

Sears (including businesses owned by Sears which are: Kmart, Lands' End, Craftsman, and Kenmore) and Marriott Corp. (their hotels include, Marriott, Fairfield Inn, and Renaissance) are two of the latest additions to "The Boycott List" published by Life Decisions International (www.fightpp.org, 540-631-0380). According to the July 2007 edition (the most recent) Sears and Marriott have been added to "The Boycott List" because they have donated to the Planned Parenthood corporation. Among other businesses new to the list are: eBay, Cold Stone Creamery, National Amusements, Outback Steakhouse, and Texaco (Chevron Corp.).

As mentioned in a previous edition of Life News, Entenmanns (George Weston Products) is no longer on The Boycott List. Also removed from the list are Circuit City and Unilever (with its long list of products such as Q-Tips, Lipton, Birds Eye, Wish-Bone, Breyers, Good Humor, Suave).

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

HELP IS NEEDED TO DEFEAT

Governor Spitzer's "Reproductive

Health and Privacy Protection Act" (RHAPP) S.5829. Although little has been done in the NYS Legislature since June, behind the scenes powerful and well funded pro-abortion organizations such as Planned Parenthood, NARAL, etc. are supporting Gov. Spitzer's bill using their websites and mailings. Because passage of this bill is a top priority of our governor and anti-life groups it is essential our legislators hear from the very many who oppose this bill. NOW IS THE TIME TO MAKE OUR VOICES HEARD! Educate friends and neighbors. One phone call or letter will not be enough to defeat this bill. If enacted this bill would, among other things, ensure that abortions are legal throughout all nine months of pregnancy, allow post-viability abortions to be performed on an out-patient basis in clinics, and could eliminate conscience protection of religious hospitals which refuse to perform abortions. The bill would make abortion a "fundamental right" thereby, regardless of future U.S. Supreme Court decisions, guarantee any woman in NYS an abortion, for whatever reason or no reason at all, at any time during her nine months of pregnancy. Any hint of objection could be labeled "discrimination" and dealt with accordingly. This extreme measure would prevent you, an elected official, from enacting any restriction on abortion. HEALTH & SCIENCE NEW BREAKTHROUGH IN STEM CELL RESEARCH



In mid-November, research teams from the US and Japan announced that they were able to create stem cells that are the equivalent of embryonic stem cells using ordinary human skin cells. The process involves reprogramming the skin cells so that they return to a pluripotent state. When cells are in a pluripotent state, they can develop into many other types of tissue. These new cells are called "induced Pluripotent Stem cells" (iPS cells). This past summer, the process was reported using mice. Both groups were then in a 'scientific race' to prove that it could be done with human cells.

The Japanese team took skin cells from the face of a 36 year-old woman and connective tissue from a 69 year-old man and induced them to become pluripotent. The resulting cells were able to produce muscle, gut, cartilage, neurons and heart cells. Four genes are inserted into the adult cells, which reprograms the cell so that it forms into an embryonic-like stem cell. However, one of the genes used by the Japanese research group was an oncogene - one that is associated with cancer. The process can disrupt the DNA of the skin cells and can create the potential for cancer development. Researchers are already working on ways around this problem. The DNA disruption is "just a byproduct of the technique." In fact, Dr. Yamanaka, the head of the Japanese research team, announced that he can produce iPS cells without the cancer gene. The American research group avoided using the cancerous gene. However, Wesley J. Smith writes, "viruses are currently used to introduce the genes to reprogramme the cells and can in theory disrupt other genes."

Recently, scientists at MIT were able to successfully treat sickle cell anemia in mice using iPS cells. James Thomson, head of the American research group at University of Wisconsin-Madison was not surprised at how fast the discovery progressed. He said the technique "is so simple that thousands of labs in the United States can do this, basically tomorrow."

Dr. Robert Lanza of Advanced Cell Technology stated, "This work represents a tremendous scientific milestone, the biological equivalent of the Wright Brothers' first airplane." Rev. Thomas Berg of the Westchester Institute said, "It's a win-win for everyone involved. We have a way to move forward which... brings the kind of painful national debate over this controversial research to very much a peaceful and promising resolution." Ethicist Leon Kass told the *National*

Review that the breakthrough is "an enormously significant achievement, one that boosters of medical progress and defenders of human dignity can celebrate without qualification."

Thomson and other scientists, however, say that embryonic stem cell research must continue. They want to compare the embryonic stem cells to the induced pluripotent stem cells to observe behavior and potential, especially regarding genetic diseases and drug treatments. Dr. George Daley of the Harvard Institute will continue with both strategies to "see, ultimately, which one works and which one is more practical."

Dr. John Shea cautions that we must be sure that the reprogrammed cells remain merely stem cells and do not become embryos. Daniel Kuebler wrote in the *National Catholic Register*, "The problem is that many researchers have staked their lives and reputations on the success of embryo-destructive research, and simply expecting all of them to pack up shop when alternative sources of embryonic stem cells arrive is a bit naïve. After years of working on a project they have fought tooth and nail to mainstream, many are convinced that we still need to proceed down both paths."

Michael Gerson stated in his column in the Wash-ington Post on 11/23/07: "A number of companies have a financial stake in embryonic research, and their stocks fell on the news. Others have an emotional investment in embryonic research because of a conviction that humanity should have unrestricted technological control over its reproductive and genetic future... But as CS Lewis said, 'Man's power over Nature turns out to be a power exercised by some men over other men with Nature as its instrument... Each new power won by man is a power over man as well.' Now science has demonstrated an even greater power — the power of morally responsible technology to serve the cause of human dignity instead of undermining it."

Wesley J Smith commented on November 23, "Unfettered science, that is science unbounded by ethics and proper moral parameters, can grow monstrous. But science in the service of the intrinsic value of human life, now that can lift the whole human race."




