- --Courting pro-abortion clergy at its annual national prayer breakfast and encouraging Planned Parenthood volunteerism in local churches
- --As backlash to President Bush's restrictions, creating a new fund to promote legalized abortion in countries where it is not illegal, such as Africa and South America ((IPPA)

- --Marketing Planned Parenthood as a health care, not abortion, provider (strategy of Cecile Richards, new president Planned Parenthood Federation of America)
- --Targeting states with high populations of traditionally pro-life Latin Americans with greater number of abortion centers, e.g., California, New York and Texas
- --Proposing opening abortion centers on Indian reservations in states where abortion is banned, e. g., South Dakota, to be free of state or federal restrictions
- --Hiring Christopher Barron, political director of Log Cabin Republicans gay rights group, to reach out to pro-abortion Republicans. Source: Cincinnati RTL, May 2006.

# PLANNED PARENTHOOD DOES 20% OF ALL ABORTIONS:

In 2003, Planned Parenthood killed 244,000 developing babies. The following year the number killed was 255,000. Planned Parenthood now performs 20% of all abortions in the U.S. This is in the face of a slowly decreasing total number of abortions done nationally. Twenty years ago, Planned Parenthood was responsible for 5½%.

In 1992, Planned Parenthood operated 922 facilities nationwide. This has now dropped to 850. It now operates 172 killings centers that do surgical abortions, plus 57 more centers that do chemical abortions using the dangerous drug RU-486. 595 other Planned Parenthood locations distribute the abortive morning after pill. ### **OVERSEAS MILITARY ABORTIONS**

On 5/10/06, the House of Representatives voted down, by a vote of 191-237, an amendment to the Defense Authorization Act to fund abortions in overseas military hospitals. Regrettably L. I. Congressional Members Bishop, Israel, McCarthy, and Ackerman voted in favor of the funding. Pro-life King opposed the amendment. Source: Life Advocacy Briefing 5/15/06.

#### ADULT STEM CELL INDUSTRY GROWING:

The adult stem cell research industry is growing rapidly. For instance, Cord Blood Registry, the world's largest adult stem cell bank, reported an 83% growth rate. #### THALASSEMIA CURED BY STEM CELL

The genetic blood disorder Thalassemia until now has been incurable. At the San Matteo Clinic in Pavia, Italy according to *Reuters*, 9/06/05, using stem cells obtained from the placenta of his newborn twin brother, the boy with this blood disorder was cured. These were not embryonic stem cells, but another ethical use of adult stem cells. Again, embryonic stem cells have not cured a single disease to date. Source: Cincinatti RTL 5/06

# CRISIS PREGNANCY CENTERS 'CRACKDOWN' THREAT

Crisis Pregnancy Centers (CPC's) purpose is to protect and save the lives of innocent unborn babies by providing education and material assistance. Some CPC's have received abstinence programs funding from the millions the federal government awards to abstinence programs. Rep. Carolyn Maloney objects to grants to CPC's for abstinence programs calling it a "windfall for crisis pregnancy centers from Bush administration funding". In an effort to stop the funds she is charging that some centers have presented themselves as "family planning centers" to lure women and talk them out of getting an abortion.

On 3/30/06, Rep. Carolyn Maloney (D-N.Y.) introduced H.R. 5052, "Stop Deceptive Advertising for Women Services Act" to start a FDA "crackdown" on CPC's for falsely advertising abortion services.

### NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION



At the deadline for submission of this column there are only eight days left in the 2005/2006 Legislative Session scheduled to conclude on 6/22.

#### **GOOD NEWS**

---Five million dollars is once again available for a NYS umbilical cord blood center in Syracuse. (Although this budget item was vetoed by Gov. Pataki the Legislature overrode his veto.)

---Assembly bill 457A which would promote umbilical cord blood banking and umbilical cord blood research has moved quickly through committees. We are hoping for passage by the Assembly. (This bill passed the Senate.)

#### **BAD NEWS**

--On 6/6 a number of pro-life bills (parental notification, Family Protection Act, partial-birth abortion ban, etc.) were on the Assembly Health Committee agenda. None of these bills were voted out of committee. Year after year this is the way Assembly Chairman Richard Gottfried "kills" pro-life legislation.

For months you have been lobbying intensively against tax-payer funding of human cloning and embryonic stem cell research because embryonic stem cells can only be obtained by killing living human embryos. We have asked legislators to support funding of research using adult stem cells, including umbilical cord blood cells. We are very thankful that so many legislators are supporting cord blood research. We are disappointed that the Human Cloning Prohibition Act (S.2400/A. 4855) has not passed, but we are somewhat hopeful that A.6300 or any other bill which funds embryonic stem cell research will fail to become law.

We have opposed the Family Health Care Decisions Act (S.5807/A.5406) because it fails to protect families' rights to continue life-sustaining treatments for their loved ones. We are hoping this bill will not pass.

As of now bills which would allow distribution of "emergency contraception" without a patient specific prescription are not moving. As you know a similar bill was vetoed by Gov. Pataki last year.

### SCNT/ANT/OAR – The Progression of Embryonic Stem Cell Research-The Moral Arguments



Embryonic stem cell research, which requires the destruction of days-old human beings, continues to be promoted, despite the fact that not one person has been cured with this process. In fact, studies have shown that embryonic stem cells (ESC) can cause dangerous tumors when used. However, the scientific community has been relentless in its support for ESC research. In comparison, adult stem cells, which can be retrieved from various organs within the body, as well as umbilical cord cells, have successfully treated thousands of patients.

The current sources of embryonic stem cells are the "left-over" embryos from in vitro fertilization clinics and the existing human embryonic stem cell lines. This supply is, of course, limited. Therefore, the scientific and biotech communities now promote somatic cell nuclear transfer (SCNT)—which is cloning—to produce the number of embryos needed to supply their research. SCNT involves removing the nucleus from an adult cell and transferring it into an enucleated (nucleus removed) oocyte (egg cell). Two schools, Harvard and the University of California, San Francisco, have initiated cloning projects, despite the fact that a majority of the general public opposes cloning. Researchers have attempted to separate cloning into two categories: therapeutic and reproductive. They argue that therapeutic cloning is more acceptable, since the embryos created will be destroyed when the ESC's are retrieved. In contrast, they argue that reproductive cloning would be used to create "designer children". In both cases, thousands of embryos will be destroyed to "perfect" the process, in addition to those who will continue to be destroyed in order to harvest cells. Many fear that in the not-so-distant future, scientists will propose using cloning for fetal farming purposes in order to grow made-to-order organ replacements.

During the last presidential election, John Kerry accused prolifers who oppose embryonic stem cell research of being "antiscience". In response to this labeling, William Hurlbut proposed another method of providing embryonic stem cells, ANT-altered nuclear transfer. The process is similar to SCNT. A cell is removed from a patient. The DNA in the nucleus is "altered." The gene that triggers growth and development is suppressed. The nucleus is removed from a human oocyte (egg cell). The altered nucleus is fused with the egg cytoplasm. The new "ANT" cell will produce the necessary pluripotent or embryonic stem cells. These cells will be genetically identical to the patient; therefore there would be no threat of rejection. The cell does not develop into a fetus. Rather, a teratoma-like growth occurs. Adrian J. Walker argues in Communio (32, Spring 2005, p. 190), "The original ANT strategy seems more to produce embryos with timed genetic defects than no embryos at all." Joan Frawley Desmond wrote in Crisis Magazine, "A few scientists and politicians who had expressed no compunction about the creation and destruction of human embryos signaled their dismay that ANT might lead to the possible, if inadvertent, creation of disabled embryos." Roberto Colombo stated, "The product of ANT is not a biological entity devoid of a complete human genome, but a developing organism with its full human genome, i.e., a human organism, a human being... A human embryo is a human organism not because it will become a fetus or a newborn baby, but as a result of the intrinsic unity...of its cells... early cleaving embryos... are not just a 'heap of cells', but an ordered, integrated, and coordinated number of blastomeres that grow according to a precise developmental plan...The abnormal

embryo development and the lack of formation of a 'true human blastocyst' are not the consequences of a defective genome, but an intentionally induced temporary block of the biosynthesis of one or more of the genes that are required for formation of the trophectoderm (or for whatever other normal developmental event ANT would suppress)...the mere probability that a human embryo is involved in the ANT procedure would suffice to justify an absolutely clear prohibition of such a possible biotechnique." (Communio 31, Winter 2004 pgs. 645-648)

In response, Markus Grompe proposed another form of ANT -Oocyte-Assisted Reprogramming (OAR). It has been observed that transcription factors, including the homeoprotein Nanog, are "expressed" in pluripotent stem cells, but not in oocytes or single-cell embryos. Cell differentiation is blocked when these factors are present. The cell is not totipotent "(having the developmental capacity to differentiate in an orderly and coordinated way into all the tissue types necessary for full organismal development)." The enucleated egg cell cytoplasm is 'reprogrammed' so that transcription factors such as Nanog are 'expressed' at very high levels. In this way, the cytoplasm will steer the donor cell nucleus in a pluripotent direction. Hurlbut and Grompe believe that the newly created entity bypasses the totipotent one-cell embryonic state and immediately creates a pluipotent stem cell. In contrast, the oocyte cytoplasm in cloning steers the somatic nucleus to form a totipotent embryo. (Walker, Communio 32, Spring 2005 pgs. 189-190)

On June 20, 2005, a Joint Statement titled Production of Pluripotent Stem Cells by Oocyte Assisted Reprogramming was issued. It was signed by pro-life scientists and theologians. It stated "Human cloning has been proposed as a means of generating human embryos whose pluripotent stem cells would be used in scientific and medical research. Here, through a form of ANT, we propose to utilize the power of epigenetic reprogramming in combination with controlled alterations in gene expression to directly produce pluripotent cells using adult somatic nuclei, without generating and subsequently destroying embryos." The statement supports research on nonhuman animal cells. Only if this research proves beyond a reasonable doubt that OAR can produce pluripotent stem cells without creating embryos, would they support research on human cells. (www.eppc.org 6/20/05)

There are ethicists and theologians who are not assured that OAR is morally acceptable. Walker argues, "OAR may be able to reduce the time lapse between the genesis of the totipotent zygote and its confinement within its pluripotent straitjacket to what seems to be zero... We cannot pull pluripotent stem cells out of thin air, or even, for that matter, assemble them from pre-existing parts. All we can really do is modify the developmental process that leads to them... OAR, like all the other methods of ANT, is not the creation of stem cells without the creation of any embryo, but the cloning of a modified embryo. OAR, in a word, is cloning with a twist... I understand, of course, that they are motivated by a laudable desire to replace current methods of ESC research with a morally acceptable alternative. Nevertheless, their willingness to invade, and to attempt to refashion, the beginnings of human life seems an odd way to go about saving it. Despite their praiseworthy wish to forestall the creation and destruction of human embryos for research purposes, proponents of ANT end up conceding much too much to the mentality that underlies and legitimates that practice in the first place. After all, if ANT's defenders really had the power over nature's way of procreating that theyunder the cover of bad metaphysics and faulty logic-claim to have, would this not strip procreation, and the human life that flows from it, of any intrinsic dignity that could not be bestowed and removed by the fiat of the scientist?"

Local pro-lifers and members of Long Island Coalition for Life stood on busy streets (sidewalks) in Hempstead, Garden City, Uniondale, Greenvale and Farmingdale to present our message to various public venues. The plight of the preborn will not be noticed unless we do noticeable things (peaceably and within the law).

NYS Senator Hillary Clinton, whose extremist pro-abortion stance includes support for the infanticidal partial-birth abortion, was the speaker at both the CW Post and Adelphi University graduations. Pro-lifers held signs such as:

Graduates and their families were similarly greeted by pro-lifers at SUNY Farmingdale's graduation. NYS Attorney General Eliott Spitzer, the lead Democratic Party candidate for NYS governor, was the commencement speaker. As attorney general, Spitzer has unabashedly attacked pro-life help centers in this state.

The majority of those graduating college this year are abortion survivors - under 33 years old. When Spitzer is offered as a role model to graduating coeds, it is more than appropriate for pro-lifers to witness on

behalf of those silenced and hurt by his policies.

When Clinton is awarded an honorary degree, it is fitting that pro-lifers give public dissent. Most of the graduates will soon be in the work force where the pressure to make a good impression and advance will lead too many of them to choose abortion because a baby will interfere with a new career. Those of us who stood outside these events offered an alternative view to the culture of death too often pushed on college students. Greeted by both jeers and cheers, this proved to be a useful way to make the effects of the anti-life policies of public officials more noticeable.

Some Democrats are giving the illusion of moving to the center of the political spectrum in order to lure pro-lifers to vote for them despite the candidate's pro-abortion stance. Meanwhile, some Republicans seem to have forgotten that party's pro-life platform. Pro-lifers, regardless of party affiliation, want pro-life candidates. That is why a handful of pro-lifers took advantage of the NYS Republican Party convention being held in Nassau County (the state Democratic convention was in Buffalo). Pro-lifers held signs urging delegates to vote pro-life, noting that babies like pro-life representatives. This was a great opportunity, in one venue in a short amount of time, to witness to and be noticed by busloads of delegates and many public officials.



A young mother stopped at our table in Mineola and started talking about using sonograms to show fetal development. She was informed about the battle in Congress to get funding for pro-life pregnancy resource centers to buy sonograms because it has been shown that a high percentage of women who are considering abortion change their mind when they see their baby on the sonogram. With that our visitor pointed to her little girl in the stroller and said, "That's why she's here."



# Spiritually "Adopt a Baby" Program

An excellent "intercessory prayer" activity for the entire parish community, Spiritual Adoption, is a very easy pro-life project.

We know there are pre-born infants in danger of abortion. Therefore, this program invites the community to commit themselves to praying every day for the nine months, praying that the mother and father of an infant receive the strength by God's Spirit to continue to choose life.

#### Where to start?

Begin the program with a sign-up weekend. Participants sign a pledge card promising to pray every day for a baby they spiritually adopt and for his/her parents. The pledge card suggests the Spiritually Adopted baby be given a name and may include prayers for example:

#### A Prayer for Aborted Babies

Dear God, I pray that you will help parents of aborted children seek forgiveness, confident that in your infinite mercy you will forgive them, assure them that you have welcomed their children into heaven and help them to know your healing and reconciling grace.

### Monthly Development Report:

During each of the nine months the parish bulletin updates the child's development. For example:

#### 3rd Month Developing Baby:

Your baby is quite active now. If his/her mother's womb had a window, you could watch your Spiritually Adopted baby squint, swallow, and move his tongue. Your baby can make a tight fist if you touch his/her palm.

Baby obtains the oxygen his body needs through the umbilical cord. The baby you are praying for weighs one ounce.

#### Suggestions for concluding the program:

A closing Mass or Service, a Communion Breakfast, a "Baby Shower" from which the gifts, diapers, formula can be donated to a nearby crisis pregnancy center.

**Note:** Volunteers say that diapers, receiving blankets, Onesies, and bibs are the most needed items.

A middle-aged woman taking literature from our table at the Lindenhurst fair said that her mother had five abortions. This live daughter didn't know much else about the circumstances surrounding the abortion, but she inherently felt a loss. She admitted somewhat sheepishly that she decided to name her siblings; she believes she had three sisters and two brothers. Often one of the steps in post-abortion healing programs is having the mother name her aborted baby. And here was this woman, unaware that post-abortion trauma was real, yet trying to cope by naming her siblings. She accepted

### **QUESTION & ANSWER**

What Is Post Abortion Syndrome (PAS)?

Many women are very ambivalent about getting aborted but do go ahead. Those around her told her (and she told herself) that it wouldn't bother her. When symptoms occur she tells herself it can't be the abortion causing them, and then into play come her two major psychological defense mechanisms: Repression and Denial.

For some this works successfully. For others it shades off to manageable distress, to severe and life-changing upset and even to suicide.
