More than 7200 Babies Lost to Abortion on Long Island in 2009

Nassau/Suffolk (Combined) 2009 Induced Abortions

According to the NY State Department of Health, reported induced abortions for 2009 in Nassau and Suffolk totaled just slightly more than 7200. Many people are still under the delusion that abortion is rare and mostly

New Indiana Law Update

Two new pro-life Bills (HBA.1210 and HBA.1474) were scheduled to go into effect in Indiana on 7/1/11. Unfortunately, a Federal Judge has Stayed the following two provisions of HBA.1210: the de-funding of abortion providers and requiring women be informed of their unborn child's ability to feel pain.

Provisions of the new bills which remain in force include: women be told that life begins at fertilization; that abortion increases infertility risk; women to be informed of Indiana's 'Safe Haven' laws; abortions on girls under 14 must be reported to Child Protective Services within three days; increased protection for Pain -Capable unborn of 20-weeks or more gestation; doctors doing abortions must provide license number and have local hospital admitting privileges; and, Indiana will opt -out of abortion coverage in any state health exchange required under ObamaCare.

Only the No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act HR. 3, awaits action by the full Senate. [Cong. Peter King is a cosponsor.] An HR.3 companion, HR.1232, awaits action by the full House. HR.3's Senate companion, <u>S.906</u>, sits

in a Senate committee.

Still waiting in various committees are: HR.1179, to add Conscience Protection to ObamaCare; HR.217, to forbid giving Title X Family Planning money to abortion providers; HR.361 (and its companion, S.165), to put Conscience Protections into the Public Health Service Act; HR.452, to eliminate the Independent Payment Advisory Board in ObamaCare; and, HR.358, (companion S.877) the *Protect Life Act*, which bars abortion funding by ObamaCare.

Anti-Life Bills in committee are: HR.1319, the Global Sexual and Reproductive Health Act of 2011; HR.1724, Compassionate Assistance for Rape Emergencies Act of 2011 (emergency contraceptives): and, HR.2085, and its companion, S.1214, (sponsored by Sen. The Roe v. Wade Decision: Flawed Reasoning

The Supreme Court used flawed reasoning to support its majority opinion in Roe v. Wade (Jan. 1973). Many legal scholars, including some who are personally pro-choice, have written that the constitutional reasoning in Roe v. Wade, and its companion decision Doe v. Bolton, are deeply flawed. As an example, consider the words of constitutional scholar John Hart Ely, professor at Harvard, Yale, and Stanford Law schools who said Roe "is not constitutional and gives almost no sense of an obligation to try to be."

Flawed reasoning number one. Roe's failure to establish a fundamental fact: When does human life begin? In his majority opinion Justice Blackmun says, "We need not resolve the difficult question of when life begins. When those trained in the respective disciplines of medicine, philosophy and theology are unable to arrive at any consensus, the judiciary at this point in development of man's knowledge is not in a position to speculate as to the answer." Even in 1973 embryological textbooks said human life begins when the sperm unites with the ovum to form a single-cell zygote. But if Blackmun is saying the court is agnostic on the question of when a human life begins, then it should have remained silent on the abortion question. But by legalizing abortion and striking down state laws restricting abortion, the court acted as if it were certain the fetus was not a human being with a right to life. Blackmun's statement is false humility designed to make the majority opinion seem more reasonable even while giving the fetus ZERO moral weight through all nine months of pregnancy. In spite of Blackmun's saying that the government may prohibit abortion in the third trimester unless the mother's life or health is threatened, the Supreme Court's decision in Doe v. Bolton handed down the same day as Roe v. Wade, defines health so broadly to include "physical, emotional, psychological, familial, woman's age" that, although not common, a woman can get a third trimester abortion for very minor reasons. A macabre irony – the abortionist certifies the health reason.

The second major flaw in Roe v. Wade is that there is no generalized, undefined right to privacy in the U.S. Constitution as Roe v. Wade claims. The majority decision claimed the right to privacy is encompassed in the word liberty in the due process clause of the 14th amendment. But the first question that must be asked about the word privacy is "the privacy to do what"? You cannot abuse your children in Long Island Coalition for Life

your home or use hard drugs in your bedroom and argue that this general right to privacy in the 14th amendment protects your actions. There are specific guarantees of privacy like the 4th amendment protection against unreasonable searches and seizures, but there is no amorphous, generalized undefined right to privacy that the Court based its Roe v. Wade decision on.

The third flaw is that the opinion is a purely results -driven jurisprudence. If you read the memoranda among Justice Blackmun, Brennan, and Douglas, they cannot decide where to find the right to abortion. Is it in the 1st amendment, the 9th amendment, the 14th amendment etc? They set out to find the right and surprise, surprise they found it. They were far from impartial judges trying to find out what the constitution says about the issue of abortion. They were acting as super-legislators making law and policy on abortion, which is not their role under the constitution. Their decision violated the most basic principle of our criminal justice system: You don't give the death penalty to anyone unless they have been found guilty of premeditated murder beyond a reasonable doubt by a unanimous jury verdict with the right to appeal. What about this entity in a woman's womb? Isn't there powerful circumstantial evidence that it is a human being? It has human DNA, human parents, a heartbeat at 21-24 days after conception. Shouldn't the benefit of doubt be given to the humanity of the fetus? Should not those on the pro-abortion side have been forced to prove beyond a reasonable doubt that it is not a human being before lethal force is allowed? Otherwise we risked a monstrous crime being committed, the slaughter of millions of innocent defenseless human beings, which is what happened.

If Roe v. Wade is overturned, the issue will be returned to the states unless the Supreme Court interprets the word person in the 14th amendment to include the unborn, whose life would then be given dueprocess protection like we have for those already born. The flaws in the Roe v. Wade decision are best summarized by the dissenting Justice, Byron White, who said it was an "act of raw judicial power." This act has consigned 50 million pre-born babies to death in the U.S. since 1973.

The Campaign to Stop Stericycle (www.stopstericycle.com) was launched about a year ago by pro-lifers "to reprove Stericycle for their grievous and egregious participation" in the abortion industry. Stericycle is a leading national waste management company. It contracts with many companies, including Planned Parenthood abortuaries, to remove their biohazard waste. Stericycle trucks have been seen at Planned Parenthood in Hempstead. Stericycle has incinerators where they are to discard the "fetal remains" of an abortion. Because Planned Parenthood needs qualified biohazard waste removal services to meet government health regulations, companies like Stericycle help the abortion giant to be able to operate.

In addition to Stericycle being complicit with the abortion industry, there are truck leasing companies who do business with Stericycle. Part of the Campaign to Stop Stericycle is to notify truck leasing companies, who have contracts with Stericycle, about the Stericycle- abortion connection. As a result, both Penske Truck Leasing and Ryder System Inc. have stated that they will prohibit Stericycle from using their trucks to service abortion facilities.

TAKE ACTION:

Pro-lifers need to keep the pressure up, explaining to truck rental companies that it is bad business to contract with Stericycle and to urge both Stericycle and the truck leasers to stop being complicit in the deaths of unborn children.

For example: Planned Parenthood Federation of America aborts more than 300,000 babies a year. Do these innocent babies deserve to die? Do aborted babies deserve "burial" in an incinerator? Please stop enabling the abortion industry by picking up its biohazard waste (fetal remains).

Expectant Mother Care (EMC) Wins Preliminary Injunction in Fight to Stop Bill 0.371a

A hearing was held 6/15/11 in NYC Federal court, Judge William H. Pauley presiding. Challenging NYC Pregnancy Service Center Local Law 17 (Bill 0-371a), was Chris Slattery's EMC Frontline Centers, represented by the American Center for Law & Justice, and the Alliance Defense Fund. Bill 0-371a creates onerous and unconstitutional restrictions, targeted exclusively at Pregnancy Resource Centers, in violation of the 1st and 14th Amendments to the US Constitution. Bill 0-371a was to take effect 7/14/11.

On 7/13/2011 Judge Pauley ruled the law was "unconstitutionally vague" and granted a Preliminary Injunction. The Preliminary Injunction will prohibit 0.371a from taking effect until a permanent decision is made.
