#### FEDERAL LEGISLATION

### **HEALTH & SCIENCE** The Slippery Slope – Viewing Children as a Commodity



On November 26, 2008, LifeSiteNews.com carried a report by Hilary White that a Belgian couple faced possible jail time for selling their newborn child on eBay and registering the child with an assumed name. The couple is under investigation for offering their second child on eBay to a Dutch couple for a "decent five figure sum". They were experiencing money problems. The child was "handed over to a couple from the Netherlands in the hospital parking lot shortly after he was born in July."

In May of this year, the Vancouver, British Columbia police were called when an online ad offered a baby girl for sale for Cn. \$10,000. The ad read, "Must have!!!! \$10,000, a new baby girl, healthy and very cute. Can't afford and unexpected, Looking for a good home, Please call ASAP" followed by a cell phone number. The Salt Lake City police initiated a search for a baby girl this past March after an advertisement appeared on a local online classified listing under "Baby & Children Items". The girl was listed for sale for \$6,560.

The Dutch government announced in mid-November that there were no reports of infant euthanasia in 2007, the first year of legalization of the practice. However, prolifers warn that these figures do not include children who may have been intentionally killed by dehydration, which is not technically labeled 'euthanasia'. "A 1997 study in the Lancet reported that approximately 8% of the infants who died in the Netherlands in 1995 (about 80 babies) were euthanized by doctors - some without the consent of the parents." The November 2008 announcement most likely was only taking into account those children killed by lethal injection. Alex Schadenberg of Canada's Euthanasia Prevention Coalition stated that because the children were most likely killed passively (dehydration) rather than actively (lethal injection), they were not counted in the euthanasia reports. He noted that past reports failed to take into account deaths "procured by leaving a patient to die of hunger and thirst, usually after having been deeply sedated, and sometimes without explicit consent." (LifeSiteNews.com, 11/18/08)

Bill Muehlenberg wrote an article for MercatorNet.com dated 11/19/08, "Towards a coercive utopia". The article discussed the theories of Oxford professor Julian Savulescu, who studied under the notorious Peter Singer. Savulescu's recent article, "Breeding Perfect Babies" supports genetic engineering and designer babies. He argues, "We have a moral obligation to select the embryo with the best chance of the best life." The new developments in testing for genetic diseases make it possible for parents to "pick and choose the characteristics they want for their baby." Karyomapping can test for muscular dystrophy, cystic fibrosis and Huntington's disease. It can also be used for testing for the risk of developing heart disease, cancer, diabetes and Alzheimer's in later life.

Savulescu recommends taking the screening much further. "We should want our children to begin life with the best genetic start. People worry that this is a slide down a slope to creating designer babies, to testing for eye colour, height, mental and physical abilities. But we should embrace the selection of such non-disease traits, if they contribute to a child having a better chance of a better life. Why wouldn't we choose an embryo which will grow into a better ability at math or music. Indeed, we should give our children the greatest range of gifts possible ... People worry that this is like the Nazis weeding out the weak and inferior. Or that it will result in a two tiered society of the genetically privileged and the genetically underprivileged...But these fears are misplaced provided we focus on testing for genes that make our children's lives go predictably better. Nature has no mind to fairness or equality. Some people are born with horribly short genetic straws. Enabling couples to choose the best of the embryos will reduce natural inequality."

Muchlenberg refers to Australian ethicist Anthony Fisher who recommends that scientists focus on curing diseases rather than eliminating people with the condition. Muchlenberg states, "Genetic screening can easily lead to selective breeding and selective abortion. It can easily lead to a return to eugenics. As we increasingly lose our understanding of what it is to be human, and what is really important in life, we increasingly look to play God, either to extend our own physical lives, or that of our offspring. But there are right ways and wrong ways of doing this. Denying God, and/or seeking to take his place is not the right way to proceed."

The 11/26/08 LifeSiteNews.com article by Hilary White acknowledged that pro-lifers have been warning for decades that legalized abortion has caused "a cultural shift in western countries from the idea of a child as a gift from God to that of the child as either an insupportable financial burden or a luxury commodity that can be purchased or sold, or, as in the case of artificial reproductive technologies, made to order." Then-Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger warned in the 1986 document Donum Vitae (the Gift of Life) that the artificial reproductive technologies industry created a situation in which human beings could be bought and sold - "artificial procreation was a set of procedures characterized by a 'dynamic of violence and domination....The abortion-mentality which has made this procedure possible...leads, whether one wants it or not, to man's domination over the life and death of his fellow human beings and can lead to a system of radical eugenics... The child is not an object to which one has a right, nor can he be considered as an object of ownership: rather, a child is a gift, 'the supreme gift.'"
