FEDERAL LEGISLATION

MEDICARE & MEDICAID HEAD DR. DONALD BERWICK, *The Hill* reported 12/17/10, began a series of closed door meetings with Administration officials and

"specialty medical societies" to discuss healthcare implementation.

Back in November, Berwick issued regulations to include "voluntary advance care planning" in each patient's (Medicare authorized) yearly exam. LifeNews.com reports - "the federal government (will pay) doctors to advise patients on possible end-of-life care treatment options. The advice may include advanced directives to authorize withdrawal of lifesaving medical treatment or, in three states, assisted suicide." Rules for this advice, called "Death Panels" by some pro-lifers, had been dropped by the Democrats during the Obamacare debate.

Rep. Blumenauer, [D-OR], an assisted suicide and euthanasia advocate, had sent a memo (reported in LifeNews.com 12/5/10 and in the N.Y. Times 12/26/10) to his supporters alerting them to the upcoming Berwick regulations, but noted- "We would ask that you not broadcast this accomplishment...it seems that no press or blogs have discovered it..." Then LifeNews.com and the NY Times released the memo. The White House first replied the 2003 (Bush) Medicare Prescription Drug law authorized the same counseling, but withdrew the new rule on 1/5/2011.

PRO-LIFE LEGISLATION - As of 1/15/2011, we await the re-introduction of Reps. Smith & Lipinski's NO TAXPAYER FUNDING FOR ABORTION ACT. (Planned Parenthood reported (2008 data) that abortions increased to 324,008, referrals for adoption dropped to 2,405 and government grants totaled \$363 million.).

PRO-LIFE LEGISLATION - The TITLE X
ABORTION PROVIDER PROHIBITION ACT was reintroduced 1/7/2011 as HR 217 by Rep. Pence.

ACTION-SAMPLE MESSAGE - to your House Member: Please support HR 217, to end Title X funding for abortion.

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

OPPOSE THE REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH ACT.

This legislation contains extreme provisions which actually go far beyond Roe v Wade.

Perinatal Hospice

With the increased use of prenatal testing, more and more parents are faced with the heartbreaking news that their unborn child may have a terminal illness. Parents are increasingly being counseled to abort their child. There is, however, a more compassionate alternative—perinatal hospice.

Bill Saunders writes at LifeNews.com (4 Jan 2011, 'Give Parents Perinatal Hospice Option Instead of Abortion'), "With perinatal hospice, families are given the gift of time to truly cherish the life of the child and allow him or her to be a part of their family, even if it is for a short time. Unfortunately, most couples are not presented the option of perinatal hospice and opt instead to terminate the pregnancy; only 20% of these couples opt to bring the pregnancy to term. These parents are often pressured to make the decision quickly in light of the complications surrounding late term abortions. Yet the statistics show that parents who choose abortion because of a prenatal diagnosis have great regret. The intensity of their grief is so great that it can cause psychological harm. This doesn't have to be the case; perinatal hospice is a nurturing option for both the child and the family. When given the option, 80% of these parents choose perinatal. These programs support the family emotionally and give them the tools to say goodbye to their baby. This is in stark contrast to the abrupt separation that occurs when a pregnancy is terminated. Perinatal hospice gives the family time to hold the newborn, and to collect photos and mementos to remember him by. These little treasures can be a beautiful gift during the time of bereavement that follows the child's passing. And the gift of time is invaluable."

The FAQ section of the website www.perinatalhospice.org contains valuable information for parents, family members, friends and medical personnel. It states, "For parents who receive a life-limiting prenatal diagnosis and wish to continue their pregnancies, perinatal palliative care helps them embrace whatever life their baby may have, before and after birth. This support begins at the time of diagnosis, not just after the baby is born. It can be thought of as 'hospice in the womb' (including birth planning and preliminary medical decision-making before the baby is born) as well as more traditional hospice and palliative care at home after birth (if the baby lives longer than a few minutes or hours). Palliative care can also include medical treatments intended to improve the baby's life. This approach supports families through the rest of the pregnancy, through decision-making before and after birth, and through their grief. Perinatal hospice also enables families to make meaningful plans for the baby's life, birth, and death, honoring the baby as well as the baby's family. Perinatal hospice is not a place. It is more a frame of mind. It can be easily incorporated into standard pregnancy and birth care. Ideally it is a comprehensive team approach that includes obstetricians, perinatologists, labor and delivery nurses, neonatologists, NICU staff, chaplains/ pastors and social workers (Hoeldtke & Calhoun 2001, Calhoun et al 2003), as well as genetic counselors, midwives, therapists and traditional hospice professionals. Perinatal hospice is a beautiful and practical response to one of the most heartbreaking challenges of prenatal testing."

There is a link on the perinatalhospice org FAQ page to perinatal hospice programs by state, and it encourages readers to print their material and give it to caregivers who are not familiar with the program. There are resources for both parents and caregivers. A new book, A Gift of Time was released January 2011, and is available in hardcover, paperback and as an e-book.

Saunders reported on *LifeNews.com* that currently only the state of Minnesota requires that parents be made aware of the option of perinatal hospice "when they are given the tragic news of their unborn child's fatal anomalies...Americans United for Life just drafted the Perinatal Hospice Information Act Model Legislation & Policy Guide to be used as a prototype for state legislators who wish to ensure that families are aware of the support that is available when they find themselves in this tragic situation."






