

Staunchly pro-life NY Archbishop Timothy Dolan was elected the president of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, November 16, 2010. Archbishop Dolan has taken prominent Catholic politicians such as House Speaker Nancy Pelosi and Vice

President Joe Biden to task for their pro-abortion views and misrepresentation of Church teaching. The USCCB president is the voice of the U.S. Catholic bishops and Archbishop Dolan will be a strong advocate for LIFE.

## BEWARE THE PLANNED PARENTHOOD ORGANIZATION

Planned Parenthood (PP) is the largest provider of abortion in America. By their own statistics they admit to having performed 305,310 surgical abortions in the U.S. in the year 2007. This figure does not reflect the number of chemical abortions from contraceptives that are abortifacients which PP dispenses. See related

article in Health & Science on Page 4. PP staffers have been caught on undercover videotape lying to women about the development of their unborn child, even denying that a 10-week old unborn baby has a heartbeat. They have also been caught on undercover video breaking the law by counseling underage girls in such a way as to cover up potential cases of sexual abuse. Silence never helps the victim, only the oppressor. Many PP clinics do not perform surgical abortions but are only too happy to refer women to their facilities that do. PP is often invited into "health" classes in our schools and host "training" sessions at their facilities for students and educators with the purpose of supposedly educating young people about "safe sex" to stem the tide of STDs and teen pregnancies. In actuality the programs, brochures and books they promote encourage young people to be sexually active outside of marriage and when their contraceptives fail they provide the abortion.

PP is on the forefront in opposing Parental Notification laws and Informed Consent laws because these would interfere with their primary business, abortion. Cecile Richards, President of PP, who has an annual salary of \$400,000 (American taxpayers fork over \$400 million every year to PP) has stated on a radio program that the lower the number of people born the more money the government will save so the Obama administration should label birth control 'preventative care" and invest millions more of taxpayer money with PP which she says will save money in the long run. But, one must ask the question, "What have we lost in children not born?"

## FEDERAL LEGISLATION

With the beginning of the 112<sup>th</sup> Congress, all legislation not enacted by the previous Congress has expired, and must be re-introduced if it is going to be considered by the new Congress. (Any recycled bills will be

assigned new numbers). The GOP is now in control of the House of Representatives, so bills that previously languished in committee are expected to see action in the House. The Susan B. Anthony list highlights two such pro-life bills:

The "<u>Title X Abortion Provider Prohibition Act</u>," sponsored by Rep. Mike Pence (R-IN), would stop Federal 'Title X' family planning dollars from going to abortion providers, like Planned Parenthood. This bill, known in the prior Congress as HR 614, sat in the Health Subcommittee since 1/22/2009. No NY representatives were among the 103 cosponsors.

The "No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act", sponsored by Reps. Chris Smith (R-NJ) and Dan Lipinski (D-IL), would prohibit funding of abortion by any and all Federal agencies or programs. Known in the previous Congress as HR 5939, it had 183 cosponsors, including Rep. P. King (R-NY). Because of its broad coverage, it had been referred to the Committees on the Judiciary, Energy & Commerce, and Ways & Means.

Similar to HR 5939, but more narrowly focused, was HR 5111, an amendment to prohibit abortion funding under any aspect of ObamaCare. Introduced by Rep. J. Pitts (R-PA) it too died in the Energy & Commerce Committee.

U.S. SUPREME COURT JUSTICE ANTONIN SCALIA, speaking at the U of Richmond in VA, (11/19/10), confirmed again his view that the Constitution contains no so-called abortion rights. He said anyone who claims the 14th Amendment's 'due process clause' includes abortion, ignores the fact that abortion "was criminal in all the states" when the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment was ratified.

# NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

REPUBLICANS REGAIN SENATE.

On 12/4/2010 a Nassau County judge certified Jack Martins victory in Nassau's 7<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District race by a 451-vote margin. *Newsday*, 12/5, stated: "Barring a successful appeal by Johnson [Martins Democratic opponent], when the Senate reconvenes on Jan. 5, Republicans will have a 32-30 majority." The *Daily News*, 12/4, stated: "....Long Island GOPer Jack Martins wins in recount." This win, and the victory by Republican Lee Zeldin in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Senatorial District in Suffolk, were critical. N.Y. State's 2011-2012 Session begins on 1/5/2011 with a Republican controlled Senate while most statewide offices and the Assembly are dominated by Democrats.

Martins won by 451 votes in a race where 85,000 ballots were cast. Once again, highlighting the importance of getting out each and every pro-life vote.

## **HEALTH & SCIENCE**

#### Methods of Abortion

There are three classes of abortion: surgical, medical and chemical.

**Surgical abortions** involve an invasive procedure. These include:

Suction aspiration - usually done in the first trimester. A suction tube (like a vacuum hose with a sharp end) is inserted in the womb. The cutting edge dismembers the baby and the vacuum pulls the body parts out to be collected.

Dilation and curettage (D & C) - A loop-shaped knife is used to dismember the baby and scrape the uterine wall. The body parts must be counted to be sure that no pieces were left in the womb.

Dilation and extraction (D & X - partial birth abortion) This method is used late in the pregnancy. The abortionist extends a forceps into the womb to grab the child's feet. The child is pulled out of the mother, except for the head. Scissors are used to pierce the child's head. A suction tube is used to remove the brain. Forceps are used to crush the skull before pulling the baby fully out of the mother.

Dilation and evacuation (D & E) - This method is used in the second trimester (24+ weeks). Forceps are used to grab the arms and legs of the child and tear them away. The head must be crushed before removing it from the womb. Hysterotomy - This method is used in the third trimester. It is basically a Cesarean section (C-section). An incision is made in the mother's abdomen and the baby is removed.

The baby is left to die or killed by the abortionist or nurse. **Medical abortions** involve the use of a drug specifically intended to abort the child. These include:

\*Mifepristone (RU-486) - This drug blocks the hormone that aids in developing the uterine lining which is essential for nourishment and protection. The child is starved to death. A second drug, misoprostol, is used to cause contractions so that the baby is expelled from the womb.

\*Methotrexate - This highly toxic drug (used in chemotherapy) attacks and breaks down the baby's fast-growing cells. It also attacks the life-support systems, causing the

baby to die. Misoprostol is used to cause contractions to expel the baby from the womb.

\*Salt poisoning - This method is used in the second or third trimester. A needle containing salt (saline) is injected into the amniotic sac. The baby dies of salt poisoning, dehydration, brain hemorrhage and convulsions. Labor occurs 24-48 hours later. The mother delivers her dead child.

\*Prostaglandins - These naturally produced hormones are injected into the amniotic sac causing violent premature labor. The child is often crushed to death during the convulsions or born too early to survive.

Complications from abortion include: increased risk of breast cancer, depression, hemorrhaging, pelvic inflammatory disease, uterine perforation, ectopic pregnancy and death. Complications in future pregnancies include excessive bleeding, premature delivery, cervical damage, placenta previa, and sterility. Chemical abortions are those caused by

drugs that can work in one of three ways:

- a) the prevention of ovulation
- b) the prevention of fertilization
- c) the prevention of implantation in the uterus. This action causes the death of a newly created child.

Some of the methods of birth control that fall into this category include:

birth control pills (oral contraceptives) birth control patches

vaginal rings

contraceptive injections (such as Depo-Provera) emergency "contraceptives" (such as Plan B, Preven, ella)

These drugs contain artificial hormones (estrogen and/or progestin) - powerful steroids. These artificial hormones suppress the woman's normal production of progesterone and estrogen. Side effects include birth defects to children conceived while on the pill, a weakened immune system that can lead to bacterial infections and increased susceptibility to HIV/AIDS, pelvic inflammatory disease (an infection of the fallopian tubes that can cause illness or sterility), infertility, cervical cancer, ectopic pregnancy, endometrial atrophy (shrinking of the womb), breast cancer, blood clots, stroke, depression and weight gain.

Gonadotropins are suppressed, which may inhibit ovulation, change the cervical mucus to prevent sperm from reaching the uterus therefore preventing fertilization, or irritate the lining of the uterus to prevent implantation, thus destroying the newly created life. Contraception is the prevention of conception or fertilization. These drugs do not always prevent fertilization, and, in fact, work at times to destroy a new life before it can attach to the lining of the uterus to continue its growth and development.

Watson Pharmaceuticals recently announced that its "emergency contraceptive," ella, will be available nationwide in pharmacies and on the Internet. Promotional materials acknowledge that it acts up to five days after intercourse. Conception can certainly occur during this time.

Wendy Wright, president of Concerned Women for America, stated that the information distributed to doctors acknowledges that "ella caused abortions in animal trials, yet the website and information for patients does not warn women of this...Questions were raised that the drug may cause birth defects, yet the FDA allowed the drug company to avoid testing for birth defects...Providing the drug through a website means that anyone can buy it any number of times. Watson has made it easy for girls of all ages, or a predatory man who is sexually abusing a girl or who wants to force an abortion on an unwilling woman, to obtain this drug. This puts women at risk from men who can slip the drug into their food or drink...Without a doctor's oversight, girls won't be tested for sexually transmitted diseases. When a woman experiences complications, the prescribing 'doctor' will be as anonymous as a drug dealer in a back alley. Clearly this will create more hazards for women." (LifeNews.com, Dec 2, 2010)

Two Photos -Two True Stories: A young man dropped his wife/girlfriend at the front door of Planned Parenthood. A pro-life sidewalk counselor nodded for the man to come over (out of the parking lot) and he did. The pro-lifer used a short video he had uploaded to his cell phone to show the young man the early development of the young lady's baby. The pro-lifer then spoke to the young man about adoption and also encouraged him to support this young lady's pregnancy because maybe she is considering abortion because she feels abandoned. The young man went into Planned Parenthood and he and the girl came out shortly thereafter. The sidewalk counselor continues to hope and pray that this baby was saved that day and the couple does not return for an abortion.

In our second story, on a recent Saturday a pro-lifer who believes "abortion will not end until people see what abortion really is" was holding the graphic photo of a child killed in a third-trimester abortion. As we packed the signs to leave a car pulled up beside us. The man stated: "I want to see that sign again." Because he had driven past all of our signs we began to show them to him one by one. He repeatedly insisted he had to see "that sign." Upon seeing the graphic sign he said, "I have five children. I never really knew abortion was like that."

Public Witness (locations above) is vital to save babies and to educate and we pray to change hearts. A new analysis by National Right to Life reported, as of Jan. 2010 52 million children have been aborted in the U.S. since the 1973 Roe V. Wade decision.

## The Boycott List: An Overview

Thank you to all of you who took the time to contact corporations and stores listed in November Life News. Were you told "Our corporation/store does not support Planned Parenthood"? The following information is provided to help explain "The Boycott List" and understanding corporate replies to the boycotts.

From time to time, the Long Island Coalition for Life updates Life News readers on companies being boycotted for their support of Planned Parenthood. The source of that information is "The Boycott List" published by Life Decisions International (540-631-0380; www.fightpp.org). "The Boycott List" is not all inclusive because LDI has not investigated every company. LDI says that all corporations listed have received information about Planned Parenthood, have been asked to stop that support, and given time to decide if they'll stop funding the abortion giant.

Here are some points about "The Boycott List." Additional information is on LDI's website.

According to LDI, "The Boycott List" includes corporations that have donated to Planned Parenthood at any level and in any amount within the past five years, but whose officials refuse to say donations will not be made in the future. What this means is that if a Kohl's store in Indiana donates to Planned Parenthood, all Kohl's stores are boycotted. If the local Nike store says it doesn't give to Planned Parenthood, that may be the case, but if national Nike has sponsored a

Planned Parenthood event then all Nike stores are boycotted.

It is the corporate headquarters of a company that allows any one of its stores to donate to a given charity. Likewise, it is the corporate office that can tell all of its stores not to donate to a specific charity. And that's what we ask of them when we write letters to the CEO asking that the company stop funding the largest abortion business in America.

If you contact a local store being boycotted and the manager says it doesn't give to Planned Parenthood, politely ask for that in writing from the corporate level. If you receive a letter from the corporate headquarters saying that it doesn't give to Planned Parenthood, send a copy of the letter to LDI (PO Box 439 Front Royal, VA 22630) so they can follow up and remove the company from "The Boycott List" if warranted. But note that many times a corporation will say it doesn't give when it really does. For example, they may pretend that each store can do what it wants and since no donations came directly from the national level, then they'll say the company doesn't have a corporate relationship with Planned Parenthood. That's not an acceptable reply.

We need to state our case clearly to the corporate heads: Planned Parenthood is in the business of tearing tiny people out of their mother's womb. A company can do better with its philanthropic dollars than supporting that business.






