


This free service of practical guidance and compassionate care focuses on meeting the needs of expectant parents as they seek to honor the life of their baby no matter how frail or how brief.

This outreach is guided by Catholic principles on decisions related to life and death and is available to all. Recently, sixty attendees completed Peer Ministry Training in New York.

Baby Safe Haven - 877-796-HOPE (4673)

"Don't Abandon Your Newborn Baby." To obtain help during pregnancy or if you cannot care for your newborn call Baby Safe Haven. You can protect your secret and get help if the newborn child is not harmed - no questions. Police will not be called, and your newborn will be safe if you leave your baby at any community hospital emergency room or community firehouse.

The N.Y.S. Safe Haven Law: Penal Code 260.03; 260.15 & Serv. Law 358-a reads:

"You can leave your baby, up to 30 days old, with any responsible person at a suitable location in New York."





FEDERAL LEGISLATION

The Supreme Court session begins 10/7/13. Experts say that in this session, or the next, the Court will hear one or more cases re the HHS contraceptive/abortifacient/sterilization mandate, and issue a broad ruling on the

matter. This is because two Circuit Court rulings are in direct conflict: The 10th Circuit said Hobby Lobby Stores are exempt, due to religious freedom, while the 3rd Circuit said Conestoga Wood Products must obey the Mandate; no exemption. Hobby Lobby has said it will close shop if forced to obey. The suit against the HHS Mandate which includes the Diocese of Rockville Centre, has not progressed since 12/5/12.

Priests for Life suit vs. the HHS Mandate was reinstated 8/19/13 in the U.S. District Court (Washington DC). The court had not yet ruled on the merits of the suit, pending the mandate's final version. When it came on 6/28/13, *Priests for Life* said the final version does not provide sufficient 'relief', so the court will now hear the case. See the status of all HHS Mandate cases at:

www.becketfund.org/hhsinformationcentral/ObamaCare "Insurance Exchanges" (on-line markets) open 10/1/13. On 8/15/13 it was announced that in three states (IA, MT & NH), Planned Parenthood will be one of many ObamaCare "Navigators," getting \$655,000 to help people choose and sign up for an Insurance Plan.

The Hill reports (8/25/13) that key former HHS officials, and former members of Congress key to passing ObamaCare, are now high paid lobbyists helping drug, health care and other companies adapt to ObamaCare. An e-mail letter from Sen. Schumer (8/27/13) talks of the contraceptive coverage in the HHS Mandate, but does not mention abortifacients. It speaks of the "accommodation" given religious entities that are not 'houses of worship.' Pro-life organizations have called the "accommodation" inadequate.

LICL opposes the anti-life provisions of ObamaCare. Several members of Congress vow to use various means to stop the funding of ObamaCare this fall.

UNICEF - A Trick or a Treat?



"As Halloween approaches, children will be bringing home their bright orange boxes to collect money to help poor children as they go 'trick or treating.' They will be told that it only takes pennies to change kids' lives. Many schools have been deceived by the propaganda from UNICEF to publicize this project and honestly believe they are encouraging children to help other children. In truth, I believe parents would be scandalized to know that UNICEF actively promotes abortion and sexual rights for children and these programs are fueled by donations from children on Halloween. UNICEF was founded in 1946 to help starving children after World War II. Over the past couple of decades, UNICEF has changed direction promoting population control and children's sexual and reproductive rights (read that abortion and contraception), including promotion of so-called emergency contraception (early abortion) for adolescents and children as young as 10 years of age. According to their controversial manual issued in conjunction with the World Health Organization (WHO), Reproductive Health in Refugee Stations: . . . "*patients access to services should not be contingent on social or cultural backgrounds nor on age, sexual orientation or parental consent.*" In 1996, the Vatican withdrew its symbolic contribution to UNICEF, stating as the reason its promotion of abortion and contraception. It has not been reinstated. Unfortunately, with its new direction, UNICEF has abandoned its original mandate to provide basic health care and education services to the poorest children of the world. UNICEF has moved far beyond its original purpose of protecting and defending children to actively assisting in the destruction of millions of tiny lives. It is a cynical program, indeed, that uses children to prevent the birth of other children." (Mary Anne Hackett, President, Illinois RTLIC, www.illinoisrighttolife.org/UNICEFdeception.htm)

Susan Yoshihara, Ph.D., reported on July 5, 2013 at www.c-fam.org that "UNICEF's latest annual report revealed that it interprets two UN human rights treaties - on disabilities and children's rights - to include a child's right to 'confidential sexual and reproductive health information and services during adolescence and into early adulthood.' UNICEF defines adolescence as 10 to 19 years of ages. Neither treaty mentions such a right, but in 2009 the committee that monitors the Children's treaty began interpreting it such that children must have access 'without parental consent' to 'reproductive health education or services', a term often used by UN staff to include abortion. In 2010 the Vatican upbraided the committee that monitors the treaty for misinterpreting it."

According to Dr. Yoshihara, the "bulk of the report supports its main finding - that basic health care and nutrition are the best way to prevent disabilities. . . UNICEF's former mission of promoting child survival allowed the agency to prioritize such issues, but when it adopted a rights-based approach in 1986, it effectively had to emphasize equally all of the rights contained in the Children's convention as well as the Women's convention. The switch has caused controversy in the past, such as when UNICEF joined other agencies in 2006 to urge Nicaragua's legislature to keep abortion legal." The Population and Research Institute Review (Volume 23, Number 1, Jan-Feb 2013), contains a lead story by Steven W. Mosher titled "UNICEF or Unisex? Sexual Rights for Children." He reports that a new Code on Childhood and Adolescence "is raging in Peru... The debate centers around Article 27 of the Code, which is called 'Rights to Sexual and Reproductive Health'... Article 27 mandates that the government provide, for teenagers 14 years and older, access to 'information, guidance, and sexual and reproductive health services.'" Mosher states that UNICEF, UNFPA, Save the Children and "a coalition of abortion-minded groups...many, if not most foreign-funded" are supporting this Code. "They encourage the early onset of sexual activity and massive condom distribution schemes for kids as young as 14 to deal with the increased risk of pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases that will result." Mosher continues, "The emotional and psychological needs of children and adolescents are ignored. Children are reduced to their genitalia. Contraceptives would be distributed to teenagers without the foreknowledge or consent of their parents or guardians. Such contraceptives would include invasive methods such as IUDs or Depro-Provera injections [abortifacients], along with indiscriminate distribution of condoms. So called 'confidential sexual health services' could also include vasectomies or tubal ligations. Parents are to be excluded from making medical decisions about their children if the treatment has anything to do with sex... UNICEF defends this attack on parents and children by alleging that high rates of teen pregnancy demand action...The UN agency and its allies defend their efforts to sexualize the young by citing 'studies' that they themselves published. Independent, objective scientific studies paint a very different picture." Mosher concludes that "UNICEF attempts to justify its push for sexual rights for kids by suggesting that they are already sufficiently developed both physically and psychologically to decide whether or not to have intercourse...It is a strange and perverted agenda that has reduced the Convention on the Rights of the Child to this."

- ♥ My heart is beating at 18-25 days.
- ♥ The foundation for my nervous system is in place at 20 days.
- ♥ My skeleton is complete at 42 days and I have reflexes.
- ♥ My brain waves can be detected as early as 43 days.
- ♥ At 8 weeks my brain and all body systems are present and I look like a miniature doll.
- ♥ During weeks 9 & 10 I squint, swallow and can make a fist.
- ♥ By the 11th and 12th weeks I am moving my arms and legs, sucking my thumbs and breathing amniotic fluid. All my systems are working.
- ♥ My movements by 16 weeks are quite active and I can be seen performing somersaults on ultrasound but am not yet felt by my mother.
- ♥ From the 3rd month on nothing new develops. I continue to grow in size and by 20 weeks I have hair on my head, weigh 1 pound and am 12 inches tall.


