Readers ask: Which companies are still on the boycott list?

So, here is a recap of a selection of corporations being boycotted because of their support for Planned Parenthood Federation. This is taken from *Life News* articles since January 2006 and, unless otherwise noted, the source for LICL's corporate boycott information is Life Decisions International (*The Boycott List:* www.fightpp.org, 540-631-0380).

- de Altria Group is OFF the boycott list. Altria is the parent company of Phillip Morris and Kraft Food Holdings, which includes Nabisco products, Post cereals, Capri Sun, Kool-Aid, Maxwell House, Cream of Wheat, Breakstone's, Breyers, Lorna Doone, Jell-O, Polly-O, Minute Rice, Oreos, Triscuit, Oscar Mayer, Athenos, Planters, Miracle Whip, and many others.
- 3 Prudential Financial and Wal-Mart are NO LONGER on "The Boycott List."
- 3 American Girl is NO LONGER the subject of a boycott initiated by Pro-Life Action League.

If you participated in any of these boycotts then you contributed, along with many other pro-lifers, to these successful efforts. KUDOS TO YOU!

- Whole Foods, Golub (Price Chopper supermarkets), and Blimpie REMAIN ON "The Boycott List."
- P Nike, Tommy Hilfiger, Levi Strauss, Circuit City, Adobe (software), and Johnson & Johnson are STILL being boycotted.
- Unilever CONTINUES to be boycotted products include Q-Tips, Lipton, Birds Eye, Country Crock, Wish-Bone, Ben & Jerry's, Breyers, Good Humor, Finesse, Suave.
- The most recent company we asked you to BOYCOTT is George Weston, owner of Entenmann's as well as Boboli, Thomas', Arnold, Brownberry, Dutch Country, Freihofer's, and Stroehmann. If you haven't yet mailed the postcard that was in April Life News please do so today or write a short note to Mr. John Cowles, President, George Weston Bakeries, PO Box 976, Horsham PA 19044. Many of us who have sent a postcard have yet to get a response, so ask for a reply, and if you get one, please forward that to the LICL. Besides the bakery business, George Weston, based in Canada, also operates supermarkets, including Zehrs, Loblaws, and Dominion. According to LDI's boycott guidelines, if any part of a corporation donates to any Planned Parenthood Federation affiliate, the whole company is subject to a boycott because the corporate heads set the rules for all subsidiaries, franchises, etc. Keep up the pressure. Please ask your friends to join the Entenmann's boycott and let Entenmann's know.

According to LDI, to date, at least 149 corporations have ceased funding Planned Parenthood. HELP DEFUND PLANNED PARENTHOOD FEDERATION - JOIN A BOYCOTT.

On 4/19/07, one day after the U.S. Supreme Court's 5-4 decision found the ban on PBA constitutional, some member of Congress

reintroduced the Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA).



In the 6/07 issue of the Knights of Columbus magazine, Columbia, appears an article by Nancy Valko. Nancy a

nurse and mother of four children, one a Down syndrome was alerted to the fate of a Down baby publicly known as Baby Doe of Bloomington, Ind. Baby Doe's parents refused to allow a routine operation to fix his food pipe which resulted in the death of their baby after a

week without food and water. Unlike a convicted murderer appealing a death sentence, Baby Doe was not even allowed a simple IV to sustain him while his case was being appealed. Since the Bloomington case in 1982, many advances have taken place in treating babies with Down syndrome. Sad to say 85% of unborn babies diagnosed with Down syndrome are aborted. # GOV. SPITZER'S REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND PRIVACY ACT" S.5829 (Program Bill #16) is

expected to be brought up a "special legislative session" later this year. In an "E-Mail BLAST" to supporters the Governor announced this bill would "solidify the protections of Roe v. Wade into New York State Law...and ensure that New York's women have the same or stronger "reproductive rights" as those currently afforded them under Roe. (For more information see Page 12.)

# HEALTH & SCIENCE They Are Coming For The Children



If one goes to the Planned Parenthood Hudson Peconic Inc., website <a href="www.plannedparenthood.org/hudsonpeconic">www.plannedparenthood.org/hudsonpeconic</a>, he or she will find under the heading Summer Sexuality Academy-Course Descriptions, a course entitled Abstinence Unveiled: What Are We Really Talking About? The description of the course is as follows: "Here's your chance to put aside those old notions of abstinence. We'll share with you innovative lesson plans, age-appropriate strategies, and ways to make abstinence a realistic choice. This is an excellent training for all professionals and parents, especially those working with middle school students and younger!"

Now the above description of the course sounds like psychobabble. Let's examine the description in the light of our knowledge of the agenda of Planned Parenthood (PP) and what they state and promote in their literature and on their website.

The New Collegiate 7<sup>th</sup> Edition of Webster's Dictionary lists: "abstinence, n. 1.voluntary forbearance esp. from indulgence of appetite or from eating some foods, 2. habitual abstaining from intoxicating beverages." So, according to Webster, it means when it comes to sex one doesn't have any. Seems fairly obvious to the intelligent person who has common sense. PP says "put aside those old notions," PP, "has ageappropriate strategies." Do you think PP has a new definition of abstinence? If boys and girls abstain from sex then they will not get pregnant. Then PP, the leading organization providing abortion, will lose a major portion of its profits. Do you think they will allow that to happen?

Will PP make available on their website the 1975 article in the British Journal of Venereal Disease, 51, 395-7 that reported on gonorrhea of the throat at a V. D. clinic. The study came from Sweden, the home of sexual liberation (or license, or enslavement, depending on your point of view). It described 3,271 cases of gonorrhea which had infected the tonsils in 3.6 % of the men and in 5.8 % of the women. Orogenital intercourse was admitted by 34 % of the men and by 33% of the women. Does anyone wonder if any of the professionals or parents who will attend the "Summer Sexuality Academy" will ask if there are any bad consequences if orogenital intercourse is offered as one of the "strategies" taught at the "Academy?" What should matter to any right thinking and caring person, especially a parent, is what does PP mean by "younger,"-the last word in their course description.

On the same website, PP offers Parent/Child Communication Programs. The listing states: "Our goal is to support parents and caregivers in their role as the primary sexuality educators of their children." Parent programs include: Talking to Our Little Ones (newborn to age 5), Getting Ready for Adolescence (age 8-12), and Facilitating Communication with Your Teen (age 13-18).

"Talking to Our little Ones"? Has any parent, from the beginning of time, ever talked to a newborn baby girl or boy about its sexuality? If a parent did, what did the newborn say in response? Did the one year old or the two year old, etc. communicate its perceptions of sexuality with the parent?

At this point we need to be reminded that resources for parents and professionals are available from many pro-family, value-based organizations, e.g., The Catholic Medical Association (C.M.A.), which in a 90 page report, "To Protect and To Prevent," states: "The practice of modesty and privacy sets the tone for respecting the dignity of the human body, respecting properly bodily boundaries, regulating appropriate interaction with others and aids in the development of 'self-mastery.' If children and young people see that their legitimate privacy is respected, they will know that they are expected to show the same attitude toward others." [p. 34]

The last section in the PP program is something every parent and teacher is acutely aware of: Communication with the Teenager. However, PP and some schools are a perfect fit here because they promote "values clarification" which is focused on emotions (feelings) rather than the intellect. C.M.A. points out "Adolescents need their parents' attention, direction, correction, affirmation, admiration and their authoritative vigilance in keeping them on a healthy moral path... Postponement of dating until late adolescence avoids emotional heartaches from broken relationships, the potential transgressions of intrinsic moral laws, and the danger of date-rape. Without the pressure of romantic involvement, adolescents can continue to develop, relationally and emotionally, within healthy friendships under the protection of their families..." [p. 48]

Fortunately, in Nassau and Suffolk, we have the antidote to PP--namely the Life Center of Long Island. Because of a federal grant, the Life Center has presented its "Healthy Respect" abstinence until marriage message to 1,200 middle and high school students. According to the March 2007 New York Times/CBS News poll on abortion 64% of Americans believe abortion should either not be permitted at all or have stricter limits than it does now. That number jumps to 70% among younger Americans (ages 18 to 29).





#### NATIONAL MEMORIAL FOR THE UNBORN





The National Memorial for the unborn is located in Chattanooga, Tennessee. It is dedicated to healing generations of pain associated with the loss of aborted children. It was built on a site where 35,000 babies died from 1975-1993 through abortion. Plaques signed by Norma McCorvey and Sandra Cano were placed on the inside



walls of the Memorial on March 23, 1997. There are more than 1800 plates on the Wall of Names (in honor of aborted babies). 
#### Answer!
