## FEDERAL LEGISLATION GOOD NEWS FOR THE UNBORN

At 10:20 A.M. on 4/18/07 Justice Anthony Kennedy spokesman for the majority opinion announced that the U.S. Supreme Court upheld the law banning

partial-birth abortions which had passed both houses of Congress and had been signed into law by President Bush. America's crusade for safeguarding the lives of the pre-born has, thank God, succeeded in achieving a milestone— the beginning of the restoration of the unborn's right to Life. Prayers and hard work are still required to bring total justice to the innocent unborn.

#### **VERMONT'S PHYSICIAN-ASSISTED SUICIDE**

**DEFEATED**—Despite losing 15 seats in the 2006 elections, and euthanasia supporters pouring big money into this "death with dignity" campaign Vermont struck down physician-assisted suicide.

THANK YOU TO PRO-LIFE CONGRESSMAN PETER KING. The pro-abortion federal Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) was introduced in the House on 3/27/07 by Rep. Carolyn Maloney (D-NY) with 192 cosponsors (including Nassau/Suffolk Members Ackerman, Bishop, Israel and McCarthy). Opposed was pro-life Rep. Peter King. That same day the ERA was introduced in the Senate by Senator Edward Kennedy (D-MA.) with 20 co-sponsors (including N.Y. Senators Schumer and Clinton). This ERA is referred to by some as "the Women's Equality Amendment". Pro-life opposes any ERA that does not contain an abortion neutral clause. The original ERA, also an attempt to enshrine a right to abortion in the U.S. Constitution, died in 1982 after a long struggle waged by Stop-ERA leader Phyllis Schlafly, Eagle Forum founder, and many others.

**ANTI-CLONING BILL S. 1036**— This bill passed the House in 2001 and 2003. However, strong pro-cloning forces in the Senate keep it from passing.

Action—Sample Message to Senators Schumer and Clinton: Please support S.1036 sponsored by Senators Mary Landrieu and Sam Brownback to prohibit the use of cloning to create human embryos anywhere in the United States.

#### NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

Citing the recent Supreme Court decision upholding a ban on partial-

birth abortion, Governor Eliot Spitzer promised to implement his campaign pledge to enshrine the "right" to abortion—including late-term abortions—in New York State law, in the event that Roe v. Wade is ever overturned. The bill would enact the "Reproductive Health and Privacy Act" under the Public Health Law. In his 5/04/07 "E-Mail Blast" to his supporters the Governor announced that this bill would "solidify the protections of Roe v. Wade into New York State law...[and] ensure that New York's women have the same or stronger reproductive rights as those currently afforded them under "Roe...".

Our Governor has again made clear that despite his statement in the "State of the State" message that special interests need to be disarmed Spitzer wholeheartedly supports the agenda of powerful and well funded pro-abortion organizations such as, Planned Parenthood, NARAL, Pro-Choice New York, Family Planning Advocates of New York State and the Center for Reproductive Rights. The executive of the NYCLU said that the "modernization of New York State's abortion law is long overdue and the NYCLU applauds the Governor's leadership in spearheading that process at this critical moment."

As of the deadline for this column the "Reproductive Health and Privacy Act" has not been introduced. However, this is a great opportunity to convince our elected representatives and voters that there is an urgent need to rewrite state law in order to protect human life.

and Assembly Member: Please restore democracy in our state by using your position to ensure that pro-life bills are voted out of committee and debated on the floor. In recent years all bills restricting abortion have died in committee. It is not surprising that N.Y. is referred to as the "abortion capital of the country". In the recent partial-birth abortion decision the Supreme Court recognized that abortion is the taking of a human life, and that government has a legitimate interest in protecting and preserving this life at every stage. I hope that this decision will lead to a dialogue on abortion.

Please reject the Governor's proposed Reproductive Health and Privacy Act. Please reply. Thank you.

## Breast Cancer, The Pill, and Abortion



There are several excellent brochures/booklets available from the Breast Cancer Prevention Institute, 9 Vassar St., Poughkeepsie, NY 12601, (Phone 1-866-622-6237), www.bcpinstitute.org. The brochure titled If it's not OK for him to take steroids...why is it OK for her? addresses the dangers of the birth control/morning after pills. It states, "The dangerous performance enhancing steroids taken by athletes are male steroid hormonal drugs that build muscle. One of their risks is liver cancer. Similarly, female steroid hormonal drugs build breast tissue. They not only increase the risk of liver cancer but breast and cervical cancers as well. These powerful steroid drugs are taken by millions of teenage girls as birth control pills."

Young girls have not yet developed the breast tissue components that are more resistant to cancer. Breast tissue has four stages of development: Type 1 lobules develop in puberty as estrogen levels rise and breasts begin to develop; Type 2 lobules can begin to form during puberty as well; cancer-resistant Type 3 lobules form after the 32<sup>nd</sup> week of pregnancy; and Type 4 lobules actively produce milk. Before a full-term pregnancy, the breast is made up primarily of Type 1 and 2 lobules. 95% of all breast cancers start in Type 1 and 2 lobules. After a full-term pregnancy, the breast consists primarily of fully mature, cancer resistant Type 3 lobules.

"Both alone and in combination, the powerful steroids estrogen and progesterone and their synthetic equivalents (estrogen derivatives and progestins) can cause breast cancer through these two mechanisms:

- 1. They cause the breast tissue to grow which can result in mutations and ultimately cancers. (Cancer results from accumulated mutations in a cell causing uncontrolled growth.)
- 2. Estrogens can act as direct carcinogens causing cancer cells to form. (There are breakdown products of estrogen (metabolites) which can directly damage DNA, causing mutations and cancers to form.)

Through public media coverage in 2002, women of this country were made aware of breast cancer risk from using HRT (Hormone Replacement Therapy). Although the same type of drugs found in HRT are also found in birth control pills in even higher doses, their breast cancer risk remains widely unknown by the public.

Many thousands of cases of breast cancer a year are attributable to these powerful steroid drugs. This is because millions of women take these drugs each year."

The brochure Reproductive Breast Cancer Risks and Breast Lobule Maturation states that "The 'susceptibility window,' the period between puberty and a fullterm pregnancy, is the time the breast is most susceptible to forming cancer; i.e., when the woman's breast is composed primarily of Type 1 and 2 lobules. A woman who has a full-term pregnancy decreases her breast cancer risk. The longer a woman waits before having her first child, the higher her risk because she has a longer 'susceptibility window'. Full-term births cause near complete maturation of the breast to Type 4 lobules therefore lowering breast cancer risk. A pregnancy ending between 32 and 36 weeks has about 90% of the protective effect of a full-term pregnancy of 40 weeks. If the first full-term pregnancy occurs late in the woman's reproductive life, her risk is transiently elevated in the first few years post partum. This is due to mutated cells that may have formed during a long 'susceptibility window,' which then may become cancerous. Cancer cells already present at conception may grow faster under the stimulation of the elevated pregnancy hormones estrogen and progesterone.

Induced abortion of a normal pregnancy during which there has been breast growth results in increased risk of breast cancer in the mother. The later in pregnancy an abortion is done, the higher the risk of breast cancer as the more Type 1 and Type 2 lobules will have formed. Induced abortion leaves a woman with more places for breast cancer to start."

Karin Michels of Brigham and Women's Hospital headed a Harvard University study on breast cancer. She stated that a woman who has an abortion "misses out on the potential benefit she would have had if she had a full-term pregnancy."

Karen Malec of the Coalition on Abortion/Breast Cancer states, "Even the NCI agrees that increased childbearing, starting at an early age, protects women from breast cancer."

All women must be made aware of these facts, most especially young girls. How many times have we been told, "I didn't know...no one told me"?


