BOYCOTT UPDATE

Life Decisions International (LDI) publishes *The Boycott List* - a compilation of corporations that LDI has determined are funding Planned Parenthood Federation of America at some level. LDI's June 2009 updated lists shows that some companies have been dropped since the December list, new ones added, and as usual, some are still lingering on the list as they continue to support the Culture of Death. Qualcomm Inc., added in December 2008, is off the latest list. It took longer for Valero Energy Corp. and Mutual of America, but these companies have also been removed from *The Boycott List*.

The following groups are on the list because, according to LDI, they are "publicly on record as a pro-abortion group:" Amnesty International, Audubon Society, Girls Inc., Human Rights Watch, League of Women Voters, National Education Association (NEA), Sierra Club, and Young Women's Christian Association (YWCA). The Dishonorable Mention list is on LDI's website.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION 2009 HEALTH CARE REFORM (Con't.)

On 9/08/09 Congress reconvenes. Their first objective is the overhaul of the one trillion dollar health care system.

Versions of health care reform legislation have drawn national attention as they seek to respond to many of our country's health needs. Of major concern to pro-life advocates is any inclusion of abortion, abortion funding, euthanasia and funding of technologies that destroy human life.

The following two paragraphs are adapted from an article by Dr. John Willke in *Life Institutes Inc.* 8/2008:

President Barack Obama before being elected stated: "In my mind reproductive care [abortion] is essential care, basic care, so it is at the center, the heart of the plan I propose". This would ultimately require workers, employers and all taxpayers to fund abortion on demand through universal "health" abortion coverage.

This new bill would create a Medical Advisory Board which will make all decisions. In charge would be the progressive pro-abortion Secretary of Health and Human Services, Kathleen Sebelius. She would have the authority to impose any and all such regulations she feels would improve the health of our nation.

ACTION-SAMPLE MESSAGE:

Dear

You are urged to oppose any health care reform unless abortion, euthanasia and funding of technologies that destroy human life are explicitly excluded. The language of this legislation must be specific and terms such as "medical procedure" and/or "clinical practices" must be defined and eliminated if these would allow abortion. Pro Death Forces Strike

Administrators at Mount Sinai Hospital in New York City coerced a senior nurse, Catherine Cenzon-DeCarlo, to assist at an "emergency" late term abortion on 5/24/09 (murder) despite their knowledge that nurse Cenzon-DeCarlo has religious objections to it.

When Cathy Cenzon-DeCarlo was hired by Mount Sinai Hospital in 2004 she advised them that her conscience would object to assisting at an abortion. This did not stop Mount Sinai's insisting that she assist at the abortion or she would face disciplinary action which could lead to her dismissal and possible lose of her nurse's license.

The mother of the aborted baby did not have a life threatening condition. A lawsuit on the nurse's behalf was filed in New York by the pro-life Alliance Defense Fund on 7/21/09.

Abortion opponents say those restrictions should carry over to any health insurance sold through a new marketplace envisioned under the legislation, an exchange in which people would choose private coverage or the public plan.

Abortion rights supporters say that would have the effect of denying coverage for abortion to millions of women who now have it through workplace insurance and are expected to join the exchange.

Advocates on both sides are preparing for a renewed battle over abortion, which could jeopardize political support for President Barack Obama's health care initiative aimed at covering nearly 50 million uninsured and restraining medical costs. The dispute could come to a head with House and Senate floor votes on abortion this fall, a prospect that many lawmakers would like to avoid.

"We want to see people who have no health insurance get it, but this a sticking point," said Richard Doerflinger, associate director of pro-life activities for the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops. "We don't want health care reform to be the vehicle for mandating abortion." The church can't accept a public plan that covers abortion, he said.

HEALTH & SCIENCE Autism – MMR Vaccine – Aborted Human Fetal Cells Part II of II



Concluded from the August issue of Life News.

Another issue of concern...is the issue of informed consent...There is no law guaranteeing full disclosure about the use of aborted fetal cell lines to produce our vaccines and other medicines. Perhaps even more egregious, there is no law requiring full disclosure about the presence of contaminating aborted fetal DNA in those drugs and vaccines...

The safety of injecting our children with aborted human fetal DNA has been debated for over 40 years, but has never been studied. Safety concerns...include 1) the potential for subsequent autoimmune disease triggered by our children's immune system recognizing the contaminating DNA and generating antibodies that will also recognize their own similar DNA, and 2) the potential for insertion of the DNA into our children's own genome. The FDA's concerns...have focused on oncogenesis, or tumor formation. Concerns about the potential for residual contaminating DNA to insert into our own genome and thus disrupt the function of tumor suppressor genes has been demonstrated in the laboratory and also in humans...

Random DNA insertion into a recipient's genes occurs by a process called homologous recombination. Laboratory studies have shown that this process occurs spontaneously only within a species. What that means is that naked, unaltered chicken DNA does not insert into a human genome and vice versa. However, naked, unaltered same species DNA rapidly crosses a cell's membranes to enter the nucleus and insert into the genome. The insertion is not a random process, but has been shown to occur at sites in our genes called 'hot spots'... insertion of extraneous DNA into a long-lived human cell such as a heart or a brain cell could have life-long consequences...

What has been ignored is the fact that this new MMR vaccine introduced the use of aborted fetal cells for vaccine production. At one point as many as 94% of US children and 98% of UK children were given this vaccine. It is unconscionable that the public health risk of injecting our children with residual contaminating human aborted fetal DNA has been ignored...I can only suggest that the refusal to carefully investigate the consequences of contaminating human fetal DNA may be related to a resistance, particularly prevalent amongst highly secular professions such as biomedical science, to anything that might question abortion...

Preliminary bioinformatics research conducted at Sound Choice Pharmaceutical Institute indicates that 'hot spots' for DNA insertion are found in eight autism-associated genes present on the X chromosome. These eight genes are involved in nerve cell synapse formation, central nervous system development and mitochondrial function. Could genomic insertion of the aborted fetal DNA, found in some of our childhood vaccines since 1979, be an environmental trigger for autism? Could the fact that genes critical for nerve synapse formation and nervous system development are found on the X chromosome provide some explanation of why autism is predominantly a disease of boys? Could the 'hot spots' identified in these autismassociated genes be sites for insertion of contaminating aborted fetal DNA? These questions must be answered. With over 1 out of every 100 children now diagnosed with autism or autism spectrum disorder, it is unconscionable that we would not investigate this."

Washington – Health care legislation before Congress would allow a new government-sponsored insurance plan to cover abortions, a decision that would affect millions of women and recast federal policy on the divisive issue.

Federal funds for abortions are now restricted to cases involving rape, incest or danger to the life of the mother.
