GUIDELINES for PRO-LIFE PRESENCE at PRO-LIFE EVENTS and ABORTIONIST'S SITE

All public witnessing (praying, sidewalk counseling, etc.) MUST BE PEACEFUL. This is legal nonviolent direct action.

Public pro-life outreach is a statement on behalf of all of the victims of abortion.

Your participation in a public pro-life awareness event or your presence at an abortion "clinic" or abortionist's office is an important affirmation of LIFE, exercise of your Constitutional right to free speech and assembly, and a witness against the tragedy of abortion.

Babies are dying at the hands of abortionists and their staff. Treat the site appropriately. Eating, drinking, loud talking and laughter are out of place.

- · Stay on sidewalks (public property). Do not go on the facility's property or parking lot.
- Do not block/impede access of cars to driveways or pedestrians to doors or along sidewalks.
- Stay with a partner.
- · Carry a camera and cell phone.
- Use signs and hold them so they can be read by vehicle and/or pedestrian traffic.
- Carry a pro-life pamphlet with pro-life assistance contact info.

- · Praying, singing, and Scripture reading should be done without disturbing other pro-lifers who aren't joining your group.
- Do Not Shout at patients, workers, residents, drivers, police, etc. (Keep an arm's length away from them and step away from potential confrontations).
- Do not shadow (follow continuously and closely) pedestrians.
- Respond to hecklers gently or not at all. Leave them with a positive life-affirming comment.

Your prolife witness is seen by those contemplating abortion, those who know or will know someone with an untimely pregnancy, and those hurt by a past abortion decision. Your presence is critical in keeping the plight of the unborn on the public conscience and saving lives.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

OBAMACARE MANDADTED "INSURANCE EXCHANGES" - On Aug 1st the Health & Human Services Dept. announced that on or after Aug 1, 2012, all new health

insurance plans must include 'free' coverage of "FDAapproved contraception methods and contraceptive counseling," whether the plans are from private insurers, or plans under the ObamaCare mandated 'insurance exchanges'.

Pro-Life groups said this would include both "birth control," and so-called "morning after" pills (Plan B and ella), that destroy, or prevent implantation of, an early embryo. (ie, cause an early stage abortion).

There is only scant, and narrowly defined conscience protection in the new mandate. Religious organizations that provide mission outreach or social services to nonmembers are NOT exempt. Nor are religious based health insurers or healthcare facilities. Individual health workers cannot claim a moral objection either.

While pre-existing plans are not covered, a government report says that by 1/1/2014, ObamaCare will cause 66% of small employer plans and 45% of large employer plans to lose their "grandfathered" status, (and thus be covered by the new rules). Investors.com 6/11/2010

HR.1179, the Respect for Rights of Conscience Act of 2011, would keep healthcare workers, providers and insurers from being forced to participate in morally objectionable contracts or services. It has sat in a House committee since March. A Senate companion bill (S.1467), with the same name, was introduced Aug 2nd ACTION ITEMS (for House of Representatives):

<u>Updates:</u> On 7/27, Judge Royce Lamberth dismissed the lawsuit against the Obama Admn.'s expanded Embryonic Stem Cell research. He agreed with a 4/11 appeals court ruling that the research did not violate the 1996 ban on tax funded embryo destruction.

HR 2583 includes a ban on foreign aid to groups that promote or perform abortions. Sec. of State Clinton says such a ban "...would be debilitating to my efforts to carry out a considered foreign policy and diplomacy, and to use foreign assistance strategically to that end."

The NYS Legislature has recessed for the year. but, they can be called to Albany for a "Special Session" anytime through 12/31/2011. The following bills could be voted on. Please contact or visit your Senator and Assembly Member at their home office.

OPPOSE: S.2525 (Klein) S.2844 (Stewart-Cousins) The Reproductive Health Act. This bill essentially removes all restrictions or limitations on abortion in New York State, and assaults even the ability of health care professionals to refuse to participate in abortions according to their consciences; S.388 (Krueger) A.3218 (Sweeney) Advance Directives for Destruction of Embryos; S.892 (Krueger) A.85 (Paulin) Emergency Contraception; S.2920 (Duane) A.1233 (Bing) Equal Rights Amendment; and A.808 (Gottfried) the Healthy Teens Act

SUPPORT: (The following bills are before the Assembly.) A.1673 (Cusick) Unborn Victims of Violence; A.732 (Gottfried) Pain Management Bill; A.2128 (Reilich) Parental Notification; and, A.2244 (Rabbitt) Women's Right to Know.

HEALTH & SCIENCE Susan G Komen Foundation and UNICEF



During the month of October, friends and family members may ask you to contribute to the Susan G. Komen Foundation to support breast cancer research, or to UNICEF to support relief efforts for children world-wide. But do you know what that money may be funding?

122 Komen affiliates contributed over \$700,000.00 to Planned Parenthood affiliates in 2009. A visit to Planned Parenthood's website for teens will be shocking for most parents. Planned Parenthood is the nation's largest abortion provider and also supports and distributes numerous forms of contraceptives/abortifacients.

In February of this year, the House of Representatives voted to adopt the Pence Amendment to eliminate federal funding to PPFA and 102 affiliates. National Right to Life Legislative Director Douglas Johnson stated that the vote "demonstrates that most House members now recognize Planned Parenthood is a hyper-political, under-regulated, out of-control mega-marketer of abortion as a method of birth control." Planned Parenthood immediately responded. PPFA President Cecile Richards stated on The Joy Behar Show, "If this bill ever becomes law, millions of women in this country are going to lose their healthcare access—not to abortion services—to basic family planning, you know, mammograms, cancer screenings, cervical cancer."

The pro-life group Live Action then conducted an investigation. Their March 30, 2011 release stated, "A series of new undercover phone calls reveals that contrary to the claims of Planned Parenthood CEO Cecile Richards and other supporters of the nation's largest abortion chain, the organization does not provide mammograms for women." Stuart Schear, Vice President for Communications of Planned Parenthood, acknowledged earlier this spring, "we refer our patients to other facilities for mammograms when indicated based on a breast exam, age or family history." Representative Mike Pence, the author of the legislation stated that [the bill] "does not reduce funding for cancer screenings or eliminate one dime of funding for other important health services to women; the money that does not go to Planned Parenthood as a result of the Pence Amendment will go to other organizations that provide these services."

"An April 2009 study by scientists at the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center found that taking oral contraceptives while under age 18 more than tripled the risk of aggressive breast cancer, and more than quadrupled the risk in those who have used the drug recently. In addition, it found that having an abortion raises the risk of breast cancer by 40 percent. A study published by the Journal of American Physicians and Surgeons in 2007 called abortion the 'best predictor of breast cancer."

Komen spokespersons have stated that the funding to Planned Parenthood was meant to support breast health.

However, directing monies to an organization that aggressively supports abortion and contraception to promote breast health does not seem logical or wise.

A spokesperson for the national Komen Foundation stated that their policies "do not preclude" the use of monies to fund embryonic stem cell research. Komen's senior communications writer, Andrea Rader continued, "If we received a request to fund such research, we would weigh it very carefully, as we do all of our research proposals, for its likelihood to have a positive impact on breast cancer research and treatment."

Last month, the Ohio Catholic Bishops issued a directive requesting all parishes and schools to discontinue fundraising for Komen for the Cure. Although they acknowledged that they do not believe the foundation is currently involved in embryonic stem cell research, "literature provided by Komen indicates that the national Komen for the Cure would not rule out supporting research that destroys human embryos in the battle against breast cancer. Local Komen dollars can reach the national level." The bishops "expressed a common desire to avoid even indirect support for research involving human embryos."

UNICEF: "As Halloween approaches, children will be bringing home their bright orange boxes to collect money to help poor children as they go 'trick or treating'. They will be told that it only takes pennies to change kids' lives. Many schools have been deceived by the propaganda from UNICEF to publicize this project and honestly believe they are encouraging children to help other children. In truth, I believe parents would be scandalized to know that UNICEF actively promotes abortion and sexual rights for children and these programs are fueled by donations from children on Halloween. UNICEF was founded in 1946 to help starving children after World War II. Over the past couple of decades, UNICEF has changed direction promoting population control and children's sexual and reproductive rights (read that abortion and contraception), including promotion of socalled emergency contraception (early abortion) for adolescents and children as young as 10 years of age. According to their controversial manual issued in conjunction with the World Health Organization (WHO), Reproductive Health in Refugee Stations: ... "patients access to services should not be contingent on social or cultural backgrounds nor on age, sexual orientation or parental consent." In 1996, the Vatican withdrew it symbolic contribution to UNICEF, stating as the reason its promotion of abortion and contraception. It has not been reinstated. Unfortunately, with its new direction, UNICEF has abandoned its original mandate to provide basic health care and education services to the poorest children of the world. UNICEF has moved far beyond its original purpose of protecting and defending children to actively assisting in the destruction of millions of tiny lives. It is a cynical program, indeed, that uses children to prevent the birth of other children." (Mary Anne Hackett, President, Illinois RTLC, www.illinoisrighttolife.org/UNICEFdeception.htm)
