HEALTH & SCIENCE Human Embryonic Stem Cell Experimentation



The Life Advocacy Briefing dated 4/14/08 reported that advisors to the FDA met in early April to begin designing human experiments using human embryonic stem cells. According to Aaron Smith of CNNMoney.com, these experiments would be the first experiments in the US using human subjects and could start "as early as this year."

Mr. Smith reported that Laurie Zoloth, professor of medical humanities and bioethics at Northwestern University, stated this "is the first step towards clinical trials. It's an important moment, and it's only the very beginning."

Senator Sam Brownback responded in a news release, "Human beings are not guinea pigs." He was "deeply concerned that the FDA is discussing procedures for conducting experiments on humans with embryonic stem cells." He referred to a March 2001 New York Times report of "devastating patient results from human experiments using fetal tissue cells. The problem was the cells were too immature and tended to form tumors or grow in uncontrolled ways that could not be reversed in the humans who underwent experimentation. I am astonished that the FDA is proceeding with human experimentation again, with even younger human cells that have shown an even greater propensity to form tumors. At best this is irresponsible. At worst, this is criminal."

Life Advocacy Briefing noted the coincidence in the timing of the FDA meetings. On April 6, New York Times reporters Gardiner Harris and Alex Berenson ran a story concerning the involvement of the FDA in a drug litigation case. Their story quoted Janet Abaray, attorney for the plaintiff. She stated that the drug company involved took "advantage of an agency overwhelmed by its many responsibilities. [The drug company] knew that the FDA does not have the funding or the manpower to police drug companies."

Harris and Berenson continued, "A series of independent assessments have concluded that the agency is poorly organized, scientifically deficient and short of money. In February, its commissioner Andrew C. von Eschenback acknowledged that the agency faces a crisis and may not be 'adequate to regulate the food and drugs of the 21st century.' The FDA does not test experimental medicines, but relies on drug makers to report the results of their own tests completely and honestly. Even when companies fail to follow agency rules,

officials rarely seek to penalize them. 'These are scientists, not cops,' said David Vladeck, a professor at Georgetown Law School."

Senator Brownback continued in his press release, "What makes this even more troubling is that there is a viable ethical alternative with adult stem cells that are currently being used in the treatment of well over 70 different diseases and conditions, including spinal cord injury, type-I diabetes, heart failure and Parkinson's disease, as validated by peer-reviewed, published results."

According to *Life Advocacy Briefing*, Aaron Smith of <u>CNNMoney.com</u> reported that biotech firms are "lining up to dive into human trials of embryosacrificing therapies." Mr. Smith reported that California-based "Geron could be the first company to conduct experiments in humans with drugs made from human embryonic stem cells. Geron has already filed an application to the FDA to begin human testing, according to analysts. [Geron] refused to confirm this and would not discuss" the FDA advisory meeting. An analyst for the financial advisory firm UBS told Mr. Smith he "believes Geron could begin human testing by mid-2008."

Smith reported that Robert Lanza, chief scientific officer for Advanced Cell Technology (ACT), stated that his company "plans to file an application for human testing to the FDA within months." *Life Advocacy Briefing* reported that ACT, "whose principal laboratory is in Massachusetts, is using cells harvested from embryonic human beings to develop a treatment for vision loss."

The <u>CNNMoney.com</u> report further stated that Neuralstem, a company focused on treating Lou Gehrig's disease, uses stem cells harvested from fetal humans rather than embryonic stem cells. According to Mr. Smith, Neuralstem "plans to file an application for human testing to the FDA in September or October."

In the <u>CNNMoney.com</u> report, Professor Zoloth stated, "the human embryo does not have the moral status of a dying child...You might say that we stand in a remarkable moment in human history."

Life Advocacy Briefing responded, "The embarkation of the government of the most powerful country in the world on the brave new world of subjecting human beings to experimentation which requires the ruthless sacrifice of embryonic fellow humans is indeed a 'remarkable moment in human history'; in fact, one must wonder whether it might be one of the last moments of human history."



LICL Greet & Teach at Planned Parenthood of Nassau County's Annual Gala




