
Good Friday Silent Vigil Raises Awareness About Abortion


YOU'RE INVITED

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

OTHER STATES FOLLOW SOUTH DAKOTA

Last month South Dakota Governor Rounds signed a law banning all abortions except if the mother's life is threatened. Now the legislators in five more states: Ohio, Georgia, Indiana, Kentucky, and Tennessee are considering bans that would severely limit or altogether prohibit abortions in their states.

One of these abortion bans may force the U.S. Supreme Court to reexamine Roe v Wade and subsequently move the responsibility to uphold the unalienable right to life to the voters of each state.

BISHOPS SUPPORT HOLLY'S LAW

The Long Island Coalition for Life backs the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops in supporting Holly's law, H.R. 1079, titled the "RU-486 Suspension and Review Act". Named in honor of Californian, Holly Patterson who died from toxic shock after being given RU-486. Eight women in the U.S. are reported to have died after using RU-486.

Every RU-486 abortion involves at least involves at least two drugs: RU-486 (mifepristone) which shuts down the baby's life support system, and misoprostol, a prostaglandin which is given two days later to stimulate powerful uterine contractions to expel the emaciated corpse.

I urge you to support the RU-486 Suspension and Review Act S.511/H.R. 1079 which would help prevent the deaths of unborn infants and injury or occasional injury or death to their mothers.

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION



EMBRYONIC STEM CELL RESEARCH

The 2006 NYS Budget which passed the Senate and Assembly on 3/31 did not contain the \$20 million in funds for biotechnology and biomedical research as announced in a 1/26 joint proposal of Gov. Pataki and Senate Majority Leader Bruno. Because embryonic stem cell research (ESCR) was not specifically excluded from the Governor/Senator's proposal, it is GOOD NEWS that this \$20 million was not included in the Budget. Also, GOOD NEWS is the \$5 million included in the budget for umbilical cord blood stem cell funding.

HOWEVER, as stated in 4/06 Life News, the intense pressure on the Governor and the legislators from biotechnology companies and institutions to fund embryonic stem cell research continues relentlessly. These are several bills before the legislature which would actually authorize and fund the cloning of human embryos for research purposes, as long as they are not allowed to be born alive. These bills would encourage and finance the destruction of living embryos and harvesting of their body parts. We can, and must, prevent these bills from becoming law. Action:

- --Continue to gather signatures on the petition in 4/06 Life News.
- -- Write, FAX or call the Governor and your State Senator.
- -Arrange a meeting with your State Senator in his district office. Invite several of his pro-life constituents to join you. These meeting are key to preventing funding of ESCR and passing the Human Cloning Prohibition Act S.2400/A.4855.
- L.I. Senators are key to stopping ESCR funding.

--Sample message—We object to the use of human embryos and cloning procedures for experimentation and do not want our tax dollars funding this research. We urge you to support investment in adult and umbilical cord blood stem cell research. Embryonic stem cell research has not resulted in even one human cure or medical success. In contrast, adult stem cells from bone marrow, blood, and the umbilical cord blood of newborn babies are currently being used to treat cancers, anemia, leukemia, paralysis, bone disease, heart damage, brain damage, hearing and sight loss, organ damage and immune system disease. Isn't it wonderful that all these cures are possible without any destruction of human life?

FETAL FARMING – THE NEXT BATTLE



The Spring 2006 issue of *Lifeline*, a publication of the Life Legal Defense Foundation, contains an article by Robert P. George, McCormick Professor of Jurisprudence and director of the James Madison Program in American Ideals and Institutions at Princeton. The article, entitled "Fetal Attraction – What the stem cell scientists really want," first appeared in the 10/3/05 edition of *The Weekly Standard*. The article is a wake-up call for all of us to the real intentions of the embryonic stem cell research community.

Adult and umbilical cord stem cells have already been successful in treating over 65 diseases. Almost every week a new study is released reporting on the use of adult or umbilical cord stem cells for various illnesses and conditions. Harvard researchers produced embryonic stem cells without destroying a living human embryo. Researchers at the University of Pittsburgh and the University of Texas retrieved cells from placental tissue and umbilical cord blood that can be programmed to develop into other types of cells. On 3/14/06, Reuters reported Japanese researchers harvested stem cells from human menstrual blood that could possibly be a source of specialized heart cells for failing or damaged hearts. On 3/26/06, Lifenews.com reported a German research team found adult stem cells in mice testicles that "could also be prompted to turn into different types of tissue, including liver, heart, muscle, skin, pancreas and nerve cells. Dr Gerd Hasenfuss indicated his team was beginning to study the cells in human males and has found similar results so far." The 3/10/06 issue of ALL's Communique reported on a study that is evaluating the use of adult stem cells to re-grow meniscus. Cedars-Sinai Medical Center issued a news release on 3/5/06 stating that researchers "have found that neural stem cells from bone marrow can be helpful in tracking and killing malignant brain tumor cells." Lifenews.com (12/13/05) reported that scientists at the University of Louisville discovered an adult stem cell in mice that could change into brain, nerve, heart muscle and pancreatic cells. The next step is to replicate the experiment using human cells.

Then why aren't all researchers happy with these discoveries? The Lifeline article explains that "Up to now, embryonic stem cell advocates have claimed that they are only interested in stem cells harvested from embryos at the blastocyst stage. They have denied any intention of implanting embryos either in the uterus of a volunteer or in an artificial womb in order to harvest cells, tissues, or organs at more advanced stages of embryonic development or in the fetal stage. Advocates are well aware that most Americans, including those who are prepared to countenance the destruction of very early embryos, are not ready to approve the macabre practice of 'fetus farming'. However, based on the literature I have read and the evasive answers given by spokesman for the biotechnology industry at meetings of the President's Council on Bioethics, I fear that the long-term goal is indeed to create an industry in harvesting late embryonic and fetal body parts for use in regenerative medicine and organ transplantation. This would explain why some advocates of embryonic stem cell research are not cheering the news about alternative sources

of pluripotent stem cells. If their real goal is fetus farming, then the cells produced by alternative methods will not serve their purposes. Why would biomedical scientists be interested in fetus farming? Researchers know that stem cells derived from blastocyst-stage embryos are currently of no therapeutic value and may never actually be used in the treatment of diseases...In fact, there is not a single embryonic stem cell therapy even in clinical trials. All informed commentators know that embryonic stem cells cannot be used in therapies because of their tendency to generate dangerous tumors. However, recent studies show that the problem of tumor formation does not exist in cells taken from cows, mice, and other mammals when embryos have been implanted and extracted after several weeks or months of development... This means that the real therapeutic potential lies precisely in the practice of fetus farming. Because the development process stabilizes cells (which is why we are not all masses of tumors), it is likely true that stem cells, tissues, and organs harvested from human beings at, say, 16 or 18 weeks or later could be used in the treatment of diseases.

Scientists associated with a leading firm in the embryonic stem cell field, Advanced Cell Technology, recently published a research paper discussing the use of stem cells derived from cattle fetuses that had been produced by cloning (to create a genetic match). Although the article did not mention human beings, it was plain that the purpose of the research was not to cure diseased cows, but rather to establish the potential therapeutic value of doing precisely the same thing with human beings. For those who have ears to hear, the message is clear. I am hardly the first to perceive this message. Slate magazine bioethics writer Will Saletan drew precisely the same conclusion in a remarkable five-part series, the final installment of which was entitled 'The Organ Factory: The Case for Harvesting Older Human Embryos."

The writer goes on to warn that if we don't ban fetal farming now, public sentiment could change. Most people now find the prospect of fetal farming abhorrent. But if these researchers are permitted to continue and find cures for several diseases or conditions using this technology, many people may suddenly change their minds. As Mr. George states, "I suspect that those in the biotech industry who do look forward to fetus farming are betting that moral opposition will collapse when the realistic prospect of cures is placed before the public... New Jersey has passed a bill that specifically authorizes and encourages human cloning for, among other purposes, the harvesting of 'cadaveric fetal tissue.' A 'cadaver', of course, is a dead body. The bodies in question are those of fetuses created by cloning specifically to be gestated and killed as sources of tissues and organs. What the bill envisages and promotes, in other words, is fetus farming. The biotechnology industry put an enormous amount of money into pushing this bill through the New Jersey legislature and is now funding support for similar bills in states around the country..."

Things cannot remain as they are. The battle over embryonic stem cell research will determine whether we as a people move in the direction of restoring our sanctity of life ethic, or go in precisely the opposite direction. Either we will protect embryonic human life more fully than we do now, or we will begin creating human beings precisely as 'organ factories'. Those of us on the pro-life side must take the measure of the problem quickly so that we can develop and begin implementing a strategy that takes the nation in the honorable direction."
