell research. Adapted from Life Advocacy Briefing 12/05/05.


On 11/08/05 California, USA, voters rejected an initiative that would have required parents to be notified when girls 17 and under seek abortions. If passed California would have become the 35th state requiring parental notification. California's teen abortion rate is the nation's fourth highest. Adapted from The Associated Press 11/05.

GC Life Decisions International (LDI), which maintains the official pro-life boycott of corporations aiding Planned Parenthood, detailed Planned Parenthood's abortion toll based on its own published figures. "While national figures generally indicated a decrease in the number of abortions," says LDI, "Planned Parenthood Federation of America (PPFA) confessed to killing 244,628 preborn human beings in 2003," reports LDI in the release, "which was a 6.1% increase from the previous year, In 2004, PPFA admits," says the release, "that it took the lives of 255,015 human beings, an increase of nearly 4.3%." 'Twenty years ago,' " said Mr. Scott in the release,

" 'PPFA was directly responsible for more than 5.5% of all abortions committed in the United States. It is now responsible," he said, "'for nearly 20%.' " Source: Life Advocacy Briefings 12/19/05

AMERICAN GIRL DOLL STOPS FUNDING GIRLS INC. WITH "I CAN" BRACELET PROGRAM

In the wake of protests from pro-lifers, American Girl (a Mattel company) abruptly ended its "I Can" bracelet sales, which funded Girls, Inc., an organization that supports abortion. Although American Girl made no mention of the pro-life boycott when it ended sales of its "I Can" bracelet on December 26, 2005, those of you who called, wrote, or e-mailed American Girl to stop funding abortion supporters can take some credit for American Girl's decision. According to Pro-life Action League, which spearheaded the boycott and protests at the American Girl stores in Chicago and New York City, prolife voices were effective because Bath and Body Works, which carries American Girl products, quit the "I Can" bracelet program in November. In addition, American Girl had not previously indicated an end date for sales of the " Can" bracelet. We hope Mattel and American Girl have gotten the good news of the pro-life message, but be vigilant of Mattel and corporations who could deliberately or unsuspectingly serve the pro-abortion agenda.

BOYCOTTS ARE EFFECTIVE-UPDATE

Boycotts are not meant to be vindictive. They are, instead, a last resort to effect change within a corporation when education and dialogue have failed to produce the desired change of heart and mind. But consumers need to remind companies regularly that their products are being boycotted. Clip out a coupon for a product you are boycotting, cut it in half and send it to the manufacturer with a short note letting it know why you aren't buying

that company's goods. This CAN be effective. Life Decisions International (LDI) (www.fightpp.org; 540-631-0380), producers of "The Boycott List,", of companies that fund Planned Parenthood, announced in November 2005 that Prudential Financial has agreed to stop funding Planned Parenthood and has been dropped from "The Boycott List."

While we are grateful for the many companies who have stopped funding Planned Parenthood, we need to educate many more I DP's December 2005 edition of "The Boycott List" added several companies. Among them are Circuit City, Tommy Hilfiger, Nike, and Altria Group. Altria is the parent company of Kraft Foods and Phillip Morris. Moreover, Nabisco is part of Kraft Food Holdings. Altria's long list of products include: Post cereals, Capri Sun, Kool-Aid, Maxwell House, Cream of Wheat, Breakstone's, Breyers, Lorna Doone, Jell-O Polly-O, Minute Rice, Oreos, Triscuit, Oscar Mayer, Athenos, Planters, and Miracle Whip. FEDERAL LEGISLATION

CORD BLOOD STEM CELL BILL BECOMES LAW

The House, on 12/15/05 passed H.R. 2520 by a 413-0 vote. This bill promotes the use of umbilical cord blood for research and treatment of diseases. The U.S. Senate had passed a similar bill the previous day and President Bush signed the legislation 3 days later.

It was indeed refreshing to see both parties working together authorizing 79 million dollars to collect and store stem cells from umbilical cord blood. The bill establishes a data-base to help physicians and researchers access the cells for use in treatment and research of many ailments.

The passage of the Cord Blood Stem Cell bill came as a disappointment to some legislators who were attempting to pass the federal funding for research of embryonic stem cells taken from surplus embryos at fertility clinics. The employment of embryonic stem cells has not only been ineffective in curing diseases but has resulted in the death of these embryos.

ON SUPREME COURT APPOINTMENT

On 1/04/06 the American Bar Association gave Judge Samuel Alito the highest rating for his selection to the U.S. Supreme Court. We wish him well.

RIGHT TO LIFE ACT NEEDS SUPPORT

We urge you to contact your U.S. congressman to sponsor and support the Right To Life Act, H.R.552 dated 02/02/05 which is presently in the Judiciary Committee. It already has implement over 35 sponsors.

The Act's role is to implement equal protection for the right to life of each born and pre-born person. Article 1 Sections 5 and 8 of the 14th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution gives Congress this authority ",... nor shall any state deprive any person of life, liberty or property without due process of law; nor deny to any person within its iurisdiction the equal protection of the laws." This section of the Constitution is commonly referred to as the Equal Protection Clause. To date none of the members of congress listed below have signed on as sponsors.

We urge you to sponsor and support The Right To Life Act, H.R. 552 which will protect the lives of millions of pre-born babies from the excruciating painful death of abortion.

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION



In his State of the State Message on 1/04/06, Governor Pataki announced his intention to propose a new biotechnology research program that will leverage \$600 million in public and private funds. It is important that you let your state representatives know that you support stem cell research and regenerative medicine using ethical sources of stem cells, such as adult tissue and umbilical cord blood, but not immoral research involving cloning and the destruction of human embryos.

Sample Message:

I am writing to you concerning the proposed biotechnology research program. I strongly support use of my taxes to support ethical stem cell research using adult stem cells and umbilical cord blood stem cells. These two sources of cells are currently being used to treat blindness. diabetes, Crohn's disease, Systemic Lupus, Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinson's Disease, Sickle-Cell Anemia and other diseases.

I do not support human cloning and embryo research. I strongly oppose this form of human experimentation and do not want my tax dollars paying for the destruction of human life. I urge you to support the Human Cloning Prohibition Act, S.2400/A.4855, the only true ban on human cloning before the state legislature, and to oppose all embryonic stem cell research funding. Embryonic stem cell research has not produced any cures for disease or disability. It has resulted in adverse effects in animals including tumor growth and cancer. Promotion of embryonic stem cells as "the best hope" for a cure of human disease is dishonest, irresponsible, immoral and cruel to suffering individuals and their families who are searching for hope.

Please keep New York State a leader in biotechnology by supporting and funding ethical and promising adult stem cell and umbilical stem cell research programs. Thank you for your consideration. Please reply.

WILL HWANGGATE FINALLY TURN THE TIDE IN THE STEM CELL DEBATE?



Jill Stanek wrote at *Lifenews.com* on January 11, 2006, "Hwanggate...along with the ever-worsening California stem-cell debacle has helped chill all the hype. Last week, nervous New Jersey legislators shelved their plan to subsidize embryonic stem-cell and cloning experimentation. Hopefully, that's just the beginning."

An investigation by the South Korean university where Hwang-Woo-suk did his research found that he did not successfully clone human embryos or embryonic stem cells that could overcome rejection by a patient's immune system. Wesley Smith reported at Lifenews.com on December 29, 2005, "Hwang's implosion leaves the field of human cloning research in a state of meltdown. Their poster boy is at best a liar, at worst a fraud and a charlatan who never created human clones at all." Smith raises several questions. How thorough is the peer review process? How did the peer reviewers at Science miss what young South Korean scientists were able to uncover? "Will the American media take a cue from their courageous counterparts in South Korea, who pursued this story until it cracked, and finally bring skepticism to their coverage of biotechnology? More to the point, will the adult/umbilical cord blood stem cell successes that have emerged one after the other in recent years finally receive the attention they deserve in the mainstream press, which has been so intoxicated with embryonic research as virtually to ignore nonembryonic breakthroughs?"

Smith continues, "Don't count on it. The procloning forces, and their media allies, recognize the potential of the Hwang fiasco to damage their cause, so they have quickly regrouped and begun to furiously spin the story. The same voices that not long ago railed against President Bush's stem cell funding policies for supposedly allowing America to fall behind the cutting-edge research in South Korea, now indignantly ponder how science's core values of integrity and objectivity are being corroded by the passionate political pursuit of a legal license to clone."

Smith uses Robert Klein and California's Proposition 71 as an example. Klein was one of the most vocal supporters of the initiative. He "assured voters that universities and private firms receiving grants would share \$1 billion or more in royalties with the state." These monies would cover some and possibly all of the money borrowed to fund the initial research. Smith comments "Voters should have asked themselves why, if this were true, the state's numerous venture capitalists hadn't been clever enough to fork over the \$3 billion." The San Francisco Chronicle wrote, "What Klein knew before the election was that such royalty-sharing by the state might be hampered by federal regulations, according to an attorney who helped Klein draft the initiative. Yet he didn't tell voters."

Smith reports that supporters of the initiative sued to prevent information from being published in the state voter election guide. This information would show that the initiative "explicitly created a state constitutional right to conduct human somatic cell nuclear transfer, the scientific name for a human cloning technique."

Smith also highlighted the deliberately misleading information concerning Alzheimer's disease. Rick Weiss, science reporter for the *Washington Post*, wrote in a June 10, 2004 article, "the infrequently voiced reality, stem cell experts confess, is that, of all the diseases that may someday be cured by embryonic stem cell treatments, Alzheimer's is among the least likely to benefit. Alzheimer's is a whole brain disease that involves the loss of huge numbers and variables of the brain's 100 billion nerve cells and countless connections, or synapses, among them." Weiss quoted Ronald D.G. McKay, stem cell researcher at the National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke: "To start with, people need a fairy tale. Maybe that's unfair, but they need a story line that's relatively simple to understand."

Smith concludes, "We don't know to what depths the dishonesty of the seemingly most successful researcher in




